### FRES-NOTES

**LOWRIDERS RAN OUT OF GAS AGAIN:** The Lowriders de Fresno (8-15, 46-42) ran out of gas, sputtering to the San Jose Giants (17-6, 54-34) 6-0 Saturday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno suffered their second straight shutout loss and dropped their fifth consecutive contest to San Jose. The Lowriders are 1-9 in their last 10 games against the Giants, who now hold a nine-game lead in the North Division second half. It was the sixth shutout involving both teams in 2024 with the last four going against Fresno. The Lowriders have scored four runs over their last five affairs with three of them ending in shutouts versus Fresno. The Lowriders offense stalled again, giving them 241 straight innings without netting a run (3-run 3rd on Sunday, July 14 at Lake Elsinore). Fresno tallied two hits (both singles) and three walks in the setback. Over the two games, the Lowriders have yielded eight singles with only one batter attaining scoring position. Felix Tena reached base safely all three times, drawing two walks and tapping an infield single. Tena also swiped his sixth bag of the year. Jason Hinchman roped a single in the third and completed an unreal catch in right field. Fresno righty Bryan Perez (3-4) agonized the defeat after four and two-thirds innings of two-run ball. Perez scattered three hits, four walks and two hit-by-pitches, while fanning five. A quartet of arms followed Perez with Brady Hill tossing a scoreless appearance. Stu Flesland III notched three strikeouts among his four outs.

**GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) conclude their three-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the fifth of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Fresno. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 56-54 overall in the regular season (14-9 San Jose in the 2024 season series) and 2-3 in the playoffs (58-57 Fresno) against the Giants since joining the California League in 2021.

**FROM FRIEND TO FOE:** The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 761 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Yulwin Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

**JACK OF ALL TRADES:** Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #19 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney is from Illinois and grew up with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

**KAMINSKA NAMED CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska was tabbed by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for July 8-14. Kaminska (5-4, win) was unbelievable Sunday afternoon (July 14) in Lake Elsinore. Kaminska weathered the storm offense for a career-high seven shutout innings (89 pitches, 62 strikes). He gave up three singles and did not issue a walk, striking out a professional-best 10. Kaminska has walked one batter over his last six outings (three straight games without a walk), spanning 35 innings. He has 42 punchouts over that timeframe (six games). The University of Nebraska-Lincoln product enjoyed his first California League award this season, giving the 2024 Grizzlies their seventh weekly and monthly honors in 2024 (Wellington Herrera, Isaiah Coupet, Braulyn Wimmer and Jack Mahoney, three times). Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record.

**ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpnor and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

**MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ:** Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker, Nate Schierholtz, Jason Ellison and Calvin Murray each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 67 times in 174 plate appearances (37 games; 39% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 37 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 32 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-29 (.310) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-37, 46% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (26/30 in stolen bases on the season).

**RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 26 bases this season. Hobson is currently nine stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.

**THERE IS NO E IN HOBSON OR CRUZ:** Grizzlies' OFs Caleb Hobson and Fadel Cruz have both not committed an error this season. Hobson has a no error streak of 66 games (65 in CF and 1 in RF) in 558.2 innings. Hobson has had 169 total chances in the field, making 164 putouts with five assists and one double play. Cruz has a no error streak of 40 games (has played all three OF positions) in 321.1 frames. Cruz has had 64 total chances with all ending in a putout.
