### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Ben Lively** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from consecutive losses (last 3G losing streak: 8/6-8/8 at Syracuse). The Saints will counter with LHP **Kendry Rojas**. Columbus is 13-20 (.394) versus left handers this year. Rojas has pitched against Columbus once in his career, 9/14/25 in St. Paul (ND, 4.0IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 3BB, 3K).

### vs. the Saints

Columbus went 5-5 against the Saints in Ohio last year (2G cancelled), on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 52 of the last 86 overall opposing the Saints (472-377 run differential; 15 of 32 losses by a single run, only 12 losses by more than two runs). Individually, **David Fry** has hit .333 (20x60) with 4HR and 15RBI in 18G against St. Paul in his career (**Kahlil Watson** has 5HR and 18RBI in 17G).

### Aside from That...

If no homers had been hit so far this week, Columbus would be outscoring St. Paul by a total of 9-1, as the Saints have scored 20 times thanks to 13HR. For their part, the Clippers have scored 18 runs off 9HR. Columbus pitching has held the Saints to a measly .063 (1x16, HR) with runners in scoring position (Clippers are 8x24 with 4HR), but St. Paul is hitting .313 (26x83) with 12HR in all other situations.

### Start with a Bang

Over the last 19G, the Clippers have plated a total of 148 runs (7.8 per, best average in the IL), with 100 tallied in the first four innings of the game (35 scored in the 1st), including seven innings of 5+. Grabbing the early lead has been of the utmost importance for Columbus, as the Clippers are the only undefeated team in the IL when leading after the 7th (46-0, 56 straight wins since 8/22/25 vs. Omaha).

### Homer Time

Columbus had gained 18 in the homer column over 17G from 7/28-8/19 (45-27; out-homered 36-21 in 19G prior), but got out-homered 11-4 yesterday. Dating to 7/28, they have hit more homers (49) than any team in professional baseball, while giving up the 5th most (38; most in the IL). The Clippers led off three innings with a homer yesterday (46 on the year, 2nd in IL), as did the Saints (55, 1st in the IL).

### Ingle is Back

In 30G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 40x118 (.339), drawing 26BB (.455OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .576SLG). He is the only batter in the IL hitting .300/.400/.500 (30PA from permanently qualifying for rate statistics), but is just 6x38 in his last 11G (.158; has drawn 15BB for a .396OBP, also has 16K in 53PA). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.303OPS (15HR) in 44G (.638OPS, 3HR in 36G between DH and LF).

### King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (13, +5), RBI (26, +4; RBI in 15 of 18G) and SLG (.942, +142). His homer in yesterday's regularly scheduled game extended his hitting streak to a career best 12G (.417, 20x48, since 8/4; had career best 30G on base streak from 6/3-7/10, .383OBP). Aside from the trip to St. Paul (0x21 in 6G, 7/21-7/26), he is hitting .344/.420/.689 since 6/18.

### All or Nothing

Over his last 18G, since 7/25, **Kody Huff** is mired in a 9x62 (.145) slump, though he has connected for 5HR (18HR on the season; had 18HR in career prior). He scored his 100th run as a Clipper on Saturday and, this year, Huff has career highs in runs (69) and RBI (66), leading the team in both (set to become the fourth 70-70 Clipper since 2019). Tuesday's single matched a career best for hits (82).

### Making a Run

**Milan Tolentino** enters tonight just 4HR and 5SB short of his second straight 20-20 season (last year, at 21HR and 20SB, was first such season in franchise history). Dating to the start of 2025, his 37HR are tied for 2nd most in the IL (35SB are tied for 29th), and he recently popped his first off a LHP (8/7 at Syracuse). At Huntington Park this year, he has just 7HR in 150AB (14HR in 195AB last year).

### Problems on the Back End

Since allowing 7ER in 4.1IP at Lehigh Valley on 7/12, the Clipper bullpen has registered an IL-worst 7.41ERA in 29G (119.0IP, 98ER). Clipper relievers have surrendered 28HR in that time (2nd to the 29 given up by St. Paul), allowing a line of .281/.390/.540. The bullpen has not put together a scoreless outing since back to back games vs. Louisville from 7/4-7/5 (112ER in 34G since; 73ER in 34G prior).

## Columbus Clippers Game Information

Friday, August 21

### This Date in Clipper History

8/21/1992

The Clippers fell to the Chiefs 4-3, but thanks to an extra inning loss by Richmond, clinched the IL West Division with nearly 3 weeks left in the season. The '92 squad then swept Richmond 3-0 in the divisional round, including two comeback wins. They would find the GC finals to be even more challenging as they were pushed to the limit by Scranton 3-2, winning game four in extras and game five with a 3-run, 9th inning comeback.

### First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,485 to 1,431).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 171-136 (.557) in pitch reviews, with batters going 88-82 (.518) and pitchers/catchers going 83-54 (.606). They have run out of challenges in 46G and have not challenged in 6G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

### On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 838, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

### On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 141 through 120G (on pace for 173SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 43CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (53; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

### Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 173 runs while crafting a .897OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 111 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +62 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 276-174 from innings 5-7).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,987RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.46 through 120G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 206HR (2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 66G this season (39-27, .591), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Good Baseball

**CJ Kayfus** bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 12th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 450-462 (.493), 420-416 with Columbus (.502).
