#### WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

In a commanding win for Fredericksburg, their offense tacked on 24 runs. They are one of only seven teams this year to score 24 or more runs in a single game across all professional baseball.

**R SPLIT DECISION:** The Rochester Red Wings and Syracuse Mets squared off for a doubleheader Friday at NBT Bank Stadium, with the Wings taking game one, 5-0, before falling in extra innings in the nightcap, 7-4...RHP **ISAAC LYON** fired 5.0 scoreless innings to lead Rochester to a shutout victory in the opener...INF **TREY LIPSCOMB** provided a historic swing in game two, launching his 30th home run of the season to become the first Red Wing to reach the mark since Terry Crowley in 1977.

**R THIRTY SOMETHING:** INF **TREY LIPSCOMB** became the first Red Wing to reach 30 home runs in a season since Terry Crowley in 1977, connecting for a two-run shot in the fifth inning of Friday's nightcap... the Maryland native ranks second in the International League behind Memphis' Joshua Báez (34)... his 30 homers this season equal his combined Minor League total from 2022-25, and double the 15 he hit across his first two Rochester seasons... through 60 second-half games, he is batting .327 (81-for-248) with 17 homers, 51 RBI and a .941 OPS, compared with .251, 13 homers and 36 RBI in 60 first-half contests.

**R LYON'S SHARE:** RHP **ISAAC LYON** earned his first Triple-A victory in his second start at the level, working 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits, one walk and five strikeouts in Friday's opener... he needed just 63 pitches, including 39 strikes, while facing 17 batters... the 22-year-old has allowed four hits and two earned runs in 8.2 innings with Rochester, posting a 2.08 ERA, 0.81 WHIP and .138 opponents' average... Lyon has climbed from Low-A Fredericksburg through High-A Wilmington to Double-A Harrisburg and finally to Rochester this season, going 9-5 with a 3.17 ERA and 99 strikeouts in 110.2 innings across the four affiliates.

**R WALL-TO-WALL HITS:** INF **CAYDEN WALLACE** collected a hit in both games Friday to extend his hitting streak to 12 games, dating to August 22, 2026... during the stretch, he is batting .432 (19-for-44) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI and six multi-hit performances... he has reached base at a .500 clip and slugged .818, good for a 1.318 OPS... the streak has lifted his Rochester batting average from .246 to .294... Wallace has also gone four consecutive games without striking out, covering all 16 of his plate appearances in September.

**R THE RILEY ROCKET:** C **RILEY ADAMS** launched a 443-foot, two-run homer at 112.5 mph in the eighth inning of Friday's nightcap, giving Rochester a temporary 4-2 lead... his 15th homer established a Minor League single-season career high, surpassing the 14 he hit between Duncedin and New Hampshire in 2019... Adams finished 1-for-3 with a walk and owns a .276/.388/.524 batting line and .912 OPS through 69 games with Rochester... he is homering once every 15.0 at-bats (15 HR/225 AB).

**R** The veteran catcher is slashing .344/.454/.678 with seven home runs and 17 RBI in 90 career at-bats against the Syracuse Mets.

**R A GLASS ACT:** RHP **JOE GLASSEY** made his Triple-A debut in Friday's nightcap, allowing one hit without a walk and striking out one in a scoreless fourth inning... Promoted earlier that day, he arrived after allowing just one hit and one walk across 11.0 scoreless innings in 10 Harrisburg appearances... Glassey has now gone 17 consecutive appearances without allowing a run, spanning 18.1 innings since July 12, 2026, with Frederick, Chesapeake, Harrisburg, and Rochester... he has yielded six hits and one walk while striking out 22 during that stretch. His full-season line features a 1.90 ERA and 66 strikeouts against nine walks in 42.2 innings.

**R ZERO TOLERANCE:** RHP **ISAAC LYON**, RHP **KYLE NICOLAS**, and RHP **PAXTON SCHULTZ** combined on a three-hit shutout in Friday's opener, striking out nine against one walk while using 97 total pitches. Nicolas struck out all three batters he faced in the sixth... Rochester also held Syracuse scoreless through four innings of game two, opening the doubleheader with 11 consecutive scoreless frames... across the two games' 14 regulation innings, Red Wings pitchers allowed just two runs on seven hits, with 17 strikeouts and one walk; Syracuse scored its other five runs in extra innings.

**R ON THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...1952:** LHP **JACKIE COLLUM** threw a nine-inning no-hitter in Rochester's 9-0 victory over the Ottawa Athletics, striking out seven and walking one... Collum retired the first 22 batters before issuing an eighth-inning walk, with a ninth-inning error accounting for Ottawa's only other baserunner... the performance marked Rochester's first no-hitter since Blix Donnelly's in 1943 and helped the Wings sweep a doubleheader during their push toward the postseason... Rochester would finish the year with both the International League and Junior World Series championships.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he signed as a minor-league free agent on 3/31/2026...originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft, out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024 and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on 5/7/2023.

- Slated to make his 18th start and 26th appearance in tonight's contest against Syracuse... among all qualified pitchers in the International League, he is second in WHIP (1.07). Fourth in BAA (.243), second in ERA (3.76), and seventh in innings pitched (105.2).
- Picked up his sixth win of the season and 30th of his professional career on 7/11 at Worcester, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth before finishing with 6.0 full, one-hit innings while allowing one earned run with three strikeouts and a pair of walks.
- Across three Saturday games this season (2 GS), the soon-to-be 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP), a 0.47 WHIP, .104 BAA, and a BB/9 of 1.20.
- Recorded his 500th career strikeout on 6/9 vs. Worcester.
- Made his 100th career start in game two of a doubleheader on 4/17 vs. Buffalo.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4, without appearing in a game.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (204 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.
- Finished the season with three consecutive scoreless appearances in relief, combining to allow four hits with six strikeouts and no walks across 6.0 innings.
