GAME TWO: Aberdeen evened the best-of-three series with a 6-1 victory over Brooklyn in Game Two of the North Division Championship Series last night. IronBirds clean-up hitter 1B **TT Bowens** mashed a two-run home run against Cyclones starter RHP **Dominic Hamel** in the bottom of the first, kicking off the big night for the Aberdeen offense. Hamel suffered the loss, allowing five runs on four walks, five hits, and his first allowed home run at High-A. Aberdeen RHP **Peter Van Loon** spun five innings of one-run ball, yielding a solo home run to Brooklyn 3B **William Lugo** in the top of the fifth that made it 5-1. RHP **Connor Gillispie** spun the final four innings scoreless.

PLAYOFF PREVIEW: Tonight wraps up the North Division Championship Series in the best-of-three series with a win-or-go-home Game Three at Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium in Maryland. Aberdeen won the First Half of the North Division with a 43-23 recording, winning by 7.5 games over Wilmington. Brooklyn won the Second Half of the North Division with a 40-26 record, winning by two games over Hudson Valley. The team that wins the series faces the South Division Champion in a three-game series starting Sunday.

RECENT PLAYOFF HISTORY: This season marks Brooklyn's first playoff berth in the South Atlantic League era that began in 2021. Brooklyn won the 2019 New York Penn League Championship in the final year of the league as a Short Season Class A club, clinching the first-ever outright title in the franchise's history. Since 2001, Brooklyn has made the playoffs 11 times, including this year's berth.

PITCHING & DEFENSE: Brooklyn ended the regular season having allowed 510 runs, ranking as the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball and the fewest in the South Atlantic League. Only the Minnesota Twins affiliate, the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels of the Low-A Florida State League allowed

vs. ABERDEEN: The Baltimore Orioles affiliate went 43-23 in the first half to win the North Division Title and then 35-31 in the second half. On the current roster, the IronBirds host six of the Orioles Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including 2022 Draft picks OF Dylan Beavers (No. 8), 3B Max Wagner (No. 16), and OF Jud Fabian (No. 23). Aberdeen also hosts prospects OF Heston Kjerstad (No. 10) and SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 26).

BEST STRETCH: Brooklyn ended the season with a 14-4 record in its final 18 games, outscoring opponents 111-51 (+60). Brooklyn's offense averaged 6.2 runs per game and the pitching staff and defense has allowed 2.8 runs per game over the stretch.

CHAMPIONS AGAIN?: The 2022 Cyclones have two players from the 2019 NYPL Championship roster, including C **Jose Mena** and INF **Jose Peroza**.

JOSE! JOSE! JOSE!: After bottoming out with a .199 batting average on June 29, INF **Jose Peroza** hit an astounding .336 over the final 58 games of the season, raising his batting average from .199 to .271. Peroza had a 31-game on-base streak from July 29-September 2 -- the second-longest in team history.

AN 'A' FOR ALEX: OF **Alex Ramirez** finished his regular season with 140 hits, ranking most among Mets minor leaguers and 18th all of Minor League Baseball, finishing 17 hits behind leader OF **Will Brennan** (Triple-A Columbus -- Cleveland). Ramirez, just 19 years old, played 67 games with St. Lucie, collecting 77 hits with a .284 batting average before his July 4th promotion to Brooklyn where he played 54 games with 63 hits and a .278 batting average. Ramirez also ended his regular season with a Mets MiLB-best 30 doubles and seven triples.

TODAY: Santos makes his first-ever postseason appearance and start of his five-year pro career, facing Aberdeen.

METS LEADERBOARD: Santos finished the regular season with 116.2 innings, ranking fourth on the list of Mets Minor Leaguers. Junior made 23 starts, tying for the second-most, and fifth in strikeouts (105).

SALLY LEAGUE LEADER: The sinkerballer finished the regular season with a 58.7% groundball rate, ranking second in the league to Rome’s Luis De Avila who led the league with a 60.8% groundball rate.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

BREAKOUT: The 21 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

OPENING DAY STARTER: Junior Santos made Brooklyn’s Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos’ fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
