TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves open their penultimate homestand at Trustmark Park on Tuesday night with game one of a six-game series against the Chattanooga Lookouts. This is the second of two meetings this season between the M-Braves and Lookouts.

LOOKOUTS, IT'S GOOD TO SEE YOU AGAIN: The M-Braves enter this series on a nine-game winning streak against the Lookouts. Since dropping four-straight against Chattanooga at AT&T Field, April 13-16, 2023, the M-Braves haven't lost a game against the Reds' Double-A affiliate. This is Chattanooga's first visit to Trustmark Park in 461 days - May 9-14, 2023, which was a rain-shortened five-game sweep. The M-Braves swept a six-game road series in Chattanooga, May 21-26, securing the second six-game sweep in club history.

ABOUT SUNDAY NIGHT: The M-Braves wrapped up their series on Sunday with an 11-1 thrashing of the Biloxi Shuckers at Keesler Federal Park to cap off a 5-1 series win. The M-Braves have won six of their last seven games since August 11, out-scoring the opposition 23-12. The offense was outstanding, but Darius Vines set the tone with his second win during the series, and a quality start. Vines worked 6.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Cal Conley capped off a big week at the plate by reaching bases three times in the finale, going 2-for-4 with three runs, a double, and a stolen base, and Ethan Workinger was 2-for-4 and scored twice.

WE'RE BACK IN THIS THING: Having won six of their last seven, the M-Braves are just 2.5 games out of first place in the Southern League's South Division with 24 games. Last week's 5-1 series win in Biloxi brought the club from 6.5 back to 2.5 back. The M-Braves play Chattanooga and Tennessee at home, and Pensacola and Biloxi are on the road to close the final season in Mississippi.

ROAD SUCCESS: The M-Braves are 14-4 over their last 18 road games since the All-Star Break. After starting the season 6-14 on the road, the M-Braves are 27-15 over their last 42 games away from Trustmark Park, including a 4-1 mark in a home-away-from-home series at Toyota Field, June 13-16. They won a club record nine straight games away from Pearl from May 12 to June 5. The streak included a six-game sweep in Chattanooga, May 21-26.

EMPERORS RISING: The three newest position player additions to the roster from High-A Rome, Ethan Workinger, David McCabe, and Adam Zebrowski, combined to reach base nine times on Sunday and went 6-for-12 with five RBI, five runs, and three walks. Zebrowski has hit in all three games so far and went 7-for-22 (.318) with a homer, double, four RBI, five runs, and a stolen base last week.

SANCHEZ SIZZLING: Volbert Sanchez has hit in eight of his last 10 games, leading the league over that span by batting .432 with six multi-hit contests. Since July 1, Sanchez ranks 4th in the Southern League with a .308 average over 28 games.

HACKEN-BRAUN: RHP Lucas Braun and RHP Drue Hackenberg have put together two of the top seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization. The two have combined for 39 starts and 236 strikeouts in 212.0 innings. Hackenberg leads the organization with 119 strikeouts, and is T-1st with 20 starts. He ranks among the organizational leaders in opponent's batting average (2nd, .220), WHIP (4th, 1.25), innings pitched (4th, 100.1), and ERA (3rd, 3.59) ... Braun leads the organization in innings pitched (111.2), and is among the leaders in ERA (4th, 3.71), starts (T-3rd, 19), WHIP (3rd, 1.23), opponent's batting average (6th, .252), and wins (T-3rd, 6).

16-Strikeout Game: Hackenberg became the first pitcher in Minor League Baseball to strike out 16 on July 21 at Pensacola, setting a new club record. He became the 21st Minor League pitcher since 2005 to record 16 or more strikeouts in a single game.

STARTING STUDS: Five M-Braves starters rank among the Atlanta Braves Top-30 prospect list according to Baseball America's early August release. Jhancarlos Lara (No. 10), Darius Vines (No. 13), Drue Hackenberg (No. 15), Lucas Braun (No. 18), and Ian Mejia (No. 25). Luis De Avila (No. 24) is currently on the IL.

ROSTER SHAKEUP: The M-Braves have made 12 roster moves since July 28. On August 15, C Adam Zebrowski was promoted to Mississippi from High-A Rome. On August 12, RHP Jhancarlos Lara was promoted from High-A Rome ... OF Justin Dean was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on August 7, and OF Ethan Workinger was added from High-A Rome. On August 3, RHP Darius Vines was outrighted to Mississippi from Atlanta, and activated on August 4. Also on August 4, RHP Anthony Vizcaya was released, and C Nick Clarno was transferred and placed on the Development List. C Javier Valdes was released on July 28, INF David McCabe was reinstated from the 60-day IL and transferred to Mississippi on July 30, OF Geraldo Quintero was placed on the IL, and OF Bryson Worrell was transferred from Rome on July 31.

MCCABE MAKING IT BACK: DH David McCabe had Tommy John surgery in February, returned to action, and made his M-Braves debut on July 30. McCabe hit his first home run on August 9 vs. Pensacola, his first home run since August 18, 2023, while with Rome. In 2023, McCabe led the Braves farm system with 75 RBI and finished T-3rd in homers with 17.

THE MAN OF STEAL PROMOTED: OF Justin Dean was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett after the game on Wednesday. Dean set a new M-Braves single-season record with 47 stolen bases in 92 games. On July 28 at Montgomery, Dean surpassed Matt Young's record of 42 (set in '09) in just 88 games. Dean is the M-Braves all-time leader with 117 steals.

M-BRAVES SET SINGLE-SEASON STEALS RECORD: With five stolen bases on July 20 at Pensacola, the M-Braves set a new single-season record for steals in a season (in 88 games), surpassing the previous mark, 159, set by the 2007 club. **Leading Double-A:** Mississippi leads Double-A with 204 stolen bases (204-for-252, 81%) through 113 games. The closest club is Montgomery, with 180. The M-Braves are on pace for 247 (1.81 per game) in 2024. Birmingham set the Southern League record with 264 in 1989.

First to 200 Steals: With three steals on August 16 at Biloxi, the M-Braves became the first team in Double-A and 10th in minor league baseball to reach 200 steals in 2024.

Four players with 30+ steals: The M-Braves became the first team in Minor League Baseball to have four players with 30+ steals in 2024. Justin Dean led the way at the time of his August 8 promotion to Triple-A and led Double-A with 47. Cal Conley ranks 4th in the Southern League with 37, Cody Milligan is 7th with 33, and Geraldo Quintero is 10th with 30 ... The M-Braves became the first team with 4+ players with 30+ steals since the 2022 Down East Wood Ducks (5). The most by a team since 2005 was the 2017 Lancaster Jethawks with six players.

IMPRESSIVE ON-BASE STREAK: INF Keshawn Ogans has reached base safely in 36 of 41 games since June 9. The Cal product saw his team-high 24-game on-base streak end on July 30. Over the streak, he hit .287 with a .374 OBP, 3 doubles, 5 RBI, 13 runs, 9 walks, 3 HBP, and 4 steals. The streak was the fourth-longest in the league this season and the longest by an M-Brave since Jesse Franklin V had a 23-game on-base streak, July 16-August 12, 2023.

M-BRAVES TO THE SHOW: RHP Parker Dunshee became the eighth M-Braves alum, and fourth from the 2024 squad to make an MLB debut this season on August 8 for Atlanta. He also became the 177th alum to debut since 2005. Dunshee joined Roddery Munoz (4/20, MIA), Tyler Ferguson (5/7, OAK), Spencer Schwellenbach (5/29), Justyn-Henry Malloy (6/3, DET), Hurston Waldrep (6/9), C.J. Alexander (6/24, KC), and Tanner Gordon (7/9, COL) and Nacho Alvarez Jr. (7/22, ATL). Overall, 176 former M-Braves have made their Major League debut.

TODAY'S GAME

- Braun is making his ninth Double-A start in game one of the series against Chattanooga at Trustmark Park. This is Braun's 21st overall appearance, and 20th start between High-A Rome and Mississippi this season. This is his first start against the Lookouts.
- Over his last seven starts since July 1, Braun has a 2.59 (fifth-best in the SL) ERA with 33 strikeouts to 13 walks over 41.2 innings pitched. Braun is second in the Atlanta Braves farm system (behind Drue Hackenberg) with 117 strikeouts between Rome and Mississippi.

LAST TIME OUT

- The right-hander took a no-decision in game two of last Thursday's doubleheader in Biloxi, tossing 5.1 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, walking two and striking out two. The M-Braves eventually lost in the 16th inning of the day 5-3 on a ninth-inning Xavier Warren walk-off homer at Keesler Federal Park

2024 NOTES

- Began the season with High-A Rome making 12 appearances and 11 starts, going 4-2 with a 4.34 ERA (64.1 IP/31 ER), 16 walks, 75 strikeouts.
- Great July:** Went 2-1 with a 2.28 ERA (6th in SL) (23.2 IP/6 ER), seven walks, 18 strikeouts during his first full month in Double-A
- At the time of his promotion, Braun ranked among the South Atlantic League leaders in strikeouts (T-7th, 75), innings (T-8th, 64.1), and WHIP (9th, 1.23).
- Promoted to Mississippi on June 25
- Struck out 21 batters over his final two starts for the Emperors ... including a career-high 12 strikeouts in his best professional start on 6/14 at Bowling Green (7.0 IP, 0 R, 4 H, 2 BB, 12 SO)

2023 NOTES

- Braun signed with the Braves in the sixth round of the 2023 draft for \$347,500 after a strong season with Cal State Northridge, where he made a successful transition to a starting role. He then had one of the better pro debuts of any drafted 2023 pitcher, as his 27 innings and 32 strikeouts between Low-A Augusta and High-A Rome were second to only fellow Atlanta farmhand Hurston Waldrep.

AMATEUR

- Braun started his college career as a reliever at San Diego for two seasons before transferring to Cal State Northridge and becoming a starter ... He took a star turn for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots in the Alaska League last summer and carried into his senior season.
- Braun went 6-5, 4.83 as the Matadors' top starter and finished third in the Big West Conference with 100 strikeouts, the most by a CSUN starter since current Angels lefthander Kenny Rosenberg in 2016.

- **ACQUIRED:** 11th round (335th overall), 2022
- **2024:** Made his first career relief appearance (49 previous starts) on 8/17 at BLX ... Mejia was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/23, and transferred back to Mississippi on 5/24. In his lone Triple-A start, he suffered the loss on 5/23 vs. Jacksonville (1.1 IP, 5 H, 5 ER, 3 BB, 1 SO, 2 HR).
- **Club-Record Scoreless Streak:** Mejia set a new club record with 30.1 consecutive scoreless innings for the M-Braves from 4/28 to 6/5. The streak ended in the first inning of his 6/5 start at PNS.
- **2x: Southern League Pitcher of the Week (4/30-5/5 & 5/14-5/19):** Tossed 7.0 shutout innings, on two hits with one walk, and seven strikeouts on 5/4 to earn Southern League Pitcher of the Week.
- **No Hitter:** Tossed a seven-inning no-hitter in game two of the Friday, May 17 doubleheader vs. Biloxi (7.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 11 SO). His 11 strikeouts were a career hig. It was the fifth no-hitter in M-Braves history, and first individual one since Tommy Hanson's nine-inning no hitter on June 25, 2008 vs. Birmingham at Trustmark Park.
- **Massive May:** Over four Mississippi starts in May, was 4-0 and didn't allow a run in 26.2 innings, five walks to 30 strikeouts.
- **2023:** Made 23 starts for High-A Rome, going 4-11 with a 4.69 ERA (63 ER/121.0 IP), 28 walks, 110 strikeouts, and 1.23 WHIP ... Ranked among Atlanta farmhands in ERA (7th, 4.69), strikeouts (9th, 110), starts (4th, 23), innings pitched (5th, 121.0), BAA (7th, .260), WHIP, and (4th, 1.23).
