THAT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK: The Loons won eight straight games, six in Fort Wayne and two in Wisconsin from April 24th to May 1st. Great Lakes before the streak were 8-7 and a half game back of first place. The Loons outscored their opponents 63-24, with two double-digit run performances and four double-digit hit contests.

Four times the Loons have won 10 straight, a franchise record. Most recently May 24-June 3, 2023. That winning streak was also a part of a 12-game road trip in Peoria and Beloit.

ROAD WARRIORS: From April 13th to May 1st, Great Lakes won 11 consecutive road games, the most in a row in franchise history. 10 was the previous record, last season's 10 game winning streak.

This season, the offense has double digit hits in 11 of 30 road games. The Loons have averaged 5.3 runs and are hitting at a .237 clip in away games. On the hill, Great Lakes pitching has a 3.83 ERA and has allowed just 14 home runs, second-best in the Midwest League.

A SERIES SWEEP, MWL STYLE: The Loons earned their first six-game sweep in team history, taking every game against the Fort Wayne TinCaps from April 24th to April 28th at Parkview Field. Great Lakes, in 50 innings scored 48 runs, two off 50 the most runs in a standard six-game series for GL. The 50 was scored from June 28th to July 3rd, 2022 vs. Dayton at Dow Diamond.

The Loons permitted nine earned runs, the least ever in a six-game series, with 50 total innings.

ACES IN APRIL: In seven games in April, the Loons had a starter complete five innings. Great Lakes had just four starters go five innings all of April 2023. In three games from April 13th-14th, Christian Romero, Jared Karros and Peter Heubeck all went five frames. The last time three Loons starters did that was September 4-7, 2022.

IT'S MILLER TIME: Noah Miller in May had a team-leading 30 hits and reached base in 22 straight games from May 3rd to May 28th. On May 1st, Miller had a two home run game in a Loons 9-8 win over Wisconsin. He was the first Loon with a multi-homer game since Griffin Lockwood-Powell did so on August 20th, 2023 at Lansing.

CROWN NEWELL: Chris Newell has 16 home runs, first in the Midwest League. Newell has hit a homer in back-to-back games, three times, his latest instance was three in a row May 23rd-May 25th. He has hit eight each at home and on the road. GL is 12-4 when he homers.

LIRANZO THE WALK OFF HERO 2X: Thayron Liranzo delivered the game-winning hit in back-to-back GL 10-inning wins on May 22-23. A RBI single on the 22nd and a RBI double on the 23rd. Liranzo became the first Loon since Chris Roller in 2018, to have multiple walk-offs in a single-season.

TWO STRIKES, TWO OUTS, NOT TOO WORRY: Dylan Campbell delivered a two-run double in the seventh inning in Wednesday's 14-13 win over Beloit. It came with two outs and a two strike count. Campbell has the sixth most hits in the MWL with two outs and a two strike count, he is 8-for-38.

FREE REIN: Before his call-up, Alex Freeland posted a 1.111 OPS, it was the best in the Midwest League. Also, despite playing just 23 games, he remains 13th in the Midwest League in walks with 27.

CAPTIAL PUNISHMENT: The Loons ached numerous season highs in a 12-1 seven-inning win, the first of two on April 13th against the Lansing Lugnuts at Jackson @ Field™. Great Lakes had their most 2B (5), and 3B (1). Also, the most hits in a inning with a six-run seven-hit top of the seventh. The next day the Loons once again had 12 runs and 15 hits in the series finale.

Loons Coaching Staff

MANAGER

Jair Fernandez

The Great Lakes Loons in conjunction with the Los Angeles Dodgers, named Jair Fernandez as their manager for the 2024 season. Jair Fernandez becomes the 11th manager in the 17-year history of the Loons. Last season, Fernandez served as skipper for the Los Angeles Dodgers Arizona Complex League team, his seventh season coaching in the organization and fourth in Arizona. This will be Jair's second stint with the Great Lakes Loons. He served as the hitting coach in 2017 and 2018. The Loons hit a combined .240 in those two seasons, accumulating 192 home runs. For his home country, Fernandez has served in a multitude of coaching roles. In 2017 and 2023, he coached for Team Colombia in the World Baseball Classic. He manned third base in the 23' Classic. In the Colombian League, played annually from October to January, Fernandez managed two different franchises from 2016 to 2018. Leones de Monteria for two seasons and Tigres de Cartagena midway through the end of the 2018 campaign. Fernandez, 37, debuted in minor league baseball in 2007 at the age of 18 in the Seattle Mariners organization. The Colombian-born catcher spent nine seasons in baseball, appearing with two teams at the Triple-A level. Fernandez played within four major league organizations, the Mariners, Minnesota Twins, Houston Astros, and Chicago Cubs. Two summers were spent in the Midwest League. In 2008, he was an MWL All-Star with the Beloit Snappers, now the Beloit Sky Carp. Beloit was a then affiliate of the Twins. He had 36 hits in 36 games, batting .283 and posting a .703 OPS. Before that season, he was traded from the Mariners organization to the Twins organization for 34-year-old R.A. Dickey. Fernandez totaled 470 games in his minor-league career, 31 at the Triple-A level including two with Oklahoma City, in 2012. Since 2015, Oklahoma City has been a Dodgers affiliate.

PITCHING COACH

David Anderson

David Anderson continues his rise through the ranks of the Dodgers organization as the pitching coach for the Loons for a third season. Anderson, 27, joined the L.A. system as a development coach in 2020, and was assigned as the pitching coach for the organization's Arizona Complex League team in the 2021 season. He led his staff to the fourth-lowest ERA in the ACL at 4.06, the third-most strikeouts (617 in 488.0 innings pitched), and the second-best walks and hits per innings pitched. Anderson, a 2015 graduate of Muhlenberg College, got his start in coaching at his alma mater, serving as pitching coach for the NCAA Division III school in Allentown, Pa., for two years immediately after his graduation. After that, he became a volunteer assistant for Cornell in 2017 before landing at Atlanta's Emory University, serving as the school's pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. While in the college ranks, Anderson also got head coaching experience in summer collegiate ball as manager of the Watertown (N.Y.) Rapids of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2018, leading the team to a 26-21 record in its inaugural season. He then went on to manage the now-defunct Fayetteville (N.C.) SwampDogs of the Coastal Plain League in 2019. Anderson, a native of Syracuse, N.Y., tossed four seasons at Muhlenberg. As a junior in 2014, he posted a 3.14 ERA over 63.0 innings, all as a starter. He walked just seven batters that season while striking out 28. He served as team captain as a senior, and led the team that year in innings pitched and strikeouts. After college, Anderson tested the waters in independent baseball. He appeared 16 times for the Newburgh Newts of the North Country Baseball League, with a stellar 2.38 ERA and seven saves. He then threw to a 2.67 ERA with the Bridgeport Bluefish of the Atlantic League, an MLB Partner League.

PITCHING COACH

Richard De Los Santos

Richard De Los Santos returns for a third year as a member of the coaching staff after serving as Assistant Pitching Coach in 2022. This year, Anderson and De Los Santos will share the title of Pitching Coach. The 38-year-old De Los Santos had a nine-year minor league career as a right-handed pitcher, mostly in the Tampa Bay system. He played a portion of the 2005 season for the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays in Battle Creek, who would be purchased in 2006 by the Michigan Baseball Foundation and become the Loons in 2007. De Los Santos pitched in 36 games over three seasons for Triple-A Durham, racking up 99 strikeouts in 169 1/3 innings at MiLB's highest level. Over the course of nine seasons in affiliated baseball, the Dominican Republic native accumulated up over 400 strikeouts on the mound.

HITTING COACH

O'Koyea Dickson

O'Koyea Dickson, 33, returns to Dow Diamond in a coaching role after spending the 2012 season as a player with the Loons. He was drafted in the 12th round of the 2011 draft by the Dodgers, and made his Major League debut with the club in 2017. 2024 marks Dickson's third year coaching in the Dodgers organization after he worked with Single-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2022 as the team's Hitting Coach. The 2022 Rancho Cucamonga team had the most hits and RBIs in the California League under Dickson's direction. The California native made his Major League debut in September of 2012 for the Dodgers, and appeared in a total of seven games after an injury cut his time in Los Angeles short. His lone hit in the big leagues came off Madison Bumgarner of the San Francisco Giants on September 23, 2017. He hit 24 home runs and drove in 76 runs in that 2017 season for Triple-A Oklahoma City. For the next two years, Dickson had stints in Nippon Professional Baseball, the Atlantic League, the Mexican League and the Pacific Association before entering coaching. Notably in 2007, as a fifteen year old sophomore at George Washington High School, Dickson became the first high-schooler to hit a home run at Oracle Park, then AT&T Park.

BENCH COACH

Elian Herrera

Former Loon Elian Herrera is back for a fourth season as the bench coach for Great Lakes. Herrera, a four-year big leaguer, begins his fifth season as a coach within the Dodgers' organization. The second baseman played over 20 games with the Loons in a span of two separate seasons, including the inaugural 2007 Great Lakes Loons, along with nine other future Major Leaguers. He also returned to the Loons for a portion of the 2009 season. From 2012-2018, Herrera played in 324 games at the AAA level, holding a .310 batting average in nearly 1200 plate appearances. Herrera made his major league debut on May 15, 2012 at Dodger Stadium, in a game where Kirk Gibson managed the Arizona Diamondbacks vs. Don Mattingly's Dodgers. Before joining the Loons staff in 2021, Herrera was the bench coach for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in 2019, helping lead the team to the playoffs after an 81-57 finish in the regular season, good for first in the South division of the California League.
