YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels won the series opener, 7-3, over the Baysox. **Casey Schmitt** scored on a wild pitch in the second to give Richmond a 1-0 lead. In the third, **Will Wilson** worked a bases-loaded walk, Schmitt hit a two-run single and **Tristan Peters** brought in a run with a groundout to open a 5-0 lead. Bowie scored two runs in the fifth and one in the seventh to close the score to 5-3. In the eighth, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run homer to open a 7-3 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with two wins in three games at Bowie from April 8-10. From April 26-May 1 at The Diamond, Richmond won five-of-six against Bowie. In the first series of the second half, Richmond dropped five-of-six at Prince George's Stadium from June 28-July 3. The Baysox won two-of-three at The Diamond coming out of the mid-season break from July 22-24.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 20-37 in the second half. They are 14-29 in the last 43 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 10 and split five this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,375 strikeouts, the most in the history of the Eastern League, and rank third with 152 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 27-37 on the road this year. Richmond is 25-24 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE BAYSOX are tied for first place in the Western Division in the second half with 11 games remaining. Last week, the Baysox split a six-game series on the road against the SeaWolves. It was the only set between the two teams in the second half. If the Baysox and the SeaWolves finish the regular season tied, the team with the best record over its final 20 games will advance to the Eastern League playoffs. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including RHP Grayson Rodriguez (No. 2, No. 4 overall - on MLB rehab assignment), 3B Coby Mayo (No. 7), 2B Connor Norby (No. 12), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 14), LHP Cade Povich (No. 15), SS Darell Hernaiz (No. 18), INF Cesar Prieto (No. 21), OF John Rhodes (No. 23 - on IL) and OF Hudson Haskin (No. 24).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his 24th start of the season and his fourth against the Baysox. He last pitched on Thursday against the Senators and allowed four runs over 5.1 innings in a no-decision. He first faced the Baysox on April 30 at The Diamond and allowed one run in 3.1 innings. On June 29, he allowed a career-high 10 runs over 4.1 innings in a loss at Bowie. He faced the Baysox a third time on July 22 and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings. In his last six outings since August 4, Frisbee has recorded 44 strikeouts in 33.1 innings. On August 10 at Portland, he set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts, earning Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Justin Armbruster makes his ninth Double-A start of the year and his fourth outing against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday at Erie and allowed three runs over three innings. He made his Baysox home debut against the Flying Squirrels and June 28 and worked four scoreless innings. He pitched the finale of that series on July 3 out of the bullpen and allowed one run in four innings. He also started at The Diamond on July 24 and surrendered three runs in four innings. For the year, Armbruster has posted a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP) against Richmond. He was selected in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of the University of New Mexico. After beginning this season with High-A Aberdeen, Armbruster was promoted to Double-A Bowie on June 21.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,140) and rank second in total attendance (368,407). Richmond is 15th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 152 home runs this season, which is third in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 165 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 25 homers on the season, with 21 coming at The Diamond.

RELYING ON THE LONGBALL: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have scored 261-of-their-586 runs on homers. At 44.53 percent, they have the second-highest total of their runs scored on the year on homers in the Eastern League, trailing Somerset (48.16 percent, 301-of-625 runs). **Will Wilson** has picked up 81.0 percent (17-of-21) of his Double-A RBIs on home runs this year. **Sean Roby** has driven in 65.5 percent (36-of-55) and **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 56.9 percent (33-of-58) of their RBIs on home runs.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .383 (31-for-81) with two homers, nine doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs in his last 20 games since August 11. On Thursday, he homered twice and drove in four runs. On Friday, he collected three hits, including two doubles, and drove in three runs. In last week's series against the Senators, Schmitt hit .444 (8-for-18) with two homers, three doubles, two walks and seven RBIs.

SMITH STREAKING: **Armani Smith** is currently riding a 26-game on-base streak since July 29, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also now the longest on-base streak for a Richmond player this year, ahead of a 24-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .250 (23-for-92) with three doubles, a homer, seven RBIs and 20 walks. Smith's current on-base streak is the fifth-longest in the Eastern League in 2022. Smith has the Flying Squirrels' longest on-base streak since 2013 and the fifth-longest in franchise history.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar**'s previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 25 by **Sean Roby** this year. Over his last 32 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .323 (41-for-127) with six homers, eight doubles, one triple and 23 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .234. He is batting .381 (8-for-21) with two doubles in his last five games since Thursday.

BRAND NEW MAN: **Will Wilson** returned to action late last month after missing nearly three months with a broken hamate. After a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League, Wilson was assigned to Richmond on August 24. He hit .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games back with Richmond. Over his last five games, Wilson is batting .389 (7-for-18) with four walks and three RBIs. He picked up three hits and drove in two runs on Saturday night.

SHANE TRAIN: On Tuesday night, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run homer against the Baysox. It was his 12th Double-A homer of the season and his fifth against the Baysox. He hit two homers in a win over Bowie on May 1 at The Diamond. He added homers in back-to-back games played on June 28 and June 30 at Prince George's Stadium. After going 20 games without a homer from August 6-September 2, Matheny has homered twice in his last three games since Saturday.

SAY HEY: **Jacob Heyward** saw his 19-game on-base streak end with an 0-for-4 game on Saturday night. In that span, he hit .241 (14-for-58) with 13 walks. He has extended his career franchise record to 154 walks. Heyward has homered four times in his last 17 games, giving him 30 for his Richmond career, which is tied for the second-most homers in franchise history with **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14), trailing only 37 by **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is tied for third in homers (25) and ranks eighth in SLG (.481). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for seventh in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is 10th in homers (21) and tied for fifth in runs scored (69). **Shane Matheny** is third in OBP (.382) and ninth in walks (53). **Ryan Walker** is tied for seventh in games pitched (41). **Matt Frisbee** is ninth in ERA (5.23), seventh in strikeouts (116), tied for third in games started (23), second in innings pitched (125.2) and ninth in WHIP (1.34).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: In the Eastern League, Hudson Haskin is seventh in OBP (.366) and ninth in OPS (.825). **Joey Ortiz** is tied for eighth in RBIs (71), tied for fourth in hits (117), tied for third in doubles (28), seventh in extra-base hits (47), seventh in total bases (198) and tied for fifth in runs scored (69).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (2), **Vaun Brown** (10), **Ryan Murphy** (15 - on IL), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Murphy (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), **Will Wilson** (26) and **Landen Roupp** (28). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
