**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds take on Indianapolis in game three of the series tonight at First Horizon Park. Indianapolis rallied and scored in the 10th to take a 4-3 win and even the series last night. The Sounds will turn to their top starter in the rotation, Chad Patrick, to take back the series lead. He'll face Pirates pitcher on rehab, Jared Jones, who makes his first start on assignment.

**Chad Patrick:** The 25-year-old makes his 19th appearance and 17th start for the Sounds tonight. He is 10-1 with a 2.98 ERA (96.2 IP/32 ER) on the season. Patrick held the Strippers to just two hits and one run on August 1. He struck out six while walking one, totaling 78 pitches (47 strikes) for his league-leading 10th win of the campaign. Patrick leads the level in ERA, wins, opponent batting average (.215), WHIP (1.08) and ranks second in win percentage (.909). Only Daniel Lynch IV (Omaha) has a better win percentage (7-0 across 18 starts and 101.2 IP). Patrick has been dominant at First Horizon Park, going 6-1 with a 2.17 ERA (49.2 IP/12 ER) in nine games (8 starts). He's also making his eighth appearance and seventh start on Thursday - he's got a 5-0 record with a 2.97 ERA (36.1 IP/12 ER) in those contests. The Indiana native is facing the state's Triple-A team for the first time in his career. Patrick was acquired by Milwaukee from Oakland on November 15, 2023 in exchange for INF Abraham Toro. He was originally selected in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by the Diamondbacks out of Purdue University Northwest.

**Jared Jones:** The 23-year-old, who celebrated his birthday on Tuesday, makes his first outing on MLB rehab assignment with the Indians. He was placed on Pittsburgh's 15-day injured list back on July 4 with a right lat strain. Jones threw a sim game in Pittsburgh on August 3 prior to his rehab appearance tonight. He pitched on July 3 vs. St. Louis and worked five innings of one-run baseball. The Cardinals picked up four hits and two walks in Jones' no-decision. This is his first season in the Major Leagues - he had his contract selected at the beginning of the season and made his debut with the Pirates on March 30 at Miami. Jones entered the season as Pittsburgh's No. 3 prospect and the No. 60 prospect in baseball (MLB Pipeline). He combined to go 5-9 with a 3.85 ERA (126.1 IP/54 ER) between Indianapolis (16 G) and Altoona (10 G) in 2023. This is his second start against Nashville in his career after taking the loss (3.0 IP, 4 H, 6 ER, 4 BB, 6 K) in game two of a doubleheader on August 10 at Victory Field last season. Jones was selected in the second round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft by Pittsburgh out of La Mirada High School in Whittier, California.

**Mis Mania:** Jacob Misorowski, the Brewers' No. 2 prospect and the No. 32 prospect in baseball, made his first start at First Horizon Park last night. Though limited to just two innings, the fireballer struck out three, including his first K at the Triple-A level to open the contest. Misorowski allowed just one hit across a pair of scoreless innings.

**Hudson Getting Healthy:** Following Misorowski on the bump was Brewers reliever Bryan Hudson, who made his second rehab appearance with Nashville. He threw 24 pitches (15 strikes) while yielding three hits with two strikeouts in 1.1 innings. Hudson is one of three Brewers pitchers on rehab assignment, which also includes right-hander JB Bukauskas and left-hander DL Hall.

**Sac Attack:** Isaac Collins had a terrific night out of the leadoff spot yesterday, going 2-for-3 with two walks and an intentional walk. Collins is currently riding a three-game hitting streak and has gone 5-for-13 (.385) since Sunday at Gwinnett. He is also one of six Sounds to have 20+ multi-hit games this season. The Minnesota native is tied for fifth in the league with 25 doubles.

**Power Outage:** The Sounds have failed to hit a home run at First Horizon Park in their last seven games. It is the longest home run drought by Nashville in First Horizon Park history (since 2015). Despite this, the Sounds have posted a 4-3 record at the friendly confines during the streak. Nashville's 34 home runs at home are the fewest home homers by any team in Triple-A this season. On the other side of the coin, Sounds pitchers have allowed the third-fewest home runs at home in the International League this season (49 - the fewest is Toledo and Norfolk with 40).

**Future Brew Crew:** The Sounds currently have three of the top 10 and five of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misorowski (No. 2), INF Tyler Black (No. 3), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 7), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 23) and INF Wes Clarke (No. 24).

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 740-635 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,332-2,155 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).
