Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Trenton Denholm** to the mound tonight, looking to become the first pitcher in the IL to reach 10 wins. The Saints will counter with RHP **Ricky Castro**. Columbus is 51-34 (.600) versus right handers this year. Castro has pitched against the Clippers once in his career, on 7/23 in Minnesota (ND, 3.0IP, 4H, 2R, 1ER, 1BB, 2K).

vs. the Saints

Columbus went 5-5 against the Saints in Ohio last year (2G cancelled), on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 52 of the last 84 overall opposing the Saints (464-359 run differential; 15 of 32 losses by a single run, only 11 losses by more than two runs). Individually, **David Fry** has hit .333 (20x60) with 4HR and 15RBI in 18G against St. Paul in his career (**Kahlil Watson** has 5HR and 18RBI in 16G).

Start with a Bang

Last night's 19-3 beatdown marked the fifth straight series opening win (15-7 vs. Omaha, 15-7 at Syracuse, 6-4 vs. Toledo and 13-2 at St. Paul) and the third time this year with at least 15 runs (all in last 11G). Over the last 17G, the Clippers have plated a total of 140 runs (most in the IL, 8.2 per game), with 94 tallied in the first four innings of the game (35 scored in the 1st), including seven innings of 5+.

End it Early

Leading by 16 after the 8th last night, the Clippers improved to 53-0 in such situations (1st in the IL, Charlotte is 52-0; when leading after 7th: 46-0, only undefeated team). Columbus last lost a game after taking a lead into the 9th on 8/7/25 vs. Gwinnett (68 straight wins; 56 straight wins when leading after 7th, last loss: 8/22/25 vs. Omaha). When trailing after the 8th, Columbus is 3-43 (.065, 6th).

Homer Time

Columbus has gained 18 in the homer column over the last 17G (45-27; out-homered 36-21 in 19G prior) to get back in the black (+5, 8th in the IL). Last night's 16-run win vaulted the Clippers into a positive run differential (+12, 12th in the IL) for the first time since 6/9 (went 28-26 during 54G underwater). The Clippers have gone deep in 15 of the last 17G, as their 45HR lead all of pro baseball since 7/28.

Ingle is Back

In 28G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 38x111 (.342), drawing 25BB (.460OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .595SLG). He is the only batter in the IL hitting .300/.400/.500 (38PA from permanently qualifying for rate statistics), but is just 4x31 in his last 9G (.129; has drawn 14BB for a .400OBP, also has 14K in 45PA). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.312OPS (15HR) in 43G (.642OPS and 3HR in 35G between DH and LF).

Watson Walks

Khalil Watson drew 3BB last night (30BB in first 31G, 18BB in last 44G), including once on a successful challenge. Watson leads IL hitters with 18 winners (leads IL with 4BB on challenged pitch) and owns the best success rate (69%) among batters with at least 15 attempts. As a team, Clipper batters have the most wins (88; 52%, 2nd best rate), walks gained (18) and strikeouts avoided (27).

Bring it on Home

Ralph Velazquez had 4HR in 5G at Syracuse (21AB; had 2HR in 100AB of previous 25G on the road), boosting his OPS away from Huntington Park to .709. He owns 4HR in 5G since coming home (1.008OPS in 34G) and, dating to 7/28, leads the IL in HR (11), RBI (23; RBI in 13 of 16G) and SLG (.902). Aside from the trip to St. Paul (0x21 in 6G, 7/21-7/26), he is hitting .336/.416/.657 since 6/18.

All or Nothing

Over his last 17G, since 7/25, **Kody Huff** is mired in a 9x59 (.153) slump, though he has connected for 5HR (18HR on the season; had 18HR in career prior). He scored his 100th run as a Clipper on Saturday and, this year, Huff has career highs in runs (69) and RBI (66), leading the team in both (set to become the fourth 70-70 Clipper since 2019). Last night's single matched a career best for hits (82).

Swolentino

Milan Tolentino crushed his 16th homer of the year last night, giving the Clippers their fourth slam of the season (six straight years with 4+). **Ralph Velazquez** and **Kahlil Watson** each knocked their 15th of the season, giving the Clippers five players with at least 15 this year (most in the IL; **Cooper Ingle** and **Kody Huff** each have 18). Since the start of '25, Tolentino's 37HR are 2nd in the IL.

This Date in Clipper History

8/19/2002

The Clippers outlasted Louisville 10-9 in 17 innings at Cooper Stadium. **Andy Phillips** led the charge for Columbus, going 3x7 with a HR and 3RBI. Phillips was named the Kevin Lawn Minor League Player of the Year in 2002, recognizing the best player in the Yankees' minor league system. Between Columbus and Norwich, he combined to hit 28HR with 87RBI, leading the organization in HR and ranking 2nd in RBI.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,474 to 1,427).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 171-134 (.561) in pitch reviews, with batters going 88-80 (.524) and pitchers/catchers going 83-54 (.606). They have run out of challenges in 45G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 842, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 140 through 118G (on pace for 174SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 43CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (54; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 173 runs while crafting a .904OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 107 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +66 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 267-172 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,987RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.39 through 118G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 196HR (4th most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 64G this season (39-25, .609), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 7th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 9th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 450-460 (.495), 420-414 with Columbus (.504).
