This is also the last game in a 12-game, 13-day homestand; the Nuts are 6-5 thus far, taking four of six from Fort Wayne and losing three of five to Lake County.

Yesterday: Picantes 3, Locos 1. In a special Copa matinee, Lake County rallied for three runs in the top of the ninth inning against Mark Adamiak to stun Lansing in front of 4,209 fans. The result spoiled a phenomenal start from Grant Judkins, who twirled six scoreless innings and allowed only two singles.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Lugnuts open a six-game series at West Michigan on Tuesday while the GLIAC Tournament takes over Jackson® Field™ from May 8-11. The Nuts return home May 13-18, welcoming in the South Bend Cubs.

Atop the League: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.276), base hits (235), total bases (341), fewest strikeouts (170), on-base percentage (.378) and OPS (.778). The Nuts also rank second in slugging percentage (.400).

Torrid Tommy: Third baseman **Tommy White** went 1-for-3 yesterday to extend his hitting streak to 17 games and his onbase streak to 19 games.

Streaks Stopped: Clark Elliott (0-for-3, sac fly yesterday) and T.J. Schofield-Sam (0-for-4) had their on-base streaks end at 18 and 16 games respectively in yesterday's loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 28.

Quality: Grant Judkins turned in his second quality start of the season yesterday with six scoreless innings, adding the latest strong performance to the Lugnuts' rotational excellence. **Yunior Tur** allowed one run in 5 1/3 innings on Tuesday, **Kyle Robinson** fired six hitless innings on Wednesday and **Gage Jump** was one single away from five perfect innings on Thursday, giving the Lugnuts strong candidates to secure their first Midwest League Pitcher of the Week award.

May 4th in Lugnuts History

2017: Rowdy Tellez sets the Brewers' single game record with 8 RBIs in an 18-4 win over the Reds, including a 453-foot grand slam and 431-foot two-run HR.

2024: Pedro Ramirez slugged a go-ahead three-run homer in the top of the ninth, and the South Bend Cubs shocked the Lugnuts, 7-6. Lansing had built leads of 4-1 and 6-4, only to see the Cubs rally for their fourth win in five games. The eighth inning was wild enough, featuring consecutive plays that saw each team's manager get thrown out of the game. With the Lugnuts leading 4-3 and Cubs at first and second with one out, James González appeared to have cleanly picked off Yohendrick Piñango from second base. But bases umpire Evan Anderson ruled Piñango safe, thumbing out Lansing manager Craig Conklin for disagreeing. Parker Chavers followed with a single to left field and Piñango attempted to score the game-tying run, only to be ruled out at the plate on a relay from third baseman Dereck Salom. Cubs manager Nick Loyullo was kicked out by home plate umpire Travis Roberson in the resulting argument. Dylan Hall replaced González and gave up a true game-tying single to Felix Stevens before retiring the side. The Lugnuts quickly retook a two-run lead in the bottom of the eighth thanks to RBI singles from Euribiel Angeles and Salom. But in the ninth inning, Hall walked Brian Kalmer, allowed a single to Ed Howard, and coaxed a fielder's choice from Brett Bateman to put runners at the corners with one out for Ramirez. The South Bend second baseman lined a 2-0 delivery over the top of the right field ribbon board and a leaping Brayan Buelvas, catapulting the Cubs into the lead

Last Game: Started the first game of this series, on Tuesday, April 29, and tossed 5 1/3 innings, allowing one run on four hits and two walks with one strikeout... 86 pitches, 54 strikes (after using exactly 87 pitches / 54 strikes in the prior two starts - consistency!)... but the Captains broke a 1-1 tie with six runs in the 8th against Jake Garland and six runs in the 9th off Yehizon Sanchez for a 13-5 win.

In a Nutshell: Making his Lugnuts debut this season... only native Cuban on the team... noted for mid-90s fastball / split-changeup combo... one of three pitchers on the roster standing at least 6-foot-6 or taller (Kyle Robinson, Jake Pfennigs)... looking to become second ever Major Leaguer named Yunior (joining Santo Domingo native Yunior Marte, who spent last season in the Phillies' pen).

Hometown Hero: Though born in La Habana, Yunior grew up in Santiago de Cuba, which also produced such notable Major Leaguers as Bárbaro Garbey, Adeiny Hechavarría and Orestes Destrade

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

2024 - Back to Stockton: Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; curiously, these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Ports in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
