FRES-NOTES

FRUSTRATING FRIDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (13-11) stumbled to the Inland Empire 66ers (8-16) 3-2 Friday evening from San Manuel Stadium. Fresno has dropped four straight games and eight of their last nine after starting the season 12-3. The Grizzlies are now tied for second place in the California League North Division standings after the San Jose Giants won their eighth consecutive contest and the Modesto Nuts enjoyed a walk-off victory again, their fourth straight triumph. The Grizzlies also lost the series to the 66ers, falling to 0-4 in May. Fresno moved to 0-3 in one-run games and 9-3 when allowing three runs or fewer (6-2 on the road). Grizzlies' starter Jack Mahoney (2-3) was tagged with a tough loss after a stellar performance. Mahoney twirled a career-high six and one-third firames and nine punchouts were career-highs for Mahoney and the most by a Fresno pitcher this season. He also retired 11 batters in a row at one point in the contest. Jake Snider reached base safely all five times, going 2-for-2 with two walks and a hit-by-pitch. Caleb Hobson ripped a triple and Andy Perez lined a double, with the former picking up one RBI.

INFO ABOUT INLAND EMPIRE: The Fresno Grizzlies and Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angeles Single-A affiliate) continue their seven-game series tonight at San Manuel Stadium. This is the last of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting this year in San Bernardino. The 66ers are the current affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels and have been a part of the Angels system since 2011. Prior to teaming up with the Angels, the 66ers had ties to the Los Angeles Dodgers (1995-2000, 2007-2010) and Seattle Mariners (1987-1994, 2001-2006) organizations. They were also the former Fresno Giants/Fresno Cardinals franchise. The 66ers are named after the historic U.S. Route 66 that runs through San Bernardino. Prior to the name change, the 66ers were known as the San Bernardino Stampede (1996-2002) and San Bernardino Spirit (1987-1995). The mascot for Inland Empire is Bernie, who is one of the only talking mascots in all of professional baseball. Bernie has been a part of the organization since 1999. The 66ers play at San Manuel Stadium and are owned by Diamond Baseball Holdings (DRH)

COUPET GETS THE NOD: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

WELL HERRERA THROWS A TON OF STRIKES: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has seven consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 3. Herrera has tossed eight and two-thirds innings, allowing six hits, one hit-by-pitch and no walks while striking out 16 in that stretch. He has not walked a batter in his first nine outings this season as well (April 7-May 3). Herrera has chucked 11.1 frames, beaning three batters and punching out 21 on the year.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an unbelievable start to the season (21 games), going 20-for-58 (345 AVG/585 OBP/586 SLG/1171 OPS) with one homer, two triples, seven doubles, 13 RBI, 18 runs, 28 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and five stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked first in ALL of professional baseball with a .585 OBP and 28 walks. Snider's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has also had an outstanding start to the season (23 games), going 30-for-95 (.316 AVG/.356 OBP/.558 SLG/.914 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, five doubles, 20 RBI, 13 runs, six walks and two stolen bases. The Cuban product is ranked among the Top 10 in nine different California League categories. He is ranked first in total bases (53), tied for first in hits (30), tied for first in extra-base hits (12), tied for second in homers (4), third in RBI (20), third in slugging percentage (.558), tied for third in triples (3), tied for fifth in batting average (.316) and ninth in OPS (.914). Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games to start the season (22 of first 23 games this year), his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Like Snider, Perez's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

OFFENSE IS IN HIBERNATION: The Grizzlies started the season 12-3 and the offense averaged 7.13 runs per game. Since then, Fresno is 1-8 and the offense is averaging 3.11 runs per game.

2024 (pro): Enters 2nd professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...Can generate more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball...Favors his low-80s slider, which has 2-plane depth, but his mid-70s curveball is a plus pitch in its own right...Fastball sits at 89-91 MPH and tops out at 93 MPH...Also owns a sinking mid-80s changeup.

2023 (pro): Pitched in just 5 games after being selected by the Rockies in the 4th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State...Was ranked as the Rockies #25 overall prospect on MLB.com after the draft...Became the 115th Buckeye to be drafted since 1966 and highest drafted since Dillon Dingler (2020)...6th player to be selected by Colorado and joins Ryan Feltner in the system...Over 2 relief appearances with the ACL Rockies, tossed 2 scoreless innings, issuing 1 walk while fanning 3...Assigned to Fresno on September 5... Struck out a batter and induced a double play in Fresno debut September 5 vs. Modesto...Fanned lone batter he faced September 6 vs. Modesto...Came in with 2 runners on and no outs in a tied game, left both runners stranded September 8 vs. Modesto.
