TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame home series against the Montgomery Biscuits at Trustmark Park. This is the third of five series and 30 meetings between the two clubs (18 at Trustmark Park, 12 at Riverwalk Stadium).

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BISUITS: The M-Braves split a six-game series at Riverwalk Stadium from May 16-21. The aggregate score was tied at 26-26 with several close games. In the final game of the series, the M-Braves rallied for a ninth-inning comeback win.

In a six-game series at Trustmark Park from April 18-23, the Biscuits took four of six games. In the second game of a doubleheader on April 22, Jacob Pearson smashed a walk-off grand slam to snap an eight-game losing streak.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves lost a five game win streak in a 6-0 loss to the Biscuits. The bullpen put together 4.1 shutout innings and Luke Waddell highlighted the offense with three hits and a triple. M-Braves pitchers combined for a season-high 17 strikeouts.

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: The M-Braves closed the first half by going 24-17 over the last 41 games, after starting 9-18. The club picked up right where it left off with a series win at Biloxi. Over the last eight series, the club is 4-1-3, starting the run with a five-game sweep of Chattanooga from May 9-14.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, Double-A, and rank 9th among full-season MiLB clubs with a 3.69 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 57 home runs, fewest in Double-A.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record five grand slams, including the first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell's last two home runs were grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola, and July 1 at Biloxi.

PROSPECTING: 8 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (10), INF Cal Conley (12), OF Jesse Franklin V (13), RHP Alan Rangel (25), RHP Tanner Gordon (27), C Tyler Tolve (28), LHP Luis De Avila (29) and INF Luke Waddell (30).

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 2nd in the league, and T-6th in Double-A with 94 homers in 76 games - 58 on the road while their opponents have just 57 total home runs. 16 different players have at least one homer with Landon Stephens leading the way with 16 which leads the Southern League. The M-Braves hit 14 home runs at MGM Park this past week.

M-Braves opponents have just 13 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve had his 20-game on-base streak (began May 24) end on Sunday. The streak is the longest by an M-Braves player

DEAN RUNNIN' WILD: Justin Dean set a club record with four steals in the first two innings on July 1 at Biloxi. Dean had seven steals over two games, June 30-July 2, finished the series with eight stolen bases, and has 20 on the year.

FRANKLIN V ON FIRE: Jesse Franklin V became the fourth player in M-Braves history (Ryan Casteel ('19), Shea Langeliers ('21), Greyson Jenista ('21)) to hit three homers in a game on Saturday at Biloxi. Franklin went 7-for-8 with four home runs, a double, walk, two stolen bases, and seven RBI on June 30, and July 1 at Biloxi

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

ANOTHER WINNING MONTH: After an 8-13 April, the M-Braves posted a 13-12 record in both May, and June. Over the month of June, the M-Braves ranked 2nd in the league with a .250 batting average, 37 home runs, and 4.17 ERA. The M-Braves are out to a 4-1 start in July.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 100th minor league home run on June 29 at Biloxi, which was his 59th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer placed on the IL again on July 3, is currently on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .455 with 4 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 6 BB, .538 OBP, and 1.386 OBP. It's the longest current streak in the league.

On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 59 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in

WADDYYY: Over his last 27 games since June 4, Luke Waddell is batting .349 with a league-most 37 hits, 22 runs, plus 24 RBI, two grand slams, 11 extra-base hits, nine stolen bases, and .988

DE AVILA DELIVERS IN JUNE: Luis De Avila has delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. The left-hander ranks top 10 in the league in ERA (2.91, 2nd), Wins (5, T-4th), and OPP AVG (.220, 4th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens hit two home runs on Sunday and another on Monday to take the league lead at 16. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18, and nine home runs since June 1.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has not allowed a run over his last 11 appearances, 15.1 IP, 24 strikeouts to 11 walks. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.71 ERA in 25.1 innings. He is currently 3rd in the league appearances with 26.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed two earned runs in 18.2 innings over 17 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including eight walks to 25 strikeouts. The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

DAYSBEL DIALED IN: RHP Daysbel Hernandez logged his second save on Friday night, and has yet to allow a run in 11 games, 12.0 innings pitched with 15 strikeouts to seven walks. Hernandez is coming off Tommy John surgery in
