JACKSONVILLE BLAST FOUR HOMERS IN 10-INNING WIN

Victor Mesa Jr.'s 10th-inning home run on Wednesday spurred the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 6-5 win over the Omaha Storm Chasers at Werner Park, halting the Jumbo Shrimp's seven-game losing streak. With the scored tied at four, Jacksonville (17-18) entered the 10th inning playing its first extra-inning game of the season. With the zombie runner on second, Mesa Jr. ambushed the first pitch from Omaha (20-12) reliever Walter Pennington (2-1) over the right field wall to put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead 6-4. Omaha got a run back in the bottom of the 10th but their rally ended there.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 19 games. however, Johnston is 24-for-78 at the plate, hitting .308/.341/.449/.790 with eight doubles, one home run, eight RBIs, three walks and 13 runs scored. He has reached base at least once in 16 of the 19 games during this hot stretch, recording multiple times on base eight times.

Out of the club's 311.1 innings pitched thus far in 2024, Jacksonville starting pitchers have accounted for just 156.0 frames, a ratio of only 50.1 percent. That said, those 156.0 innings are the seventh-most in Triple-A for any starting rotation. Jumbo Shrimp starters have also provided quality in their innings. The club's starting rotation has posted a 4.62 ERA, the ninth-best in Triple-A. The club's .253 batting average against from its starters ranks 10th. Jacksonville starters have yielded three runs or fewer in 16 of their last 20 games.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jonah Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Through 26 games, Bride is 31-for-90 (.344/.478/.711/1.189) with seven doubles, one triple, eight homers, 18 RBIs, 20 walks and 15 runs scored. Bride leads the International League in both OPS and OBP, while ranking second in slugging percentage, tied for fifth in batting average.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 35 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 156 runs (4.5 per game), a figure that ranks 28th in Triple-A in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are batting a woeful .244/.337/.395/.732 (ranking 21st, 26th, 24th and 24th, respectively, in those respective slash categories in Triple-A), with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th at the Triple-A level.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder Victor Mesa Jr. missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 26 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 32-for-104, slashing .308/.371/.538/.909 with six doubles, six home runs, 24 RBIs. 11 walks and 21 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 14.7 percent this season with Jacksonville.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 22 of Jacksonville's 35 games (62.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have mostly excelled in these contests, going 13-9 (.591) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. However, Jacksonville has lost six of their last seven games decided by three runs or fewer, including five straight. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SHRIMP BITES

Nashville

Jacksonville has surrendered 35 runs in the last five games, tied for the fifth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 35 runs, 23 have come with two outs... After yesterday's outing, Kent Emanuel became the 11th different Jumbo Shrimp pitcher to start a game thus far in 2024. After clubbing four home runs last night, Jacksonville's 32.3 AB/ HR ranks 17th in Triple-A.

REPERTOIRE

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about $45\,\rm minutes$ from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32)
