YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 9-4, to open the series. It was their sixth win in the last seven games. Richmond trailed, 4-1, entering the fifth inning. Luis Toribio scored on an error, Jairo Pomares hit an RBI single and Grant McCray followed with an RBI hit to tie the game, 4-4. In the top of the seventh, Will Wilson hit a two-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 6-4 lead. Later in the inning, Victor Bericoto scored on a wild pitch and Andy Thomas added an RBI double to open an 8-4 lead. In the top of the eighth, Pomares reached on an error, scoring Vaun Brown to push the lead to 9-4. Bowie took a 2-0 lead in the first inning on a two-run homer by Jud Fabian. In the top of the second, Thomas cut the score to 2-1 with an RBI single. Frederick Bencosme hit an RBI double in the third and Samuel Basallo hit a solo homer in the fourth to open a 4-1 Baysox lead. Carter Howell went 2-for-3 with two walks and scored twice. McCray had three hits. After allowing the homer to Basallo, Nick Swiney did not surrender a run over the rest of his 2.1 innings out of the Richmond bullpen. Eric Silva threw two scoreless frames and Nick Garcia closed out the game in the ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the second of a six-game series. This is the first of two visits to Bowie for Richmond. They will return for a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from July 1-3. Richmond won four-of-six against Bowie at The Diamond earlier this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-1 in their last seven games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning last Wednesday night, starting a five-game winning streak.

THE BAYSOX are in fourth place in the Southwest Division, 3.5 games behind first-place Akron. They won four-of-six last week at Binghamton. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/IB Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), INF Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright, (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24) and INF Frederick Bencosme (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features 10 Baysox players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 9), Beavers (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 20), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). On Baseball America's "Best Tools" list for Orioles prospects, Basallo is rated as the best power hitter, Pham is rated as having the best control, Bright is rated as having the best curveball, Silas Ardoin is rated as the best defensive catcher and Fabian is rated as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his eighth start of the season and the third of his career against the Baysox. He last faced Bowle on April 26 at The Diamond and worked five hitless innings as the Flying Squirrels took a no-hit bid into the ninth inning. That start was his first Double-A win. In his most recent outing, Birdsong pitched five innings and allowed one unearned run on Thursday against Reading with five strikeouts, lowering his season ERA from 2.49 to 2.08. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 30 IP) this season, Birdsong is ranked third in K/9 (11.9), fourth in strikeout percentage (31.7%) and fifth in ERA (2.08). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. *For more on Birdsong, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Brandon Young makes his sixth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on April 27 and threw three hitless innings with seven strikeouts. Last time out, Young threw 3.1 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts, tying his season high for the third time, at Binghamton on Thursday. Young missed the start of the 2023 season before beginning rehab starts in July. He joined the Baysox in mid-August and went 0-3 with a 4.26 ERA. After signing with the Orioles in 2020 out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels infielder Hayden Cantrelle, he began the 2022 season with Bowie before suffering an injury after three starts and missing the rest of the year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (8,009).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last seven games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .274 (60-for-219) and have scored 39 runs, an average of 5.6 runs per game, which is second in the Eastern League. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win last Wednesday night. In winning six-of-their-last-seven, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 39-19.

STRONG ARMS: Dating back to May 14 in the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels have a 2.44 ERA (16 ER/59.0 IP), which is second-best in the Eastern League. In that span, Richmond starters are 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER/29.1 IP). Flying Squirrels relievers have gone 4-1 with two saves and a 2.12 ERA (7 ER/29.2 IP) in that stretch.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers, three Richmond pitchers rank in the top-XX in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (2nd - 0.86 ERA - 2 ER/21.0 IP), **Nick Garcia** (6th - 1.45 ERA - 3 ER/18.2 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (12th - 1.78 ERA - 5 ER/25.1 IP). Jensen also ranks second the league in relief innings pitched (25.1).

SETTING THE TABLE: Carter Howell is batting .320 (16-for-50) over his last 14 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, nine walks and five runs scored. Last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his nine games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .324 (11-for-34) with two doubles and five walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .379 (11-for-29).

GRANTING WISHES: In his last eight games since May 12, **Grant McCray** is batting .435 (12-for-23) with a homer, four doubles, five walks, five RBIs and nine runs scored, raising his season batting average from .130 to .187. He picked up a season-high three hits on Tuesday night at Bowie. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .474 (9-for-19) when batting fifth or sixth in the order. He is tied for sixth in the Eastern League with 14 extra-base hits this year.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .364 (8-for-22) over his last six games since May 15 with three doubles and five RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .227. Thomas has picked up two hits in three-of-his-last-four games played dating back to the second game of last Thursday's doubleheader and has picked up a double in each of those three games.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
