TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Reading Fightin Phils. Altoona last played the Fightin's in 2023 and went 6-5.

Former Indiana Hoosier (19-22) and Lipscomb Bison (2023), Braydon Tucker takes the ball for Reading tonight. A Brazil, Ind. native, Tucker makes his Double-A debut with the Fightins tonight. Tucker went 4-3 with a 3.19 ERA in 19 games, 12 starts, for High-A Jersey Shore to begin the season. He works with a low-90's sinker, slider, curveball and change-up.

A TALL CENTER FIELDER: Pirates OF Oneil Cruz joined the Curve to begin a Major League rehab assignment on Saturday, August 23. Cruz is the third Pirates minor leaguer to rehab with Altoona this year, joining INF **Spencer Horwitz** and RHP **Johan Oviedo.** Cruz, who was placed on the 7-Day Concussion injured list on August 13, is batting .207 with 17 2B, 2 3B, 18 HR, 41 RBI and career-best 34 stolen bases in 108 games with the Pirates this season. His 34 stolen bases lead the National League entering play on Saturday. Cruz, who batted .285 with 23 2B, 8 3B, 13 HR, 57 RBI and 21 SB in his 97 games with Altoona across the 2019 and 2021 seasons, became the tallest position player to ever play for the Curve when he joined the team in August of 2019. Cruz was named a Double-A Northeast League Post-Season All-Star in 2021, the same season that he became the tallest player to start a major league game at shortstop.

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder **Mitch Jebb** has picked up at least two hits in each of the first three games of Altoona's series with Reading. In his last 16 games, he's batting .344 (22-for-64) with a .413 on-base percentage, 5 2B and 7 RBI. In that time-frame, Jebb has bumped his season batting average from .252 to .270. Jebb is hitting .349 in 16 games this month.

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, **Konnor Griffin**, joined the Curve on Monday, August 18. Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, he is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since Paul Skenes in 2023. At the time of his promotion, Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (2nd, 98), stolen bases (9th, 60), hits (4th, 137), and batting average. (3rd, .329).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg. and Hickory.

POSTSEASON CURVE: With 20 games remaining in the Second Half, Altoona holds a 1.0 game lead over Harrisburg in the Southwest Division. The Curve were last in the postseason in 2018 when they fell to the Akron RubberDucks in the Division Series.

NICK AT NIGHT: First baseman Nick Cimillo has returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 26 games, he's batting .258 with 17 extra base hits (.986 OPS). In that time he ranks 2nd among Double-A players in HR (9), and XBH (17), 4th in SLG% (.629) and 7th in OPS (.986).

DUUUUUUCE: Infielder **Duce Gourson**'s last two homers have come in clutch spots. After swatting a game-tying shot on August 8 in the bottom of the 9th against Hartford, Gourson smacked a go-ahead 3-run homer on Tuesday, August 18 at Richmond. With the Curve down to their final out, Gourson rocked his third hit of the game to take a 7-4 lead in an exhitarating comeback win for the Curve. Gourson is 19-for-48 (.396) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI and 12 BB in his last 14 games (since August 7).

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly has become one of the top pitching prospects in the Pirates minor league system. The 21-year-old holds a 1.00 WHIP between Greensboro and Altoona which ranks 8th among qualified minor league pitchers. The Aruban righty has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 19-of-23 starts this year. He's totaled 112 strikeouts this season, 3rd-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 121), just behind teammate Wilber Dotel (115).

SO YOU LIKE PLAYING ALTOONA?: Nine players this season have earned an Eastern League weekly or monthly award immediately after playing the Curve. CJ Kayfus (Akron, 4/13), Brandon Beck (Somerset, 4/20), Blaze Jordan (Portland, May Player of the Month), David Sandlin (Portland, 6/1), Rafael Sanchez (New Hampshire, 6/8), Trey Gibson (Chesapeake, 7/27), Max Ferguson (Portland, 8/3), Sean Sullivan (Hartford August 11) have all taken home weekly awards after playing Altoona. **Hunter Barco** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (April 27) and Pitcher of the Month in April to account for Altoona's only honors this season.

CLOSE WINS: 23 of Altoona's last 29 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 57 of the team's 116 games this year (48%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and joins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
