WELL EDUCATED: With the FredNats' Wednesday morning win, they improve to 1-1 in "education day" games this season. Wednesday was the highest attended Salem game this season by nearly one thousand spectators, with the FredNats taking down the RidgeYaks in a morning first pitch. The FredNats will play their third straight "education day" on Wednesday next week, as they host the Carolina League-leading Hickory Crawdads.

BACK DOWN TO EARTH: After the best start to a season in Fredericksburg history (and the best start for the franchise overall in at least 20 years), the FredNats have leveled out, still leading the Carolina League North, but going 6-5 in their first two six game-series.

I CAN DO THE SPLITS: With Wednesday's win, the FredNats have now opened up each of their first three six games series by going 1-1 in the first two games. After dropping a series opener for the first time in Salem, the FredNats won the second game of the series for just the second time this year, and the first time in a six game set.

DO I KNOW YOU?: The FredNats hit the road to take on the Salem RidgeYaks, a familiar franchise with an unfamiliar name. The RidgeYaks are one of three teams to relocate or rebrand in the Carolina League for this season, after being known as the Salem Red Sox since 2009. A member of the Carolina League since 1968, the RidgeYaks last title came in 2013, when they defeated the then-Potomac Nationals in the championship series, and were managed at the time by 2025 FredNats manager Billy McMillon.

NO DAYS OFF: Monday's off day still included some FredNats news, including their first award and call-ups of the season. After hitting .500 and going a perfect 6/6 on stolen bases, OF Jeremy Cabrera was named Carolina League Player of the Week. In addition, more FredNat news came in Monday morning, with the first two promotions of the season, as INF Ronny Cruz and RHP Isaac Lyon were assigned to High-A Wilmington.

ABOUT LAST YEAR: The FredNats finished last season at 65-64 overall under Manager Billy McMillon, following the championship in 2024 by winning the North division's second half title to advance to the playoffs for the second straight year. The FredNats' season concluded with a two games to none loss to eventual Carolina League Champion Lynchburg in the Division Series.

UP TO OUR ARMPITS IN PROSPECTS: The Fredericksburg Opening Day roster is loaded with some of the top talent in the revamped Nationals organization, headlined by Washington's top prospect Eli Willits, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft. Willits is ranked as baseball's 9th-best prospect overall by MLB Pipeline. Overall, the FredNat roster has seven prospects ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 20 Nationals prospects.

MACKENZIE'S GONE: The FredNats opening day roster includes two of the five prospects dealt back to Washington from Texas as part of the trade for Nats' top end arm MacKenzie Gore. Last year's 12th overall pick Gavin Fien debuts as the fifth-best prospect in the Nationals organization, and is joined by former Rangers prospect Jeremy Cabrera (Nats No. 20) in the haul back from Texas. Both players bring Carolina League experience to FXBG after finishing last year with the Hickory Crawdads.

THE STAFF: Manager Chris O'Neill leads a coaching staff of seven newcomers to the Washington organization, and the average age of the coaching staff is 28.

WE ARE GETTING YOUNGER: The new staff in Fredericksburg follows a trend of young brainchildren charged with working in the Nationals organization this year, with other notable hires within the organization including President of Baseball Operations Paul Toboni (currently the youngest lead executive in MLB), General Manager Anirudh "Ani" Kilambi (aged 31), and Major League Manager Blake Butera (the youngest manager in MLB since 1972 at 33 years old).

FREDNATS BASEBALL NETWORK IS BACK: Once again, all 132 FredNat games this season will be broadcast live on the FredNats Baseball Network, with Luke West Poley and Adam Gotkin beginning their first seasons calling the action in Fredericksburg. Home games are broadcast on MiLB.tv and the Bally Sports Live App to go along with the audio-only stream at frednats.com/broadcast or the MiLB App. For road games, the radio broadcast is available at the same link. In addition, all FredNats games preceded by a 20 minute pregame show and postgame coverage following each night of action.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Potomac Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

Chris O'Neill - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Hitting Coach/Recruiting Coordinator, Virginia Commonwealth University

O'Neill, 36, joins the Nationals organization after two seasons (2024-25) as a hitting coach/recruiting coordinator at Virginia Commonwealth University. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at George Washington from 2022-24.

O'Neill is credited with helping fuel major offensive surges at both VCU and George Washington, as both schools set offensive records and contended for Atlantic 10 championships under his watch. O'Neill spent the 2021 season as the director of operations at Duke University and prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at Bucknell University (2020), Marshall University (2018-19) and the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore (2017).

This season will be O'Neill's first time managing since he led the Grand Lake Mariners (Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League) in the summers of 2016 and 2017. A Pennsylvania native, he received his Bachelor's degree in Education from King's College in 2012. O'Neill and his wife Kate have two boys, Easton and Callum.



Luke Dziados - PITCHING COACH

1st Season | Previously: Pitching Trainer - Driveline Baseball (Tampa, Fla.)

Dziados (D-Zay-Dis), 27, comes to the Nationals organization after spending the last two years as a pitching trainer at Driveline Baseball in Tampa, Fla. He capped his college pitching career at Villanova University in 2023 after pitching at Binghamton University from 2018-20. Dziados earned his Bachelor's degree from Binghamton in 2021 and also earned a Graduate Certificate in Leadership from Villanova in 2023.



Jake Scheiner - HITTING COACH

Scheiner, 30, played seven seasons (2017-23) in the Phillies and Mariners organizations. He appeared in 658 Minor League games before signing in 2024 with Hiroshima Toyo Carp of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan. A native of San Mateo, Calif., Scheiner was drafted in the fourth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Houston.



Luis Villanueva - ASSISTANT PITCHING COACH

Villanueva, 24, was a performance coach at LAVR Performance where he designed and led throwing programs to improve overall pitching performance for more than 50 athletes prior to joining Washington's coaching ranks. Villanueva attended and played baseball for both Kansas Wesleyan University and MidAmerica Nazarene University.



Anthony Ray - DEFENSIVE COACH

Ray, 30, joins Washington after spending the 2025 season as a hitting and outfield coach with the Rocky Mountain Vibes of the independent Pioneer League. He transitioned to the coaching role after 487 professional games across 10 seasons between the St. Louis Cardinals system and independent leagues.

- Began collegiate career at Coastal Carolina, splitting time between bullpen and starting roles for the Chanticleers, struck out 33 in 33.2 IP with a 9.36 ERA.
- Transferred to Vanderbilt for his final two seasons, pitching exclusively in a bullpen role. Pitched 28 innings across two seasons at Vanderbilt, with a career-best 2.81 ERA as a junior, appearing in short relief roles (~1 IP/app).
- Father (football/baseball) and brother (football) were college athletes at Chattanooga, with brother playing in the NFL for Pittsburgh, Tennessee and the New York Giants. Grandfather Jack was INF in the Cardinals system in the 1950s, reaching as high as AAA Rochester (now a Nationals affiliate).
- Pitched '22 and '23 summers with Tri-City in the Coastal Plain League, before spending 2024 appearing nine times for the Brewster Whitecaps of the Cape Cod League.
- Multiple outlets named Huesman a high school All American, and was the top-ranked pitcher in his class out of the state of Virginia. Was starting quarterback in high school, and also led baseball team to an 18-game winning streak to end senior season, capped off by a state championship.
