## RIDERS SLAM EIGHT HOMERS IN WIN HISTORIC WIN OVER TULSA:

The Frisco RoughRiders ended their six-game series against the Tulsa Drillers with an 18-4 win at ONEOK Field, tallying their most runs in a game since 2011 and their largest margin of victory in franchise history. Behind a franchise record-tying eight team home runs, **Trey Hair** slugged three and **Ezequiel Duran** recorded two. Both Duran and Hair finished the game with 12 total bases and were responsible for scoring ten of the 18 runs scored. Frisco left-hander **Cole Ragans** (3-1) struck out five batters in five innings, giving up three earned runs in his Sunday start. Riders relievers **Tai Tiedemann**, **Lucas Jacobsen** and **Fer Ozuna** combined for five strikeouts in the final four frames against the Drillers (19-13), giving up no walks or hits. Duran knocked his first home run of the game to start Sunday's scoring in the top of the first off Jose Martinez (1-1), giving Frisco an early 3-0 lead. The Drillers responded with two runs in the bottom of the first inning with two runs on one hit, cutting the Riders' lead to 3-2. Leading off the top of the second, Hair stretched the Riders lead back to two with his second home run of the year to make it a 4-2 Frisco lead. The busy inning came in the top of the third, beginning with a Duran double and back-to-back RBI singles from **Dustin Harris** and **Josh Stowers** to make it a 6-2 lead. Hair clubbed his second homer of the game in the following at-bat, scoring Harris and Stowers to balloon the lead to 9-2. On the first pitch of the bottom of the third inning, Michael Busch homered to cut Frisco's lead to 9-3. Duran doubled for the second time in Sunday's game with one out in the fourth inning and came in to score on a Harris RBI groundout. The RoughRiders homered twice in the top of the sixth, first by **Jonathan Ornelas** leading the inning off with his fourth homer of the season. Two batters later, Duran homered for the second time of the game and improved his batting line to 4-for-4 with a solo blast to give Frisco a 12-3 lead. Ragans entered for the sixth inning but departed following a first-pitch homer to Tulsa's Ryan Ward to change Sunday's score to 12-4. Entering as the first Frisco reliever of Sunday's game, Tiedemann retired the Drillers in order to end the sixth. Hair's third home run came in the top of the seventh on newly-inserted Guillermo Zuniga to give Frisco a 13-4 lead. **Jordan Procyshen** hit his second home run of the season in the top of the seventh inning, giving Frisco a 14-4 lead. Procyshen's seventh-inning homer was his second career home run at ONEOK Field, with his first coming on July 6th, 2019, when he previously played for the Drillers in the Dodgers organization. Duran walked in the eighth inning and was followed by Harris homering for the eighth and final team home run of Sunday's game, making the score 16-4. Not finished, Frisco scored two more in the ninth inning to end with their largest margin of victory in franchise history of 14.

## POWER SURGE:

The RoughRiders exploded for eight long balls in the series finale against Tulsa on Sunday. The eight home runs tied a franchise record for the most home runs in a game by any Frisco squad, equaling the RoughRiders total from July 22nd, 2011 when Frisco defeated Corpus Christi, 19-4. **Trey Hair** also became the first Riders batter to knock three home runs in a game since 2012 when Chris McGuinness accomplished the feat on June 22nd, 2012. Overall in the series, the RoughRiders smashed 15 home runs in the six-game series in Tulsa, the most in the Texas League and the fifth-highest total in Minor League Baseball.

## GARVER IN FRISCO:

Texas Rangers catcher Mitch Garver begins his rehab assignment with the RoughRiders on Tuesday. Garver was placed on the 10-Day Injured List on May 10th with a right forearm flexor muscle strain. Garver is in his first season with the Rangers after he was acquired via trade on March 12th, 2022 from the Minnesota Twins.

## DURAN, DURAN: DOUBLE TROUBLE

Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles with 16. After a monster Sunday, in Tulsa, going four-for-four with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored and five RBIs, Duran is now hitting .429 (21-for-49)/.444/.857 over his last 12 games with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 RBIs and one steal. The Rangers No. 4 prospect by MLB.com has a .901 OPS this season now.

## AYYY, IT'S THE FOSC:

Riders infielder **Justin Foscue** has caught fire for Frisco. After starting in Extended Spring Training because of back tightness, he joined the club on April 19th. Foscue went 1-for-7 in his first two games, but in his last 17, the former Mississippi State Bulldog has hit .333 (21-for-63)/.447/.619 with 10 doubles, a triple, two home runs, 12 RBIs, 13 walks and nine runs. He is riding a 15-game on base streak, where he owns a .471 OBP and a 1.071 OPS.

## JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .372 (42-for-113)/.408/.504/.912 in his last 27 games and .393 (33-for-84) with 1.004 OPS over his last 20 games. He has six games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .355 average on the season, which is fourth in Double-A and the best in the Texas Rangers organization.

## THE VIPER STRIKES AGAIN:

Known as "The Viper" since his college days at Alabama, Frisco reliever **Chase Lee** has struck quickly and often this season. Over his 12 outings, Lee has allowed just four hits (.093 BAA) while not allowing a run and going 3-for-3 in save opportunities. In his 13.1 innings, Lee has whiffed 16 while walking just six. Lee spurs a bullpen that is the best in the Texas League in ERA (3.96) and BAA (.202).

## ALLOW ME TO REINTRODUCE MYSELF:

Riders reliever **Seth Nordlin** has been strong out of the bullpen. Ever since his first game of the season when he allowed four runs, Nordlin has gone 2-0 with a 1.25 ERA over 21.2 IP. During that span, opponents are just hitting .139 (10-for-72) against him while he has whiffed 23 and walked six. Over his last three outings, Nordlin has just surrendered one earned run over 10.2 innings with 13 strikeouts and one walk.

## REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 986 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

#### ABOUT ZAK

-Grew up never playing travel ball, always played Little League baseball and never started on the All-Star teams. After making the varsity team his freshman year at Northumberland High School, he was cut. He was "heartbroken" and wanted to prove to everyone that he could play varsity. Made the team his sophomore season, playing third and pitching, but pitching was his passion.

-Around midway through his SO year in HS, decided he wanted to play in college, so decided to try travel ball. During his first time with the Richmond Braves, he was cut after the tryout. Mom encouraged him to tryout again in two weeks and made the team.

-Mom went to Liberty, so he wanted to go there, but went to camp and saw players that were a lot better than him when he was a junior. Went to a showcase and was the last one to throw. VMI was the only school interested and Kent only said he wanted to go there when he heard they were D1. At the time, he was only throwing 82-84 on a good day, but had a high spin rate. Played QB on football team in HS for three years and lettered one year in golf

-Pfeiffer (D2) was only other team that recruited him.

-At VMI, finished 2019 season 5-5 with a 4.64 ERA, striking out 132 over 97.0 innings while walking just 30. Those strikeouts led the Southern Conference and was ninth in the nation (also a school record). Was second in the country in strikeouts at the end of the regular season, but was passed when others pitched in the postseason.

-Teammates with Josh Winder (started 2021 season with Wichita Wind Surge) at VMI. He was a big inspiration to Kent throughout his career.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-In first start at San Antonio, threw four innings, allowing three runs before being placed on the 7-Day Injured List.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Finished third among Rangers farmhands in strikeout rate (31.9 percent), only behind Avery Weems (34.5) and Cole Winn (32.2).

-Began season in the bullpen, throwing five-straight scoreless outings (18.2 IP, 10 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 26 K) before transitioning into a starting role with Hickory.

-As a starter, went 4-2 with a 4.10 ERA over nine starts, but finished out time with Crawdads with best start on August 5th against Greensboro: 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 13 K. Won High-A Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

-In Double-A debut, threw first career complete game in game one of the doubleheader at Northwest Arkansas, but took the loss in a 1-0 game. Kent went 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on a solo home run, ceding three hits while striking out seven and walking two.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Tied with Cody Bradford for most strikeouts in the Fall Developmental League (25 K/17.0 IP) among Rangers farmhands.

#### 2019 SEASON

-Though he started seven games, he never pitched more than three innings in a game.

-Finished last eight outings, six starts, with a 0-1 record and 3.45 ERA.
