## SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

**TODAY WE HONOR:** Today, May 20, is Armed Forces Day... Across the entire weekend, MiLB and MLB will honor active service members, veterans, and military families... Armed Forces Day was established by President Harry S. Truman in 1949 and is traditionally celebrated each year on the third Saturday of May.

**ARE YOU NOT ENTERTAINED?:** Entering today, the Shuckers bullpen has not allowed a run over the last three games dating back to Wednesday... Over that span, the bullpen has combined for eight shutout innings with 16 strikeouts... The group has also allowed one hit, which came with one out in the seventh inning on Friday night... This year, the bullpen owns a 3.06 ERA, the fourth-best in Minor League Baseball.

**KING OF THE BULLPEN:** RHP **Harold Chirino** tossed two perfect innings on Friday night, extending his scoreless streak to 14.0 innings to start the season... Since being activated off the 7-Day Injured List on May 11, 2023, Chirino has allowed one hit over four innings... Chirino is one of two pitchers in Double-A, along with M-Braves RHP **Alec Barger**, to not allow a run while throwing at least 10 innings this year.

**MAKING IT TO THE SHOW:** Former Shuckers RHP/INF **Lucas Erceg** made his MLB debut on Friday with the Oakland Athletics, becoming the 61<sup>st</sup> former Shuckers player to make their MLB debut and fourth in 2023... Erceg, a San Jose native, was traded to the A's on Wednesday from the Brewers... Over three years with Biloxi (2018, 2021-22), Erceg had 620 plate appearances as a hitter before switching to the mound in 2021... In two years as a reliever and starter (2021-22), Erceg made 38 appearances and 15 starts as a Shucker.

**THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS:** Entering today, the average Shuckers hitter is the youngest in Double-A... Per *Baseball-Reference*, which uses playing time to weight and measure the average age, the average Shuckers hitter is 22 years and six months old... For comparison, the oldest lineup in Double-A is the San Antonio Missions (SDP) with an average age of 26 years and three and a half months... The Shuckers roster has six players who enter today at 22 years old or younger.

**MOVING TOWARDS HISTORY:** Shuckers manager **Mike Guerrero** enters today needing 10 more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019.

**TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (2-2, 4.80):** RHP Christian Mejias is set to make his first start as a 24 year-old after his birthday on Friday... In his last start, Mejias tied his season-high with five innings... Both earned runs scored in the first off a two-run home run, while he allowed one hit the rest of the way... Against right-handed hitters, Mejias has limited them to a .130 (6-46) AVG and a .516 OPS.
