JUMBO SHRIMP STRIKE BACK IN 7-4 WIN

After scratching across a run in each of their last three games, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp smacked 12 hits, including two home runs in their 7-4 win over the Durham Bulls Wednesday night. The Jumbo Shrimp struck first in the bottom of the first inning. With runners at second and third, Graham Pauley smacked an RBI single and two batters later, Maximo Acosta drove in a pair with a double. Durham added a run in the third and fourth before the Jumbo Shrimp unleashed a four-run sixth for a 7-2 advantage.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 50 games, a whopping 35, or 70 percent, have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 23-12 (.657) in these closelydecided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 25-13 (.658) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 13-6 (.684) mark in onerun games. Those 13 one-run victories are tied for the most in Triple-A and tied for second in MiLB.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 48 of their last 58 games, with multiple steals in 36 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With two stolen bases last night Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fifth in the minors with 134 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.60 ERA, and their 238 runs allowed are the fourth-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 20th in Triple-A in strikeouts (500), but their 402 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has supressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.0 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, tied for the thirdlowest such mark in Triple-A

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last nine games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 15 runs, 11 earned, on 23 hits in 41.1 innings for a 2.40 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 33 strikeouts against 22 walks during this stretch.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Over their last eight games, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers combined to cede just nine runs, eight earned, on 19 hits in 32.2 innings for a 2.20 ERA. Jacksonville lid-lifters have fanned 25 opposing hitters against 13 walks during this stretch. Jumbo Shrimp starters have surrendered three runs or fewer in all eight contests including two or fewer in seven affairs, during this recent run.

BULL-Y PULPIT

Jacksonville is a woeful 1-7 against Durham this year, getting outscored by a 59-25 margin, Jumbo Shrimp pitching has really struggled during this run, posting a 7.64 ERA with the Bulls hitting .261/.351/.477/.828 in those eight games. In comparison, Jacksonville is hitting just .238/.270/.352/.642 against Durham pitching. The Jumbo Shrimp have scored three runs or fewer in five of the eight games of this season series so far.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has scored one run in three games of their last four games, totaling only 28 hits in 33.0 innings of offense. The Jumbo Shrimp have not scored more than four runs in 11 of their last 13 games, including six in a row ... Jakob Marsee leads the International League in stolen bases (33) while ranking tied for second in walks (39)... Five of the top 19 stolen base leaders in the IL play for the Jumbo Shrimp (Marsee, 1st, 33; Troy Johnston, T-4th, 18; Maximo Acosta, T-6th, 16; Jack Winkler, T-10th, 15; Andrew Pintar, T-15th, 13)... Jacob Berry has reached base in 14 of his last 16 games, going 15-for-48 at the plate during that stretch (.313/.358/.479/.837) with five doubles, one home run, eight RBIs, three walks and seven runs scored. He was hitting just .140/.238/.243/.452 before this run.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

- -Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).
- -When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).
- -As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.
- -Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

- -Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.
- -Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
