Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Stripers play the fourth of a six-game set at First Horizon Park tonight. Gwinnett has won the first three games in the series. Right-hander Colin Rea starts for the Sounds tonight against right-hander Bryce Elder for the Stripers.

Colin Rea: 31-year-old Colin Rea makes his third start of the 2021 season tonight. Rea is 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA in his first two starts with Nashville. He last pitched on August 21 in a start at Memphis and allowed 4 runs on 8 hits in 3.2 innings. Prior to signing a minor league contract with Milwaukee, the right-hander was previously pitching for the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks in Japan. In 2020, Rea pitched 14.0 innings for the Chicago Cubs and compiled a 5.79 ERA. The Iowa native went 5-5 in 20 appearances with a 4.82 ERA in 2016 with San Diego and Miami. He was selected by the Padres in the 12th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Bryce Elder: 22-year-old Bryce Elder pitches for the Stripers in game four of the series tonight. The right-hander is making his second start with Gwinnett after being promoted from Double-A Mississippi on August 17. Elder started the season in Advanced-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.60 ERA in 9 starts before he went 7-1 with a 3.21 ERA in 9 starts with Mississippi. Overall, in 2021, he is 10-2 with a 2.97 ERA in 19 starts, covering 106.0 innings. He has allowed 80 hits and 40 walks to go along with 121 strikeouts. Elder's Triple-A debut was on August 20 at Louisville where he picked up a win. He went 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 3 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts. The Braves drafted Elder in the 5th round of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 59, Third: 5, Fourth: 23, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Tight Teams: The Sounds and Stripers have played 21 times with Nashville holding a 12-9 series lead into tonight's game. 13 of the 21 games have been decided by one or two runs, with three of the games (May 19, June 18 and August 25) needing extra innings to decide the outcome. Overall, in games decided by two or less runs, the Sounds are 24-21.

The Senior Circuit is a Problem: Nashville continues to struggle against National League affiliates and enters tonight's game with a 28-35 record against NL teams. Comparatively, the Sounds are 24-12 against American League affiliates. Having the designated hitters has helped the Sounds throughout the season. The DH spot for Nashville has put together a .282 batting average (35-for-124) with 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 18 RBI and 28 walks compared to only 28 strikeouts. Nashville has only one series remaining against an AL affiliate - September 22-26 when they host Triple-A Columbus.

Quality Stuff: Josh Lindblom turned in his team-leading sixth quality start last night (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 8 K) and Nashville's 22nd of the season. Alec Bettinger is second on the club with four quality starts. The Sounds are now 13-11 when their starter goes at least 6.0 innings.

Dahl's Damage: Outfielder David Dahl extended his hitting streak to seven games with a double in last night's game. He has hit safely in every game he has played in with the Sounds and is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with 7 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 3 RBI in the seven contests.

Hot August Nights: As the weather has gotten hotter, so has outfielder Matt Lipka's bat. With three more hits last night, Lipka is now hitting .333 (19-for-57) over 19 games in the month of August. In the 19 contests, Lipka has 13 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBI, 5 walks and 8 stolen bases.

Trending in the Wrong Direction: Wins have been hard to come by lately for the Sounds. After last night's loss, the club has lost 12 of their last 15 games.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2016, the Sounds got a strong performance from Dillon Overton, and big offensive games from Matt Olson and Joey Wendle in a 2-1 win in Memphis. Overton allowed one run in six innings and earned the win. Olson went 3-for-5 with two doubles and two runs scored while Wendle went 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI. The win was in the middle of a hot streak that saw the Sounds win 10 of 11 games.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is closing in on the career milestone of 2,100 managerial wins at the minor league level. Entering play today, Sweet has been at the helm for 2,083 wins, spanning all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues dating back to 1987. His 2,083 wins are the 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
