LAST GAME

The Baysox capped off their series with the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday afternoon, falling by a 14-10 final. Bowie plated four runs in the bottom of the first via a Hudson Haskin RBI double, along with RBI singles from Donta' Williams and Anthony Servideo. Bowie, however, ran into an out on the base paths, when Romero sprinted to an already occupied third base on the Servideo single, leading to Williams being tagged out, and preventing the Baysox from doing any further damage in the frame. Right-handed starter Garrett Stallings went four innings, allowing all three of his earned runs in the outing on a second inning three-run home run by Frankie Tostado to make the score 4-3. A Coby Mayo RBI double gave the Baysox a 5-3 edge in the fourth, but momentum shifted in the fifth inning. Right-hander Peter Van Loon entered for Bowie and allowed two home runs in the frame, a solo shot to James Wood and a grand slam to Brady Lindsy, to give Harrisburg an 8-5 edge, while only recording two outs in the process. Harrisburg scored three more runs against right-hander Kade Strowd in the sixth to make it 11-5, before the Baysox had a five-run frame of their own in the seventh. John Rhodes kicked off the scoring with an RBI single, before both Williams and Servideo doubled to extend their RBI totals on the day to three and two respectively. Kjerstad would single home a run to make it 11-10, but that's all the closer Bowie would get, as Blake Rutherford launched a solo shot, alongside a two-run homer from Donovan Casey, in the eighth inning off right-hander Wandisson Charles to seal the victory for the Senators.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter this week with a record of 29-22 - one-game ahead of Altoona atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, Erie has won eight of its last 10 games, including taking five of six against Richmond this past week. Erie is 21-9 since entering their series with the Baysox back in the beginning of May, where they took four of six in Bowie. The SeaWolves have not lost a series in that span, and outscored opponents 209-118, after entering the series with Bowie last month holding the worst run differential in the league at -51. No. 2 Tigers/No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads an Erie offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.773) and home runs (61). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.321) and hits (61), while sitting third in OPS (.959) and extra-base hits (24) and was named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Erie looks to open the series by handing the ball to left-hander Brant Hurter. The No. 21 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, Hurter owns the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (2.31) with the fourth-most strikeouts (55) across 46.2 innings. Hurter is coming off a season-long six innings against Richmond this past Wednesday, where he took a no-decision after allowing three earned runs on six hits, including his third and fourth home runs allowed on the season. However, the southpaw allowed no walks and struck out a season-high nine batters. Hurter was tagged for a season-high six runs last time out against Bowie on Sunday 5/7, where he took his only loss of the season, as the Baysox peppered him with eight hits, including home runs from Billy Cook and Gilbert Lara, across 4.2 innings. Hurter did feature earlier that week, on Tuesday 5/2, and got the win against Bowie after tossing five innings and allowing just one, unearned run, on three hits with seven strikeouts. Originally a 7th round pick by Detroit in the 2021 draft out of Georgia Tech, Hurter's arsenal features a low-mid-90s sinker, a mid-80s slider, and a changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 18 doubles and is second with 26 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has doubled in six of his last eight games, and has at least one extra-base hit in 11 of his last 14 contests. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 25 RBI, 28 walks, and a .899 OPS. He is in the midst of a 20-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 22 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29).

SLIPPING UP

After committing seven errors in the past six games, the Baysox continue to lead Double-A with 53 errors this season. Last year, Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors in a full 138-game season, and an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 150 total errors in 2023. The Baysox have committed three or more errors in a game on six different occasions this season.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 64 hits and a .348 average. Prieto has hit safely in 40 of 47 games this season, with 18 multi-hit games, and six games with at least three hits. Prieto has struggled a bit as of late, with three of his hitless contests coming in the past two weeks, where he has hit just .225 (9-for-40). However, the No. 16 Orioles' prospect still leads the Baysox with a .397 on-base percentage.

DONTA' DAZZLES

OF Donta' Williams has hits in six straight, and eight of his past nine games for the first time in his professional career. After a 4-for-51 stretch (.078) in the beginning of May, Williams is 13-for-27 (.481) with a pair of home runs, five doubles, and 11 RBI in his last nine starts. Williams matched a career-high with three hits twice this past week against Harrisburg, after having just four three-hit contests in the first 147 games of his career. Williams has also shown improved plate discipline, with seven walks in his last nine games, helping his on-base percentage jump 75 points during the stretch.

- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft. Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- 4/12 Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- 4/18 Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped out his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- 4/25 Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- 5/2 Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- 5/7 Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- 5/13 Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 5/19 **12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning)** Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hoffman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
- 5/26 For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.
- 5/31 Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.
