YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox lost their fifth straight and second straight in extra innings in an 8-7 loss in 10 innings to Hartford on Friday night. **Creed Willems** hit two homers, including a game-tying solo homer in the ninth. **Noelberth Romero** homered and drove in the go-ahead run in the 10th but a two-run homer by Jose Cordova handed the Yard Goats their fifth straight victory.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** recorded his first two homer game of the season last night and the second of his career. The Orioles No. 12 prospect's last two homer game was on August 28, 2024 in Akron, which was just his second Double-A game. Willems has a 1.084 OPS over his last 10 games and remains tied for the league lead in doubles with eight on the regular season. He has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is ninth in the Eastern League in hits (25) and is tied for the league lead in doubles (8) to start the season. Jackson has struck out only 13 times in 103 total plate appearances (12.6% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. **The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.**

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 19 of the 25 games played this season, which is second-most in the Eastern League lead behind Erie. **The Baysox staff has punched out the fourth-most hitters in the league (242) while the bullpen has the third-lowest ERA in the circuit (2.96).** Last night, Chesapeake became the last team in Double-A to blow a save after starting out nine for nine in save opportunities.

WALK THIS WAY

C **Silas Ardoyn** is second in the Eastern League in walks (19). His eight-game on-base streak ended on Friday night after he struck out in a pinch-hit at-bat. The 24-year-old drew nine walks last week against Altoona pitching, which was the most by any Double-A hitter. Ardoyn has drawn 11 walks over his last eight starts.

LATE NIGHT WITH COHEN

RHP **Cohen Achen** makes his first professional start for Chesapeake tonight, which will be his Double-A debut. The 23-year-old has appeared in four games between Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen and has posted a 2.84 ERA in 19.0 innings with 16 strikeouts over seven walks. Achen was drafted by the Orioles in the 14th round of the 2024 Draft out of Lindsey Wilson College, an NAIA school in Columbia, KY.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (76), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with **eight** so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

THE GOATS ARE GOING YARD

The Hartford Yard Goats are the Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The Yard Goats most recently split their road trip in Somerset. Hartford won the first half of the season last year but lost in the Northeast Division Finals to Somerset. Hartford's active roster features five Rockies' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): OF/SS Cole Carrigg (No. 3), OF Benny Montgomery (No. 15), RHP Gabriel Hughes (No. 16), IF Kyle Karros (No. 20) and RHP Jack Mahoney (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Blake Adams makes his fifth start of the season for Hartford. The 24-year-old pitched most of last year in High-A Spokane with a short stint in Hartford and threw the second-most innings in the Rockies system (127.0) and was tied for the third-most strikeouts (125). After a 5.0 scoreless inning season debut, Adams has given up at least three earned runs in each of his last three starts.

2025: Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/3. Began season in Single-A Delmarva. In three long relief outings, went 2-0 with a 3.21 ERA with 14 K over 14 IP. Promoted to High-A Aberdeen on 4/23. Made High-A debut on 4/27 @ WIL and pitched 5.0 innings, allowing 2 R (1 ER) and 1 BB with 2 K in a no decision.

2024: Did not pitch upon being drafted.

Pitched for Lakeshore Chinooks in the Northwoods League in summer of '24 and was named an NWL Postseason All-Star.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
