RIDERS FALL FOR FIFTH TIME IN LAST SIX GAMES:

The Frisco RoughRiders and Tulsa Drillers combined for 14 runs over a two-inning stretch late in Friday's barnburner, with Tulsa winning 12-10 at Riders Field. **David Garcia's** three-run home run in the sixth inning gave the RoughRiders (23-20, 54-57) a lead, as Frisco scored seven runs between the sixth and seventh innings. Tulsa (16-27, 57-55) tallied six runs in the seventh inning and tacked on one more run the next inning. **Jax Biggers** brought Frisco within striking distance in the seventh with a three-run double. Biggers rifled his second hit of the night to right field to clear the bases and cut the deficit to one. Ricky Vanasco (1-1) picked up the win against his former club, getting the final out of the seventh inning to strand Biggers as the tying run at second base. Vanasco then struck out the side in order in the eighth. **Aidan Anderson** (0-3) pitched a hitless sixth inning for Frisco but allowed three batters to reach in the seventh. He exited with a two-run lead but all three runners came in to score after he left and he was charged with the loss. **Trevor Hauver** went 3-for-4 with a double and a sacrifice fly. His two runs batted in added to his team-leading 12 RBIs this month. Hauver put Frisco on the board in the first inning with an RBI double that scored **Evan Carter**. **Aaron Zavala** led off the second inning with a base hit, followed by **Keyber Rodriguez** reaching on a sacrifice bunt and error. They both scored on RBI groundouts by Garcia and **Frainyer Chavez**. Hicks led off the sixth inning with a single and extended his streak of reaching base in all 29 home games he has played in. He has also reached in 25 of his last 27 games played. Zavala scored three times, going 2-for-3 with a double and a walk. Rodriguez walked twice and also scored three times.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 16 games in August, (8-8 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.51 ERA while allowing a league-low 13 home runs and .221 BAA. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Coprus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is last in the Texas League with a .717 OPS and runs per game with 4.6 per contest.

WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing their last five of their last six entering Saturday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last six games, Frisco has allowed 39 runs (6.06 ERA) while scoring 4.3 runs per game and hitting .186 (13-for-70) with runners in scoring position.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-29 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 45 games since, he is batting .298/.412/.494/.906 with 13 doubles, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 34 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 39 points and his OPS 101 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 69 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.5 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 19 times in his last 18 games. His .413 OBP on the season is eighth in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better. Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 27 games, Hicks is batting .333 (31-for-94)/.442/.447/.889 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 13 RBIs, 17 walks and 14 runs scored. In his last 14 games, he is batting .354 (17-for-48) with a .945 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all nine save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
