Round Rock and Salt Lake will play in game two of the series on Wednesday night from Dell Diamond. Express RHP Owen White is slated to start against Bees RHP Cesar Valdez. Tonight's first pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CT.

THE WIN STREAK SITS AT 13

Round Rock earned a 9-6 win over Salt Lake in 12 innings on Tuesday night. Salt Lake got on the board in the first inning after CF Jordyn Adams doubled then scored on a throwing error. Round Rock took a 2-1 lead after 1B Blaine Crim smacked a two-RBI single. The Bees went up 3-2 in the fourth when 1B Jared Walsh launched a two-run home run. Salt Lake extended their lead to 4-2 in the seventh after three singles and an error. Crim tied the game at four with a two-run dinger in the bottom of the frame. In the ninth inning, the Express went 1-2-3 in the home half to send the game to extra innings. Both teams got their inherited runners home in both the 10th and 11th innings, which sent the game to the 12th. Express RHP Marc Church notched two strikeouts in the top of the 12th and held the Bees scoreless. In the bottom of the inning, RF Sandro Fabian walked it off with a three-run home run to secure the 9-6 final.

WHITE TAKES THE MOUND

Round Rock RHP Owen White is slated to get the start in Wednesday's game two. The righty has not reached 5.0 innings in any of his last four starts after tossing 5.0 innings in two of his first three starts. At home, White boasts a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) in three games. White is averaging one home run given up per game after allowing seven.

SEEKING CLUB HISTORY

The Round Rock Express defeated the Salt Lake Bees in 12 innings on Tuesday night to earn their 13th consecutive victory and tie the longest winning streak in franchise history (May 19-31, 2004). It is the Pacific Coast League's longest winning streak since Nashville saw 15 straight wins in 2018.

CRIM WENT CRAZY

On Tuesday, Round Rock 1B Blaine Crim led the E-Train offensively, recording his third four-hit game of the season after going 4-for-5 with one walk, three singles, a home run, which tied the game in the seventh inning, four RBI and two runs scored. He now has recorded the team's most four-hit games this season.

WALK IT OFF, E-TRAIN

Express RF Sandro Fabian hit the team's second walk-off home run of the season last night, improving Round Rock to 6-2 in extra innings. The team also has eight wins that have been decided in the final at-bat. The E-Train have trailed in the seventh inning or later in five of their 13 wins during the winning streak, including last night after seeing a two-run deficit after the top of the seventh.

HAVING FUN AT THE TOP

The E-Train own a 1.0-game lead over the Las Vegas Aviators in the league's second-half standings with just 29 games remaining. Round Rock has allowed the fewest second-half runs (210) and owns the best second-half run differential of +71, which is 20 more than the next closest team, Tacoma.

AN ASTOUNDING AUGUST

Round Rock has amassed a 15-4 record through the first 19 games in August behind back-to-back series sweeps. The E-Train is the first Pacific Coast League team to earn back-to-back sweeps since the six-game series format was implemented in 2021. With a win on Wednesday, the Express will have tied with the 2001 squad for the best 20-game stretch to open a month, sitting at 16-4. With a loss, the Express would be 15-5, which is a record not seen by the team before and would be the second-best stretch.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

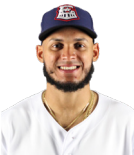
