**SATURDAY:** The Amarillo Sod Poodles (16-16) defeated the Wichita Wind Surge (16-16), 9-7 in 10 innings, on Saturday night at HODGETOWN. A pair of first inning errors led to a five-run Wichita frame. Down 6-0 after the top of the second, the Soddies started their comeback with **Angel Ortiz's** two-RBI single in the home half of the frame. **Manuel Pena** and **Gavin Logan** added leadoff homers the third and fourth innings. Back down by three after a Wind Surge sac fly, Logan hit his second home run of the night to bring Amarillo within a run in the sixth. **Ben McLaughlin** was able to race home as the tying run on a passed ball. Both bullpens held firm over the next three innings, which sent the game to the 10th. A scoreless top of the 10th set the stage for Logan to tuck a 2-1 fastball from Kyle Bischoff inside the left field foul pole to send the Sod Poodles home as walk-off winners. Amarillo's scheduled Sunday afternoon series finale against the Wind Surge was cancelled due to inclement weather.

**GAV-IN THE ZONE:** Gavin Logan had a monster night at the plate on Saturday, hitting three home runs as he reached base five times... it was his first multi-homer game of his minor league career along with his first homer and multi-hit game against right-handed pitching in 2026...he is the most recent Sod Poodle to tally three long balls in a game since Christian Cerda on August 17, 2025 against the Corpus Christi Hooks...he also tied Cerda for most total bases recorded (13) in a single game in franchise history.

**I'M McLAUGHLIN IT:** Ben McLaughlin reached base four times out of the leadoff spot on Saturday...it was his just his fourth career game batting first and his second with Amarillo, where he's slashed .500/.611/.714.

**WAY OF THE K:** Six Sod Poodles pitchers combined to strike out 17 Wind Surge batters on Saturday...as a staff, Amarillo has struck out at least 10 batters in every game in the previous homestand and is tied for second in the Texas League in punchouts with 334.

**REY OF HOPE:** Soddies reliever Carlos Rey turned in his longest outing of the season on Saturday as he struck out three batters over 1.2 innings...he has struck out 26 batters in 11.0 innings pitched, giving him a 21.27 K/9 rate that clears any Texas League pitcher who has logged at least 11 innings...Rey has not allowed a run in his most recent eight games, the third-longest active streak in the TL.

**ANGEL EYES:** Angel Ortiz checked in with three hits in Saturday's contest...he has recorded multiple hits in five of his most recent 10 games and enters play on Sunday as one of 13 qualified Texas League hitters batting over .300.

**ROMAN EMPIRE:** Roman Angelo was an unsung hero for Amarillo Saturday after taking over in the first...turned in his longest outing of the season...he held Wichita to two runs over 3.1 IP.

**DOWN IN THE DESERT:** No. 1 D-Backs prospect Ryan Waldschmidt made his first start in the majors on Saturday...he batted ninth and played center field in Arizona's 2-1 win vs. the New York Mets.

#### SUMMARY

- ▶ Selected by the Diamondbacks in the 3rd round (102nd ovr.) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Presbyterian College...inked a \$650,000 signing bonus.
- ▶ In 2024 at Presbyterian College, went 6-2 over 14 starts with a 2.67 ERA in 77.2 innings...struck out 121 batters, good for a 14.0 K/9 rate...fanned 172 batters total in his three-year collegiate career.
- ▶ One of only eight players ever drafted out of Presbyterian College...Presbyterian teammate Joel Dragoo was selected in the 7th round in 2024 by the Phillies...the most recent draft selection from Presbyterian was a 25th round pick by the Diamondbacks in 2013 as Arizona selected RHP Bud Jeter.
- ▶ Pitched his first professional game in 2025 with High-A Hillsboro on 4/3 against Eugene.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Was given his fifth loss of the season, which is the most of any Texas League pitcher.
- ▶ Both of his season-low two hits he allowed left the yard for Wind Surge solo home runs...the first came from Kala'i Rosario to center field in the second inning and the other was by Ricardo Olivar to left field in the third.
- ▶ Struck out six batters for the second straight game...his 29 on the season are third-most among Amarillo pitchers.

#### OPENING DAY

- ▶ Named the Opening Day starter for Amarillo in 2026.
- ▶ On 4/3 at home against Springfield, tossed four shutout innings out of the gate...fanned two Cardinals in his first inning of work.

#### A QUALITY FIRST IMPRESSION

- ▶ Made his Double-A debut on the road at San Antonio on 8/22/25.
- ▶ Was perfect through 5.1 IP...perfect game bid was broken up in the 6th when Moisés Gómez reached on an error...no-hit bid was broken on a Braedon Karpathios two-out single in the 6th.
- ▶ Only the fourth game in Soddiess history where a starter tossed 7.2+ shutout innings...was also the fewest hits allowed (2) by a Sod Poodles pitcher pitching beyond the 7th inning...the longest start by a Soddie making their debut in club history.
