NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, at 22 games over .500 at 42-20 (.677) and the best team in MiLB.

- 42 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 1 ahead of the next winningest team (Sugar Land Space Cowboys, 41 / Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .677 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Modesto Nuts (.671 / Mariners Single-A).
- Omaha's magic number to clinch the 1st Half title in the International League is **8**, meaning the Chasers need 8 wins or 2nd-place losses to secure a playoff berth.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

Shut out in its last two games against Memphis, Omaha did not scored in a span 21 innings between Friday and yesterday.

- The Storm Chasers were previously shutout in 3 straight games, March 31 to April 4, with a span of 25 scoreless innings in that stretch.
- 5 shutout losses this season are tied for the most of any International League team (with Jacksonville, Nashville and St. Paul).

WHO'S THE NEW GUY?

Between Monday and Tuesday, 6 roster moves were made affecting the Storm Chasers.

- On Monday, RHP **Dan Altavilla's** contract was selected, while RHP **Will Klein** was optioned to Omaha ... additionally, RHP **Noah Murdock** was promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas and made his Triple-A debut with a perfect 7th inning last night.
- Yesterday, OF **Drew Waters** and 1B **Nick Pratto** were both recalled by Kansas City.
- Additionally yesterday, former Mud Hen **Josh Lester** was promoted to Omaha from Double-A NW Arkansas ... between 2019 and 2022, Lester appeared in 188 games for Toledo and hit .241 (173-for-717) with 38 homers and 100 runs batted in.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Losers of 4 straight, Omaha has still won 28 of its last 37 games... 24 of those 37 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 20 of the 28 wins in this stretch.

- Omaha is 16-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... 22 games decided by 1 run are tied for the most in the Minors ... the Chasers have won their last six 1-run games and 9 of their last 12.
- Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, but 17 of 37 games since have had a save awarded to Omaha (from 7 pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors since May 1 ... **Will Klein** has 5 saves in that span, while **Carlos Hernández** has 3 **Dan Altavilla**, and **Walter Pennington** and **Sam Long** each have 2 ... **Steven Cruz** and **Evan Sisk** each have 1 save in the last 35 games.
- In total, 41 of Omaha's 62 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (66%), including 13 of 20 losses this season.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 360 to 289 this season, a +71 run differential.

- A +71 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the second-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +106.
- Omaha ranks tied 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Kannapolis Cannonballers (White Sox Single-A) lead all Minor League teams at +144 (333 to 189).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 20-4 record (.833 winning%), compared to 22-16 (.579 winning%) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 27-5 (.844 winning%), while the team is just 15-15 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.500 winning%).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .200 average (tied 5th in MiLB), while the .678 opposing OPS ranks 2nd-best and a 3.84 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 4th-best in Triple-A.
- 14 times this season Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run, most recently Sunday's loss to Memphis ... this is an average of once every 4.4 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
- The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) at the Triple-A level in 2024 have come from Omaha pitchers ... **Evan Sisk's** 14-game scoreless streak ended Saturday, a stretch of 15.1 innings since April 20 without a run allowed ... **Dan Altavilla** previous went 13.2 innings scoreless over 13 games from April 23 to May 31.
- Carlos Hernández** has thrown 5 straight scoreless outings, 5.1 innings since May 21.
- Walter Pennington's** 65 strikeouts in 25 games (2 starts) are tied 5th-most in the International League, while 53 strikeouts as a reliever lead Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S START

- Hoffmann is making his **6th start** of the season with Omaha and his **9th start overall** in 2024.
- Opened the season in Omaha's rotation, but was placed on the Injured List April 17 ... made 3 rehab starts in the Arizona Complex League between May 21 and June 1, activated from Omaha's IL on June 4.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, JUNE 6 vs. MEMPHIS

Made his fifth start with Omaha in 2024, his first since being activated from the injured list two days earlier ... allowed a two-out single in a scoreless 1st inning ... a walk, hit batter and three straight one-out singles scored two runs in the 2nd inning ... two singles and a three-run homer from Alfonso Rivas III added three more runs in the 3rd inning ... allowed a leadoff single in the 4th, removed from the game.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games (1 start) and went 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (1 ER in 4.2 IP), with 4 strikeouts.
- In his 2024 season debut on March 31 vs. Iowa, retired 15 of his final 18 after the homer, including his last 7 straight.
- Made 3 rehab appearances with the Arizona Complex League Royals (R) and combined to allow 1 unearned run over 6.0 innings, with a walk and 8 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023**
- Opened the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and made 19 starts for the Naturals with 1 relief appearance (as the bulk pitcher) before getting promoted to Triple-A on August 12, where he ended the season ... combined to go 7-9 with a 5.53 ERA (77 ER in 125.1 IP) and 133 strikeouts (9.55 K/9) between the Naturals and Storm Chasers.
 - Was supposed to make his Triple-A debut on August 13 vs. Iowa (CHC), but the game was rained out ... instead pitched twice in next series, including his Triple-A debut August 15 at Toledo (DET), where he retired 6 of his first 7 with 3 strikeouts, before allowing a 5-run third inning ... tied a season-high at the time with 8 strikeouts on August 20 at Toledo, but also set a career-high with 6 walks.
