series vs. the Indianapolis Indians (Pittsburgh Pirates) at Coolray Field, the only series between the two clubs this season. Tonight is Pride Night, and Thirsty Thursday™ presented by Michelob Ultra (fans age 21 and older can get select 12 oz. domestic beers for \$2 each).

VS. INDIANAPOLIS: Gwinnett is 33-21 (.611) all-time vs. Indianapolis at Coolray Field, and enters play riding an eight-game home winning streak over the Indians dating back to 4/23/19 (outscoring IND 49-22). The Stripers have won seven straight overall vs. Indianapolis since 6/1/19 (outscoring IND 42-20). In 11 season series vs. Indianapolis since 2009, Gwinnett is 3-4-4 (2-0 since 2018).

STIFLING STARTERS: Stripers' starters (Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa) have combined to post a 2.62 ERA (23 ER in 79.0 IP), 10.03 SO/9.0 IP ratio (88 SO in 79.0 IP), and seven quality starts over the last 14 games (team is 7-7). The group has allowed 61 hits and just 20 walks in that span.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 634 in 62 games (10.23 SO per game). That's two more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 632 SO in 62G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 84), Tucker Davidson (11th, 53), and Huascar Ynoa (T-17th, 50) all rank in the IL top 20 in strikeouts.

WATERS WATCH: Drew Waters tallied the GWRBI last night with a seventh-inning sacrifice fly. In 29 games since being activated from Gwinnett's 7-day IL on 5/3, he's batting .243 (27-for-111, 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 10 RBI, 1 SB, .664 OPS), including .444 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.113 OPS) vs. LHP and .147 (1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, .452 OPS) vs. RHP.

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year, including leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), and a leadoff triple on 6/11 at Jacksonville (off RHP Bryan Hoeing).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (153-for-622, 32 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 58 RBI, 32 SB, .702 OPS) in 158 games.

LET'S GET TROMPICAL: Chadwick Tromp has notched three RBI in his last two games, his first time driving in runs in consecutive games since his Gwinnett record 11-game RBI streak from 4/28-5/12 (.419, 4 2B, 7 HR, 23 RBI, 1.447 OPS during the streak). Tromp leads the Stripers in RBI (32) and homers (9), and is tied for second on the club in total bases (71, trailing only Phil Gosselin's 86).

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Preston Tucker went 0-for-4 last night, snapping his 12-game on-base streak. He hit .300 (12-for-40, 3 2B, 2 HR, 4 R, 5 RBI, 10 BB, .965 OPS) on the streak from 5/27-6/14, his second-longest this season (had 13-game on-base streak from 4/24-5/12). Braden Shewmake has a five-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .333 (6-for-18, 2 2B, 2 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, .794 OPS).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 35 of 42 games (83.3%) with the Stripers this season, batting .252 (30-for-119, 5 2B, 16 R, 10 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-10th, 13) and walks (T-11th, 31).

IONIGHT: The Stripers play game three of a six-game **DEMERITTE RETURNS:** Travis **Demeritte** played for the first time since 6/1 on Tuesday (0-for-3, 2 BB, 1 R, 1 SB), his second game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

> **GWN Career:** Demeritte has reached base safely in 163 of 191 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .283 (186-for-658, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 129 R, 137 RBI, 14 SB, .941 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meiia.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out 11 batters over 7.0 IP (4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB) for the win on Tuesday, his second double-digit strikeout game of the year (tied career high with 12 SO over 6.0 IP on 5/14 at DUR). He has recorded three straight quality starts since 6/2, going 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER in 20.0 IP), 0.90 WHIP, .194 BAA, and 12.60 SO/9.0 IP ratio (28 SO) in that span.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (84) and is among the top 10 in ERA (3rd, 2.89), WHIP (5th, 1.19), innings (T-5th, 62.1), and BAA (T-6th, .230).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.17 ERA (50 ER in 142.0 IP), .226 BAA, and 177 strikeouts (11.22 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 28 starts.

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 from 2017-19).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: On Tuesday, the Atlanta Braves selected the contract of INF Phil Gosselin from Gwinnett. Gosselin hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, he ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI, .831 OPS) in 49 games.

GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS). He is one of just seven players in Gwinnett history to record 300 career hits with the club.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.
