2025 Media Notes – April 26th vs Brooklyn (Mets)

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Jersey Shore BlueClaws (6-13) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (13-6)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001)

Series: Game 5 of 6 (Brooklyn leads season series 3-1 of 30)

Last Game Recap... Carson Bengie hit a grand slam and Estarling Mercado hit a two run home run as Brooklyn topped the BlueClaws 8-3 on Friday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn scored six runs in the top of the third inning to open the scoring...Kehden Hettiger homered for Jersey Shore, who has dropped three of the first four games in the series.

Battle of the Boardwalks... Brooklyn is in town for a six game series (Brooklyn leads 3-1), the first of five series, and 30 games, between the BlueClaws and Cyclones this season...Jersey Shore won the season series 17-10 last year and 15-11 in 2023, but Brooklyn won 22-5 in 2022, and the BlueClaws won 17-10 in 2021...The BlueClaws are 55-59 all time against the Cyclones.

State of the Teams... The BlueClaws have dropped three in a row and six of their last seven games...They are seven games under .500 for the first time this season...They went 2-4 last week in Greensboro, losing the last three...Brooklyn went 4-2 at Aberdeen, allowing just 20 runs over the six games...The Cyclones swept three from Wilmington to open the season and split six with Hudson Valley before last week.

At Stake Today... A loss today would be a fourth straight by the BlueClaws (they last lost four or more in a row from July 27-August 4 last year, an eight-game losing streak (2 vs Aberdeen and 6 vs Hudson Valley).

DeMartini Heating Up... Since starting the year 2-17, Carson DeMartini is 16-44 and enters today on a six game hitting streak over which he is 12-29...He has five two-plus hit games in the last two series...He has already drawn 12 walks this year while adding six stolen bases...DeMartini hit a three run home run to cap a six run seventh inning in the home opener on 4/8 vs Aberdeen.

Hip Hip, Hettiger... Kehden Hettiger had two hits including a home run on Friday night and is 8-23 with the BlueClaws, having hit safely in all six BlueClaws appearances since joining last Wednesday from Clearwater, where he was 2-25...He homered in his first BlueClaws at bat last Thursday at Greensboro...His homer on Friday was his 7th professional home run after he hit five with Clearwater last year...He is the first BlueClaw to homer in his first game with the team since Logan O'Hoppe homered on 5/4/21 in the first game of his first season with the BlueClaws (second at bat)...Luke Miller (5/24/19 at Delmarva) also homered in his game with the BlueClaws (second at bat) as did Nick Maton (4/5/18 at Kannapolis, Opening Day, second at bat).

Big Innings... The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 11 times this season, in 10 different games over which they are 1-9...Their lone win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...They have allowed at least four runs in an inning in five of their last seven games, and lost all five...Six of the 11 Innings have included multiple walks...By comparison, Brooklyn has three such innings this season in which they've allowed four or more runs.

Dev For Three... 2B Devin Saltiban had three hits on Thursday, his first three hit game with the BlueClaws (he had four last year with Clearwater plus one four-hit game)...Before Thursday night, Saltiban had been 2 for his previous 30 with 13 strikeouts...A 3rd round pick in 2023 (Hilo HS in Hilo, Hawaii), he hit 17 home runs last season with Clearwater and is the #9 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Luke on the Board... Luke Davis hit his first professional home run, a three-run shot that just missed entering the Chick-fil-A Fan Zone, Thursday night against Greensboro...The switch-hitting catcher from Garden Grove, California (Orange County) signed with the Phillies last year out of Long Beach City College, where he was the South Coast League MVP...He did not appear in a game last year, and made his pro debut with Jersey Shore on Opening Day, 4/4 at Hudson Valley.

A Walk in the Park... The BlueClaws have four players with double-digit walks so far this year: Luke Davis (12 in 50 plate appearances), Carson DeMartini (12 in 76), Bryan Rincon (12 in 72), and Bryson Ware (10 in 60)...Luke Davis drew four walks on 4/18 at Greensboro, tying a club record and becoming the seventh BlueClaw to draw four walks in a game (most recently McCarthy Tatum on 8/8/21 vs Aberdeen)...Ware had six walks in 106 plate appearances with the BlueClaws in 2024, Rincon had 23 in 140 plate appearances with the BlueClaws last year, while DeMartini had nine in 104 with Clearwater last year.

Bouncing Back... Since opening the season 1-23, Dylan Campbell is 10-37 with three home runs and 13 RBIs (beginning game two of the double-header on 4/12 vs Aberdeen)...His two home runs on 4/15 marked the first multi-home run game by a BlueClaw since Otto Kemp on 6/5/24 at Greensboro...Acquired from the Dodgers in January, he spent last year with Great Lakes in the Midwest League (High-A) and hit .251 in 115 games with 10 home runs, 53 RBIs and 42 stolen bases in 49 attempts (six of his 10 home runs were hit in August)...Campbell was a 4th round pick of the Dodgers in 2023 from the University of Texas.

Going Going Rincon... Bryan Rincon hit three home runs in Greensboro last week, giving him three home runs in his first 13 games this year (now 15), one more than he hit in 33 games with the BlueClaws last year...Rincon, the third youngest BlueClaw, turned 21 in February...He is the #14 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline and was a 14th round pick in 2022 from Shaler Area HS (PA).

Comebacks... The BlueClaws win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9th inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead.

Benny Barrels... Pierce Bennett (9-37 to start the year) has two home runs already, including one 4/17 at Greensboro (3rd professional home run), 30 miles from Wake Forest where he played his college baseball...He also hit one on 4/10 in Lakewood against aerdeen...Bennett had a big night in the 4/8 home opener – a two run single and a two run double in the 8-3 win...Bennett's four RBIs were a career-high (he had two, three-RBI games with the BlueClaws last year).

Player of the Week... Dylan Campbell went 9-23 with three home runs and 11 RBIs in Greensboro and was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week, the first BlueClaws position player to win Player of the Week since Jhalil Ortiz in 2021...Campbell had two 5-RBI games in the series with Greensboro (last Tuesday and Friday)...He is the second BlueClaw to have two, 5-RBI games in the same series (Chris Duffy on 7/14 and 7/16/12 vs Savannah)...He is only the seventh BlueClaw with two 5-RBI games in the same season (Rixon Wingrove in 2023, Jhalil Ortiz in 2021, Duffy in 2012, Maikel Franco in 2012, Jim Murphy in 2011 [also one in 2009], Jonathan Singleton in 2010).

From the Draft... Carson DeMartini is the lone member of the Phillies 2024 draft class to open the season with the BlueClaws (4th round pick, Virginia Tech)...This is the third straight year only one member of the previous year's draft class opened the season with the BlueClaws (2024 – 3B Zach Arnold, 11th round, 2023; 2023 – OF Troy Schreffler, 15th round, 2022)...DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th...He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a junior last year...

Super-Utility... Bryson Ware has played 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and RF with the BlueClaws, and played those six positions and CF with Clearwater before joining the BlueClaws last August...In August last season, he played 1B, 2B, 3B, and SS in four straight games, becoming only the third High-A BlueClaw (Nick Ward in 2023, McCarthy Tatum in 2022) to play those four in consecutive games.

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes four players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), and OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – most recently July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

Going For Five...The BlueClaws enter 2025 with four straight winning halves, both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half

of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin (since promoted), IF Zach Arnold).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...125 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkerling (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.

About: 21 year old, 6-4, 190 pound RHP from Dearborn, Michigan

How Acquired: 4th round pick, 2021 draft (Trenton High School, MI)

Season Notes: Placed on 7-day IL on 4/16 (ankle sprain)...Fanned three over four scoreless innings on 4/15 at GBO...Entered season as #27 prospect in system per MLB Pipeline... On Opening Day roster.

Career Notes: Spent 2024 with Clearwater, where he went 3-9 with a 4.88 ERA over 19 starts...He struck out 99 and walked 41 in 94 innings pitched...His longest outing was seven innings, on 5/21 at St. Lucie, allowing two runs, and he threw at least six innings five times...His season high-strikeout total was eight on 8/24 vs Dunedin...Threw a combined 14 innings between 2021 and 2023, having Tommy John Surgery in 2022...Committed to Michigan State before signing with the Phillies.

The following players did so multiple times: Ben Brown (4, 2022), Sam Aldegheri (3, 2024), Jean Cabrera (3, 2024), Griff McGarry (3, 2022), Eiberson Castellano (2, 2024).

- 10 Strikeout Games in 2025: (none)

Strikeout Marks - Jean Cabrera struck out 14 Wilmington Blue Rocks on 6/12/24, the second-most in a game by a BlueClaws pitcher, behind Jose Taveras' 15 strikeout game on 6/25/16 at Greenville.
