**THREE-RUN EIGHTH INNING SPURS 'CATS TO VICTORY:** The Fisher Cats struck thrice in the bottom of the eighth, courtesy of an LJ Talley RBI, a bases-loaded balk, and a Brock Lundquist sacrifice fly. The Fisher Cats also got excellent pitching from Mike Ellenbest, Graham Spraker, debutant Will McAffer, and Andrew McInvale, as the four pitchers held the Yard Goats to just four hits on the night. McInvale picked up his second win on the season, coming in with two runners aboard in the top of the eighth and escaping the jam before pitching a scoreless ninth.

**MOVING ON UP:** Curtis Taylor, Zach Logue, and Kevin Vicuña were all advanced to Triple-A Buffalo within the last week. In Logue's first start for the Bisons, he went seven innings, allowing just one hit and striking out eight. The three join Rodrigo Vigil as the players in Buffalo who have appeared in games for New Hampshire this season.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** June 19, 2018- After a rainout in the series opener, the Fisher Cats swept a doubleheader at Erie. Both games went extra innings. In the opener, the Fisher Cats loaded the bases in the top of the eighth on singles by Jonathan Davis and Jon Berti. Cavan Biggio delivered the game winning two-run single in a 5-3 win. In the second game, both teams scored single runs in the eighth and ninth. Biggio started at second, went to third on a groundout, and scored on a Gunnar Heidt's sacrifice fly. Travis Bergen held Erie scoreless in the bottom of the tenth for a 5-4 win.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays were four-hit by the Baltimore Orioles, giving up five runs in the eighth en route to a 7-1 loss. The top four in the Toronto lineup were 0-16 on the night. The Jays have now lost five in a row since their 18-4 victory over the Red Sox last Sunday. Buffalo one-hit Rochester off of stellar outings from Zach Logue and Dani Jimenez. Blue Jays' number 25 overall prospect Sem Robberse led Dunedin to a 3-2 victory in game one of their doubleheader, as the 19-year old went five and two-thirds innings allowing just three hits. Dunedin fell to Clearwater 4-1 in game two. Vancouver lost to Everett 9-2, as the C's mustered only five hits on the evening.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats host Hartford (Colorado) for the first time this season this week, before getting their first taste of interdivisional play when they travel to Bowie to face the division-leading Baysox (Baltimore). Following the Bowie trip, the Fisher Cats will return to Manchester to face the familiar foe of the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston).

**STARTERS:** Elvis Luciano will get the start for the Fisher Cats today, making his first appearance in 27 days. His last start came on May 23<sup>rd</sup> against Portland, where he had to leave the game after just six pitches due to injury. Luciano was the first player born in the 2000s to appear in an MLB game in 2019. It is expected that he will pitch two innings today.

Following Luciano, Maximo Castillo is expected to appear. He holds a record of 3-1 on the season with a 5.74 ERA. He picked up the win in his last outing against Portland, giving up just one run in five innings and limiting the Sea Dogs to four hits.

For Hartford, Karl Kauffman will get the start this evening. The Rockies' #17 overall and #5 pitching prospect has an 0-4 record with an ERA of 6.04. The former Michigan Wolverine is coming off of his best start of the season, limiting Reading to two runs over five innings last time out.
