Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open a two-week homestand with the first of a six-game series with the Quad Cities River Bandits, the High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Today is Tacos and Tallboys: \$4 tacos and \$4 tallboys today, and every Tuesday home game! After Quad Cities departs, Dayton arrives for six next week.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander Jack Perkins, a 2022 fourth-rounder from Indiana who has allowed only one run in his first 10 innings of the year, gets the start for Lansing against River Bandits southpaw Tyson Guerrero, drafted by Kansas City in the 12th round in 2021 from Washington.

Game 1: Lugnuts 2, Captains 1 (9 innings). Lazaro Armenteros broke up Tommy Mace's no-hit bid with a home run leading off the fifth and Joshwan Wright delivered a tie-breaking sacrifice fly in the ninth, the second extra inning, to help the Nuts halt a three-game losing streak at Classic Auto Group Park.

Game 2: Captains 3, Lugnuts 0. Southpaw Ryan Webb struck out eight in 5 2/3 innings, combining with two relievers on a two-hit shutout to help the Caps split the twinbill.

#### Lug•Notes

Inclement Days: Lansing is coming off an unusual weather-affected series in Eastlake, Ohio. The Lugnuts and Lake County Captains were postponed last Tuesday, played nine innings Wednesday, played a doubleheader Thursday, were postponed Friday, postponed again Saturday, and then played a second doubleheader Sunday. In the end, three days with baseball, three days without, a 1-4 record for the Nuts on the road, and one game still needing to be made up (expected to be on Wednesday, May 17, when the Captains visit Lansing.)

Streaking: Outfielder Caeden Trenkle went 1-for-3 with a triple in Sunday's Game 2 and has now reached base in all 12 games he has played this year, collecting 12 hits and 11 walks.

On a Tear-os: Lazaro Armenteros has belted four home runs in his last four games (going 7-for-12 in that span), placing him second in the league behind only Wisconsin's Alex Hall in longballs despite not having enough plate appearances to rank among the league leaders in slugging (.793, which would rank third) or OPS (1.237, which would rank first). Armenteros is also tied for third in the MWL with seven steals.

Power Switch, Flipped On: After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit nine roundtrippers in their last eight games.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts' infield has turned at least one double play in 11 of their 14 games, leading the league with 16 double plays in total. (In contrast, Peoria has turned three double plays all year.)

Clean Baseball: Lansing has committed a league low seven errors through 14 games (four by shortstop Max Muncy), leading to just three unearned runs. On the other side, the Lugnuts' opponent has committed 21 errors: five by Great Lakes in the season-opening three-game series, eight by West Michigan two weeks ago, and eight by Lake County last week.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

2013: Future Astros teammates met, as the Lugnuts' Roberto Osuna whiffed the River Bandits' Carlos Correa three straight at-bats in Davenport, lowa. Osuna struck out eight total in five innings, allowing one hit and one run, while Correa finished 0-for-5 with four strikeouts in a 6-2 Lugnuts victory.

**2019:** Bhe Lugnuts did not fare well in their first meeting with Bowling Green super-prospect Wander Franco, who lined out (on a diving catch by third baseman Johnny Aiello) before singling off the top of the left field wall and homering twice over the left field wall, both opposite-field shots, in a Bowling Green 6-5 victory. The Lugnuts had the potential tying run at third base in Reggie Pruitt with two outs in the ninth, only to see Jordan Groshans ground out to pitcher Chris Muller to end the game.

In a Nutshell: Jack Perkins makes his third Lugnuts start today... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas today), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason), Jack Weisenburger and prospect OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

**Glory Days:** Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

**Study Skills:** Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

**Draft Day:** Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
