**LAST TIME OUT:** Jersey Shore captured game two of the three-game set on Saturday afternoon, 8-6, over Brooklyn...The BlueClaws picked up three runs in second and another four in the fourth to force Sunday's rubber match...C **Kevin Parada** smashed a 391-foot solo home run for the 'Clones in the third and added a 109-mph single to left in the fourth...2B **Kevin Kendall** and SS **César Berbesi** added multi-hit games for Brooklyn, as well...LF **Troy Schreffler** swiped four bags for Jersey Shore.

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate comes to Brooklyn to open the 2023 season. The BlueClaws boast two of Philly's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*, including INF **Hao Yu Lee** (No. 6) and RHP **Tommy McCollum Jr.** (29)...Brooklyn dominated the season series vs. Jersey Shore in 2022, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones were 10-2 against the BlueClaws at Maimonides Park.

**SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:** LHP **Quinn Brodey** and RHP **Manny Rodriguez** made their Cyclones pitching debuts on Saturday afternoon...Brodey yielded one run on one hit, striking out a pair, in 2.1 innings...Rodriguez did not permit a hit or run over 1.2 frames...As an outfielder, Brodey led Brooklyn in RBI (30) in 2017...Rodriguez appeared in 51 games as a shortstop with the franchise in 2018.

**'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

**LIGHT IT UP:** Through the first two games of the 2023 season, the Cyclones offense has been a tornado of production...Brooklyn has tallied 15 runs through the first pair of contests this spring...That total is the most for the franchise through the first two games of the season dating back to the 2005 campaign...The 'Clones tallied 14 runs in the initial two contests of 2010 season at and vs. Staten Island on June 18 and 19.

**NEW DRAFT CLASS:** The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

**PATIENT PALMER:** INF **Jaylen Palmer** drew four walks in Friday's victory over Jersey Shore...Oddly enough, that is not the first time the Brooklyn native has done just that...Palmer also drew four free passes in a 2021 game with Single-A St. Lucie against Daytona... Palmer is the first Cyclones player to have a four walk game since **Nic Gaddis** did last season, also against Jersey Shore, on July 22.

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**2022 IN REVIEW:** The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

**CANARSIE TO CONEY:** INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

**SOARING EAGLE:** Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after red-shirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

**NEW ROLE:** Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 2nd professional start on Sunday...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

**SUMMER NIGHTS:** The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.
