SHOREBIRDS EVEN SERIES: The Delmarva Shorebirds displayed a strong all-around effort on Wednesday night to get back into the win column as they defeated the Carolina Mudcats by a score of 6-2. They used a four-Wednesday by driving home three on three hits, including a solo home run to start the seventh, his team-best sixth homer of the season as he finished the night just a triple shy of the cycle. Adam Crampton also drove home a pair with two singles with each scoring Douglas Hodo.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Wyatt Cheney toes the slab for the Shorebirds on Thursday night for his second start of the year as he'll match up with **Patricio Aquino** of the Mudcats who will be making his fifth start of 2023 and has excelled in the early going for Carolina across 13.1 innings allowing just 3 earned runs on 9 hits while striking out 13 with 6 walks.

PITCHING PROGRESSION: The pitching staff delivered for the Shorebirds in their last series against the Salem Red Sox, especially the starting pitchers. In the last five games, the Delmarva starters allowed just 4 earned runs in 23 combined innings. The starters struck out 25 batters with only 9 hits allowed. The ERA for the starters went from 6.80 to 5.18 following their strong showing against the Red Sox.

GO LONG: Creed Willems continues his excellent season in Delmarva by going deep for the sixth time on Wednesday night to add his already impressive slugging percentage of .759 through 17 games. Willems has already passed his home run total from 2022 and is on pace to shatter all his offensive numbers from last season after just one month of action.

HITS IN BUNCHES: Stiven Acevedo has been a regular at collecting multi-hit games as he delivered his teambest, seventh following his career performance on Tuesday. Acevedeo now has three 3-hit games, and four 2-hit games. The 20 year old outfielder has especially enjoyed the confines of Perdue Stadium owning an average of .372 and OPS of .964 in 11 games in Salisbury.

PROCEED WITH CAUTION: The Delmarva catchers have been tough to run on this season for opposing base runners as they are tied for the Carolina League lead by catching 21 would be base stealers and have denied their opposition on 40% of their attempts through the first 21 games of the season.

SHARP ON THE MOUND: Reese Sharp is one of the top arms in the back of the Delmarva bullpen as the 20th Round pick from Indiana is tied for the team-high in strikeouts with 17 in just 9.2 innings on the mound, giving him a strong 15.8 K/9 innings. Sharp earned his first professional victory on Wednesday by retiring the final six batters and has struck out three or more batters in all five of his outings this season.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Douglas Hodo has made become one of the most reliable bats in the Delmarva batting order over the last ten games as has the best batting average (.345) and OBP (.472) thanks to six walks in that span. The former Texas Longhorn picked up his first career triple on Wednesday night versus Carolina and has reached base in 13/14 games he's played in this season.

MUDCAT MATCHUP: The Shorebirds and Mudcats will face off in a series for the third consecutive season after the two franchises were in different leagues since their respective inceptions until 2021 when both were moved to the Carolina League. The Mudcats have been in the Carolina League since 2012 while Delmarva was formerly in the South Atlantic League. The Shorebirds hold the all-time series edge 14-10 with the two teams splitting their 12 games last season.

TODAY'S STARTER: Wyatt Cheney gets the call as today's starting pitcher as he'll operate as the starter for the second time this season. Cheney also started April 22 at Fredericksburg but the game was suspended due to rain in the bottom of the second inning.

LAST OUTING (4/27 vs SAL): Cheney settled in nicely in his last relief appearance, striking out a young, career-high of 4 batters across three innings. He escaped major trouble in his final frame in the seventh thanks to an inning ending double play. He would go on to be the winning pitcher in an 8-5 victory over the Red Sox.

vs. CAROLINA: This will be the first time Cheney faces the Carolina Mudcats in his career.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The right-hander appeared in just two games for the Shorebirds after being drafted out of McClennan Community College in Texas. His first outing was a full inning against the Pirates in the FCL where he dealt a full inning with two strikeouts as he retired the side in order. He faced just two batters in his only Delmarva appearance where he faced two batters, allowing a hit and a walk. Appeared in 16 games at McClennan in 2022, making 15 starts where he struck out 122 in 81.2 innings to earn a 10-3 record and an ERA of 3.20. Struck out 11 batters or more in three starts including a career-high 13 versus Hill College on March 19.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

DEVELOPMENT COACH



Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization. Prior to joining the Orioles, Murray worked with three other MLB clubs (Tigers, Marlins, and Angels), most recently as a Baseball Information Assistant with the Detroit Tigers in 2021.
