Inland Empire 66ers (19-23) AT RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (30-15)



LHP Leonard Garcia (1-2, 5.85 ERA) vs. RHP Chris Campos (5-1, 4.38 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Quakes continue their 12-game, 13-day home stand, with the opening game of a six-game set against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Tonight is Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans can visit our website and pledge to recycle 10 CRV-eligible bottles and cans for a free Club Seat Ticket.

VS THE 66ERS: Today is game 10 of 27 between the two clubs, with 15 of those coming here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes swept a six-game set in San Bernardino the last time these two teams matched up and are 8-1 against the 66ers this year. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the 66ers overall, 9-9 at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes' pitching staff turned in a remarkable game on Sunday, helping them to win their third straight and salvage a split of the six-game set with the Storm, winning 3-2 at LoanMart Field. Rancho took a perfect game into the eighth inning, as Jared Karros (4 IP), Joel Ibarra (2 IP) and Kelvin Bautista (1 IP) combined to retire the first 21 Storm hitters. After allowing the Storm to tie the game at 1-1 in the eighth, Rancho rallied for two in the bottom of the inning against Storm reliever Will Geerdes (2-2), before giving up a run in the ninth and hanging on for the win. Madison Jeffrey secured his sixth save in as many chances, while Christian Ruebeck (1-0) notched the win in relief. The win for Rancho surrenders their 5.5 game lead with 21 games left to play in the first half.

DOING THE SPLITS: The Quakes were the last team in the league to lose three straight games in 2023, as the Storm took the first three meetings of the previous series. Rancho responded with three straight wins though, earning a split of the six-game set, just their second series that they haven't won outright in 2023. Their series record is now 6-0-2 through the first eight series of 2023. Their only split prior to this was a six-game set in Visalia in early April.

NEWELL GETS PROMOTED: OF Chris Newell put together an MVP-caliber season over the first two months of 2023, was promoted to High-A Great Lakes after Sunday's win over the Storm. He leaves the Quakes with a .312 average (sixth in the league), 14 homers (first), 38 RBIs (second), an on-base percentage of .426 (fourth) and the top slugging percentage (.662) along with the top OPS in the Cal League at 1.088. In addition to the loss of Newell, Cameron Decker went on the Injured List. Taking their respective spots on the roster are OFs Luis Rodriguez, who hit .241 with 11 homers and 67 RBIs in 110 games for Rancho in 2022 and Josue De Paula, who joins the team from Extended Spring Training in Arizona.

THE CLOSE ONES: The Quakes have played in some pretty tight ballgames already this home stand, as Sunday's 3-2 win was the third one-run game in the Storm series. Rancho went 2-1 in those contests to improve their record in one-run games to 9-7. Seven of their 16 one-run games have come against the Storm, going 5-2.

CHRIS CAMPOS: Right-hander Chris Campos makes his third start of the year for Rancho and his tenth overall appearance. Campos, who is tied for the league-lead in wins (5) is coming off his first loss of the year, as he allowed five runs on three hits with four walks on May 24 vs Lake Elsinore at LoanMart Field. Against the 66ers, he's 2-0 while allowing five hits over 5.1 relief innings. Campos was drafted by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of St. Mary's University.

LEONARD GARCIA: Left-hander Leonard Garcia will make his eighth appearance and seventh start of the year, his third appearance and second start against the Quakes. In two games against the Quakes, he's allowed a total of eight runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings, going 0-1. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits over five innings in a win over Visalia on May 23. Garcia was signed out of Venezuela by the Angels in 2019.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Quakes are home through this Sunday, hosting the Angels' affiliate. Coming up on Thursday, it's Thirsty Thursday with \$3 Pepsi products, \$4 domestic drafts and other drink specials throughout the night. Thursday is also Viva Los Temblores, as the Quakes will transform into Los Temblores de Rancho Cucamonga, as part of MLB's Copa de la Diversion program. Game time is 6:30pm.
