TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Tonight, your Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the fourth game of a six-game series. Tonight is Will Smith Bobblehead Giveaway, thanks to La Rocque Better Roofs, as 1,500 fans through the gates will take home a bobblehead. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 16th of 24 head-to-head games and the 13th of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 12-3 against the Storm with the Quakes owning a 10-2 record here at home. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes took the lead for good in the last of the eighth, then held on in the ninth for a 3-2 win over the Lake Elsinore Storm on Thursday night at LoanMart Field. Tied at 2-2 in the bottom of the eighth, Storm reliever Yovannky Pascual (0-2) loaded the bases with two outs. Storm reliever Igor Gil then hit Eduardo Guerrero with a pitch, forcing in the eventual winning run. In the ninth, Dilan Figueredo (1-3) gave up a pair of singles, but got a double-play ball to end the game, the third turned in by Rancho's defense on Thursday night. Mairo Martinus had two of Rancho's six hits, including his fourth homer of the year. Rancho starter Sterling Patick took a shutout into the fifth, but gave up a pair of runs in the fifth, taking a no-decision.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Quakes made a roster move today, sending RHP Ryan Brown to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League. Rancho will receive 22-year-old RHP Will Maynard from the ACL to take Brown's place. **ELKINS TAKES OVER RBI LEAD:** One day after RBI-leader Samuel Munoz was promoted to High-A, Jaron Elkins moved into a tie for the team lead with 65 RBIs, driving in a run in Tuesday's 6-1 win over the Storm. On Wednesday night, Elkins took over the top spot all to himself with another RBI hit, giving him 66 on the year. That number is tied with Inland Empire's Raudi Rodriguez for second in the league, trailing only San Jose's Dakota Jordan (82). Elkins also leads the team and the California League, with 61 stolen bases in just 66 attempts.

WELCOME BACK TO JOENDRY VARGAS: 19-year-old infielder Joendry Vargas has spent a significant amount of time on the Injured List this year, with two different stints. Vargas homered on Wednesday night, giving him his first hit since being activated from his latest injury stint. Vargas is hitting .248 in 25 total games, with three homers, 20 RBIs and 17 steals in 19 attempts. He's ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 11th-best prospect overall.

TWO WINS, NOT MUCH HITTING: The Quakes have enjoyed a solid offense this year with a .256 average for third in the league and 82 homer, behind only San Jose's 92. Despite taking two of three in this current series, Rancho hasn't exactly piled up the hits though, with hit totals of five, seven and six, respectively over the three combined games. Ironically, the only game they've lost was Wednesday, when they posted a series-high seven hits.

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 22nd overall appearance and 12th start, his fourth appearance and second start against the Storm. In three games against the Storm, he's 0-0 with a 3.52 ERA, allowing three runs on three hits over 7.2 innings. In his last outing, he allowed two runs on five hits over five frames in a no-decision at Fresno on August 2. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024. **MAIKEL MIRALLES:** Righty Maikel Miralles makes his 14th appearance and 11th start of the year for the Storm, his third start against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho, he's 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA, allowing three earned runs on nine hits over eight innings. In his last game, he allowed two runs on four hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision vs Inland Empire on August 1. Miralles signed with San Diego in January of 2023 out of Maracay, Venezuela.
