SEAGER DOUBLES, BUT FRISCO FALLS IN FIFTH STRAIGHT:

Grey Seager scored two runs on a double and the Frisco RoughRiders got five shutout innings from Jack Leiter but couldn't hold off the Wichita Wind Surge on Thursday night in an 8-6 loss at Riders Field. In the second at-bat of his rehab assignment, Seager ripped a ball down the right field line to score Scott Kapers and Kellen Strahm, providing a 2-0 lead in the third inning. Frisco (13-17) led 5-2 in the seventh inning but Wichita (13-17) tied the score in the seventh and took the lead in the ninth. Seager went 1-for-3 in the ballgame with two fly-outs. He played the first five innings of the game before exiting. Seager is slated to return with the RoughRiders tomorrow in Frisco to continue his rehab assignment. Leiter allowed just two hits in his five innings, walked two and tied his career high with eight strikeouts. It was the second consecutive start without an earned run for Leiter, who has gone 13 straight innings without a run charged to him. After Leiter exited the game, Wichita stormed back from a 4-1 deficit. **John Matthews** (1-1) allowed the go-ahead run in the ninth inning, while Michael Boyle (1-0) earned the win by pitching the final 2.2 innings. Frisco made it close in the ninth with a leadoff home run by **Dustin Harris**, who totaled three hits on the evening. **Liam Hicks** singled to bring the tying run to the plate but Frisco never pulled closer. Hicks also walked three times on Thursday, his second game at the Double-A level. **Luisangel Acuña** and **Scott Kapers** both homered on Thursday, each on solo long balls in the fifth and sixth innings, respectively. Frisco committed a franchise record-tying seven errors in the ballgame. Wichita has won the first three games of the series, sending Frisco to a five-game losing streak.

The RoughRiders are expected to host their second rehabbing Texas Rangers player this season in the form of Rangers shortstop Corey Seager beginning on Thursday. Seager, who was signed by the Rangers as a free agent prior to the 2022 season, was placed on the 10-day injured list with a hamstring strain on April 12th. To begin the season, Seager was hitting 359/.469/.538/1.008 with a home run and 4 RBIs over 11 games prior to the injury. The three-time All-Star, two-time Silver Slugger and 2016 National League Rookie of the Year began his career with the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2015. In 2020, Seager helped the Dodgers to their first World Series championship since 1988 with MVP performances in both the NLCS and the World Series, clubbing a combined seven home runs between the two series. In his first season with the Rangers, Seager set an MLB record for the most home runs by a left-handed hitting shortstop with 33. He was named to the American League All-Star Team. When coming up through the Dodgers organization, Seager played 38 games with Double-A Chattanooga in 2014 and 20 games with Double-A Tallsa in 2015, batting, 355/390/.583/.973 with seven home runs and 42 RBIs over his 58 combined contests. On Thursday, Seager went 1-for-3 with a two-run double.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING HARDWARE:

The RoughRiders had three players honored by their parent club in their April awards. **Evan Carter** won Player of the Month in the org, hitting .343/.500/.543/1.043 with a league-best 21 walks while **Grant Wolfram** earned Reliever of the Month honors by not allowing a run over 9.2 innings with 11 strikeouts. **Luisangel Acuña** anchored the best defensive team in the minors to take home Defender of the Month, playing both shortstop and second base.

Over the last 15 games, Frisco has a 7.21 ERA, which is the second-worst in the Texas League over that stretch. The Riders allowed 18 home runs over that stretch, which is tied for the third-most in the league. The Frisco bullpen had a 7.22 ERA over the last two weeks, ballooning their reliever ERA to 4.99 this season, which is still fifth in the league. After the tough two weeks, Frisco is still sixth in the league with a 5.26 ERA.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .340/.407/.547/.954 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking six times. Over the last 13 games, he has raised his average 113 points and his OPS 290 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .316 (42-for-133)/.374/.474/.848 through the first 30 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (42), tied for fifth in doubles (10), fourth in total bases (63) and second in stolen bases (15). Over his last 26 games, he is batting .339/.403/.522/.925. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (123).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders just committed 12 errors through 29 game, the best in MiLB, but they tied a franchise record with seven errors on Thursday.

On the season, Frisco's 160 walks are first among Double-A teams while their .361 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Evan Carter** has the Double-A lead with 26 walks and Dustin Harris is fourth with 24 (second in the Texas League) while Carter is third in OBP (.444) in the league.

ABOUT OWEN

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school offers at OB).

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MillB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player candidate if he went to South Carolina.

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvila (40, 1199).

2023 SEASON

- -Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com
- -Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.
- -Threw first quality start for RoughRiders pitchers on April 25th at Amarillo, allowing three runs over six innings. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one baserunner on a single through five innings.

2022 SEASON

- -Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
- -Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.
- -Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.
- -With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).
- -Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.
- -Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no hitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself,"
White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me
at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just—
emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.

-Did not see action in the 2018 season after being drafted as part of Rangers "de-load program".

-Missed the entired 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery
