Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, finishing a nine-game road trip that began with winning two of three at Fort Wayne. The Nuts are 11-6 this season against Lake County, 7-4 at Classic Auto Group Park, losing the first two games of this series before winning the last three nights.

Last Night: Lugnuts 2, Captains 1. **Jake Garland** recorded his first quality start of the year, allowing only three hits, two walks and a sixth-inning run, and **Garrett Irvin** and **Colton Johnson** combined for scoreless relief to lift the Nuts to a third straight victory over the Caps. Lansing's only tallies were unearned, thanks to costly Lake County errors in the fourth and fifth innings.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, **Adam Jaksa** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

On Deck: Tomorrow begins the four-day Major League Baseball All-Star Break, then the Nuts welcome in the Great Lakes Loons from July 19-21.

LUG NOTES

Draft Day(s): The Oakland Athletics will select 4th and 40th tonight, their first two selections of 21 in the 2024 Rule 4 Draft. The active Lugnuts roster includes five draftees from 2023, three from 2022, five from 2021 and one from 2019. Last year, Lansing received the A's first-round (**Jacob Wilson**) and 17th-round (**Colby Halter**) following the draft.

Streaking: **Euribiel Ángeles** enters today on a ten-game hitting streak, two games shy of his season-high/team-high streak from June. **Will Simpson** comes in with a 16-game on-base streak, one game shy of his own season high from April and two games shy of **Cameron Masterman's** team-high 18-game streak spanning April and May.

The Future was Yesterday: Lugnuts right-hander **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the team, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on Saturday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, plunking Dylan Crews, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos, and walking Great Lakes' **Thayron Liranzo** before departing in favor of Quad Cities' **Ben Kudrna**, who stranded the runners.

All-Star Alumni: On Tuesday, the Lugnuts will be represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**; for Vladdy, this is his fourth consecutive All-Star nod while rookie Miller makes his first All-Star appearance, continuing a stellar first full season that has him in Rookie of the Year conversations.

Prospecting: Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Oakland Athletics prospects on its roster: starting pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), slugging corner infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 24), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27), and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

What a Crowd! The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in the Midwest League this season, leading all High-A single game attendances this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: The Lugnuts were swept in a doubleheader, 3-2 and 1-0, at Peoria. Game 2 saw the Lugnuts' Jordan Romano and Josh DeGraaf pitch a six-inning no-hitter, the second no-hitter in franchise history, but a leadoff walk to Craig Aikin, a sacrifice bunt/DeGraaf fielding error, a fielder's choice and an Eli Alvarez sacrifice fly in the bottom of the sixth gave the Chiefs the game's only run. Romano had pitched five innings, striking out five batters, before leaving one batter into the sixth due to precautionary reasons after issuing his second walk

2019: In a prospect matchup, the Lugnuts' Eric Pardo fired five scoreless innings, the host Cedar Rapids Kernels' Kai-Wei Teng tossed six scoreless innings... and the Lugnuts' Hagen Danner bashed a two-run homer in the seventh for a 2-0 win at Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium.

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Lugnuts Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, June 2, after promotion from Stockton, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Most Recently: Tossed two effortless innings against Fort Wayne, allowing only a two-out first-inning single to Romeo Sanabria while striking out one... worked perfect 2nd... 30 pitches, 19 strikes... Lugnuts went on to build a 6-0 lead and win 7-5.

Temporarily Inactive List: Inactive from June 28-July 4, returning to Taiwan in connection to compulsory military enlistment.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).

Path to Lansing: Pitched at National Taiwan Sport University, signing with the Athletics in November 2021 for approx. \$500,000... debuted in 2022 with Stockton, making eight starts from April 12 - June 1, 2022... did not pitch again until April 10, 2024, a hiatus of 679 days between professional appearances... excelled with Stockton this season, never allowing more than one run in an appearance... of nine total appearances with the Ports, did not walk a batter in seven of them.

"We received more information regarding this naming arrangement issue. According to the representative from the A's organisation, they are fully aware of the double-barrelled family name... the player's family decided to go with the "Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang" format. He will be known in English romanisation as Chen Zhang-Ao (given name) Zhuang (family name)."

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, infielder Casey Yamauchi and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3... notable splits:

History: On June 13, relieved Jake Garland beginning in the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since 2003.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.
