### **LAST GAME**

The Bowie Baysox dropped their fourth-consecutive game on Sunday afternoon, as the Richmond Flying Squirrels launched four home runs towards a 9-1 final at The Diamond in Richmond. Bowie's offensive struggles continued, as the Baysox went 0-for-6 at the plate with runners in scoring position. Over their four-game losing streak, Bowie has only collected one hit with runners at second or third base. Garret Stallings made his second start of the series, and took the loss again behind home runs. Frankie Tostado and Shane Matheny each collected long balls against Stallings, while Franklin Labour lifted one against Griffin McLarty making his Double-A debut, and Shane Matheny followed with his second of the game later in the same inning.

#### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Senators had held the top spot in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for most of April, but enter the first series in May tied for second place behind Richmond. A team mostly lead by its pitching staff, Harrisburg has the third best team ERA in the league at the start of this series, at 3.59, as well as the fewest home runs allowed in the league, at just 16. They also sport one of the best closers in the league, as Matt Brill has already collected seven saves and a win in his nine appearances. The Senators sport one of the oldest rosters in the league with an average age around 25.5 years old.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-handed pitcher Ronald Herrera is slated to make his fifth start of the season for the Senators after being signed as a minor league free agent over the offseason, Last season, Herrera pitched for the New Jersey Jackals of the Frontier League. Before playing independent ball, Herrera had pitched in the minor leagues since 2012 with stints in the A's, Padres, Yankees and Rangers organizations, making the big league squad and pitching two appearances for the Yankees in 2017 (3 IP, 2 ER, 3 K). He has opened this season with a 5.48 ERA, picking up the loss in his last appearance against Hartford, with five innings of four run ball. Herrera last pitched against an Oriole affiliate on July 6th of 2016 while with Trenton, getting the loss in four innings of six run ball at Prince George's Stadium against Bowie.

### **WELCOME BACK, FRIENDS**

Prior to Tuesday's game, the Baysox added two very familiar faces to their roster. Baseball's top overall prospect Adley Rutschman, and Orioles top left-handed pitching prospect DL Hall. Rutschman, rated as the top overall prospect in baseball by Baseball America, began the 2021 season with the Baysox, and appeared in 80 games for Bowie, before being promoted to Triple-A near the end of the season. With Bowie, he hit .271 at the plate, while smashing 18 home runs and driving in 55 runs. Well known for his discipline at the plate, Rutschman only struck out 57 times in 357 plate appearances, while also drawing 55 walks. DL Hall is rated as the fifth-best prospect in the Orioles organization, the sixth-best left-handed pitcher, and number 88 in all of baseball by MLB Pipeline. Hall spent his 2021 season with Bowie, overpowering opposing batters with his well-graded fastball. After striking out a league-leading 56 batters in just 31.2 innings through mid-June, Hall was diagnosed with a stress fracture in his elbow, ending his season.

### **TOP GUNNAR**

Infielder Gunnar Henderson singled on just the fourth pitch of Sunday's game in Richmond, extending his on-base streak to 20-consecutive games, the best mark in the Eastern League this season. Henderson also has 21 walks on the year, second-most in the League. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to 24.7% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

#### OUT OF GAS

Bowie's constant struggle with leaving runners on base over the last four games has made an impact on some of their numbers. Bowie has slipped out of the top spot for batting with runners in scoring position, thanks to a 1-for-30 mark at the plate over their last four games. Bowie has also stranded a total of 34 runners on base in the four-game stretch, bumping them up to 150 runners left on base this season, an average of 7.5 per game. Bowie was second in the Double-A Northeast in 2021, when they stranded just over 800 total runners across the season, a little over 6.7 per game

#### A RARE DROUGHT

During their current four-game losing skid, the Baysox have been held to exactly one run in each of their last three games. It is the first time that Bowie has been held to three or fewer total runs in a three-game span since 7/25-7/27 2019, when they dropped the first three games in a series at Binghamton. Bowie lost the first game 3-2 in 11 innings, the second game 6-0, and the third game 2-1.

### **Coaching Staff**

### Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/ coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Moore signed as a non-drafted free agent with the Orioles in 2010 after playing collegiately at the University of Alabama. As a high schooler, he starred at Edgewood Academy (AL), where he won three AISA state baseball championships. Kyle, his wife Whitney and their daughter Madilyn reside in Sarasota, FL.

### Hitting Coach: Branden Becker

Becker was drafted by the Orioles in the 17th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft in 2015 and played parts of four seasons in the organization before retiring in May, 2019. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

### Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double- A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
