LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned their 2nd-straight victory with a 6-1 triumph over Hudson Valley on Friday night...C Kevin Parada registered his first career multi-home run game as part of a career-high-tying 3-hit night...The 21-year-old hammered a solo shot in the 3rd and added a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th...The Cyclones clubbed 3 home runs in the 3rd inning...3B William Lugo and LF Jaylen Palmer followed Parada with solo blasts of their own...CF Alex Ramírez reached base 3 times on 2 singles and a walk...Lugo also added a multi-hit effort...RHP Blade Tidwell tossed his 2nd-straight quality start, posting 6.0 innings of 1-run, 9-strikeout ball...The 22-year-old captured his 4th win.

HOMER HAPPY: On Friday night, the Cyclones set a team season-high with 4 home runs vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn's previous high water mark was 3 on June 13 at Aberdeen...It was the first time the 'Clones had clubbed at least 4 home runs in a single game since July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF Alex Ramírez homered twice on a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run blast in the 6th...C José Mena and 1B Joe Suozzi went back-to-back in the 7th...Brooklyn's 3-home run 3rd inning on Friday was also the first for the franchise since the team smashed a trio in the top of the 5th on July 27, 2021, at Jersey Shore...DH Edgardo Fermín (2-run) and SS Ronny Mauricio went back-to-back before 2B Luis González added a 2-run shot of his own later in the frame...Friday also marked the first time the Cyclones have poked 4+ home runs at Maimonides Park since a 5-homer barrage on September 18, 2021, vs. Jersey Shore...CF Jaylen Palmer, C Oscar Campos, 2B Luke Ritter, DH Francisco Álvarez, and 1B Wilmer Reyes all went deep.

**TOUCH 'EM ALL**: C **Kevin Parada** capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of Friday's win vs. Hudson Valley... It was the first inside-the-park home run by a Cyclones player since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by **Joe Jiannetti** on July 19, 2001.

BULLS ON PARADA: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .345/.400/.600 with a 1.000 OPS and 170 wRC+ in 14 games...Parada has accrued 7 runs scored, a triple, 4 home runs, 11 RBI, 4 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Saturday on a 6-game hitting streak (11-for-24; .458) and an 11-game on-base streak (.357/.426/.619)...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Saturday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (14), tied for 7th in hits (61), and tied for 8th in total bases (100) and extra-base hits (23).

BLADE RUNNER: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed consecutive quality starts dating back to last Saturday at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in both outings, permitting just 1 run on 7 hits over 13.0 innings...He has walked 4 and struck out 15 in those contests...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 7 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 4-0 with a 1.35 ERA (6 ER in 33.1 Pl) with just 17 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 48 (12.96 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 35.0% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .150 batting average (17-113) against him... Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (150) and is 2nd in ERA (1.35) and strikeouts (48) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 8th in the SAL in punch outs (75).

A-RAM IT: OF Alex Ramírez reached base 3 times on Friday, including 2 singles and a walk, last night vs. Hudson Valley...In the month of June, the 20-year-old is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in walks (15) and runs scored (14)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (65) and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...He is also 4th in hits (118), 4th in total bases (176), and 6th in doubles (26).

**LUGO LAND:** INF **William Lugo** became the 3rd different Cyclone to homer in consecutive games on Friday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 21-year-old smashed a 2-run home run in Thursday's victory and added a solo blast in the 3rd on Friday...OF **Stanley Conseugra** in consecutive games on April 14 and 15 at Winston-Salem...OF **Alex Ramírez** also accomplished the feat on June 4 and 6 at Jersey Shore and vs. Greenville.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 5-straight scoreless outings since that date (9.0 IP)...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.17)...Gervase averages 13.79 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.3% strikeout rate.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.19) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.22) in the classification, while Hudson Valley (3.35) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 3rd best in all of MiLB... Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.04).

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), earning his 2nd win of the year on Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...The
23-year-old is the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP
Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart is
also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed
8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum is the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP Kevin
Canelon whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads
all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.44)...The
Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.5%) and FIP (2.88), 2nd in xFIP (3.19),
4th in strikeouts (78) and strikeout rate (31.0%), 5th in innings pitched (62.2) and WHIP
(1.09), and 6th in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20) and batting average against (2.09).

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Benito García has come into his own in Brooklyn's bullpen over the last few weeks...The 23-year-old tossed 1.1 innings of scoreless relief on Thursday and has not allowed a run over his last 4 appearances dating back to June 9...In that

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 12-game homestand, starting with 6 contests against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21...The Cyclones went 4-2 in the set, taking 4-straight games from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Cyclones are 132-138 (.489) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

span, García has allowed just 5 hits in 5.1 innings with no walks and 5 strikeouts...Benito also accrued his first save with the franchise on June 14 at Aberdeen...Since returning from Single-A St. Lucie on May 30, García holds a 1.17 ERA (1 ER in 7.2 IP) and 6 strikeouts in 6 relief outings.

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 26 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in Mil.B...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (103), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (103), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (99), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (97) and Red Sox INF David Hamilton (97) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 55 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 6 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in Tuesday's defeat...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8...His 91 pitches also set a career-high...Over his last 2 starts, Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.27 ERA (4 ER in 11.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 13.09 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 35.6% (16/45) in that span.

**DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE:** RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 10 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.08 ERA (2 ER in 16.2 IP) on 5 hits and 7 walks, registering 25 strikeouts (13.50 K/9)...That equates to a 39.7 K% (25/63).

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn posted a career-best performance in Saturday's win at Aberdeen...The 24-year-old tallied a professional-high-tying 3 hits and collected his 1st career multi-home run game...Osborn added a season-best 4 RBI, as well...His 1st 3-hit night came on April 30, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie vs. Daytona...The multi-home run performance was the first by a Cyclone since RF Alex Ramírez blasted two long balls on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...Osborn is the first 'Clone to record 2+ home runs, 3+ hits, and 4+ RBI in a single game since DH Brett Baty (3/4, 2 HR, 4 RBI) accomplished the feat on June 3, 2021, at Jersey Shore...3 of Osborn's last 4 hits have been home runs and 4 of his last 6 have left the ballpark, as well.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after last Friday's loss at Aberdeen...21.2% (14-of-66) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 24.3% (9-of-37) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...37.8% (25-of-66) have been determined by just 1 run.

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023... Over his last 3 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 7.1 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 8...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.64 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.1% strikeout rate with a 11.2% walk rate.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (198), at-bats (649), plate appearances (777), runs scored (100), walks (107), and stolen bases (48)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio (21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (68) on May 23 and is 1 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (201), tied for 3rd in home runs (17), and 5th in hits (117).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last week...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasii (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney (sland)

LAST TIME OUT: Took his 3rd-straight no-decision in a scheduled abbreviated start at Aberdeen last Sunday...Retired all 6 batters he faced...Tossed 18 pitches and 12 strikes (66.7%)...Relieved by RHP Benito García in the bottom of the 3rd with the game scoreless...Cyclones scored multiple runs in each of the final 3 innings to defeat the IronBirds, 7-3.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Despite Maimonides Park's pitcher-friendly tendencies, Foster has faired slightly better away from Coney Island in 2023...The 24-year-old holds an 1-2 mark, but a 4.45 ERA (16 ER in 32.1 IP) with 16 walks and 27 strikeouts in 8 road starts...At home, Foster is 1-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP), 9 walks, and 15 strikeouts.

2022: Composed a 4-2 record with a 1.86 ERA (13 ER in 63.0 IP), 12 saves, and 84 strikeouts in 29 appearances at McNeese State University...Named Southland Conference Reliever of the Year...Recognized on the All-Southland Conference First Team...Selected by the New York Mets in the 14th round...Signed on August 1 for \$40,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets, but did not pitch.

START ME UP: Foster is slated to make the 9th start of his season and pro career on Thursday night...The 24-year-old did not start at McNeese State in 2022 and only made 4 total over 3 seasons...During 2 campaigns at Wharton (Texas) County Junior College registered just 8 starts in 23 appearances...Prior to this season, his last official start came on February 28, 2021, for McNeese State vs. Prairie View A&M University.
