TODAY'S HEADLINES

Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 266-241 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints got a solid start from Adam Plutko, who threw 5.0 scoreless innings, but lowe pulled away late in 9-1 loss in the series finale on Sunday. The Saints fell behind 4-0 after the seventh inning after Hobie Harris was tagged for four runs over 2.0 innings. The lone Saints run was scored in the eighth on a Tony Kemp single. However, in the eighth, Scott Blewett allowed five runs on six hits, giving lowa an 9-1 lead. The Saints finished the game 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position, splitting their first series of the second half.

GOING FISHING: This week the Gwinnett Stripers are making their second trip to CHS Field. This will be the second meeting in franchise history between the two clubs, with the Saints sweeping last year's sixgame series. The Saints had one of their best offensive weeks in franchise history against Gwinnett last season, hitting .356 as a team, clubbing 14 home runs, outscoring the Stripers 62-34, averaging 10.3 runs per game. In last year's series, Jair Camargo went 9-for-19 (.474) with a walk-off grand slam, driving in 10 runs over the series. Matt Wallner hit 9-for-24 (.391) with a double, a triple and two home runs.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Major League Baseball announced the rosters for the All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX today. Brooks Lee was named the Twins representative to participate in the showcase event. Lee is the third Saint to be selected, joining Josh Winder (2021) and Spencer Steer (2022). Lee will also participate in the Skills Challenge afterward; a three-round hitting competition that will display prospect's control and power. Lee is ranked as the Twins' #2 prospect by MLB Pipeline and the 13th-best prospect in baseball.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 6/21 vTOL...made 13th start of the season, throwing 5.0 innings, allowing one run on three hits, walking five, tying his career-high and striking out four...retired the side in order in the first inning...walked three batters in the second inning, allowing a run to score on a Riley Unroe sacrifice fly...faced the minimum in the third inning...allowed a two-out single in the fourth, retiring the other three batters...walked two with two outs in the fifth, getting out of the inning without an runs...recorded just five ground ball outs...walked five for the second time this season and fifth time in his career...received sixth win in 4-2 Saints victory.

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny Henriquez.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3.380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Escalage in Pitthswere (2010-15). at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement. coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.
