LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn returned to the win column with a 4-1 win at Jersey Shore on Thursday night...C Ronald Hernandez delivered a game-tying RBI double in the 2nd and added a long solo home run in the 9th...1B Estarling Mercado posted a run-producing single that gave the Cyclones the lead in the 2nd...RF Carson Benge garnered 2 hits, including a double and a triple, adding a walk...SS Marco Vargas reached base 3 times with a single and 2 walks...RHP R.J. Gordon fell an out shy of qualifying for the win, striking out 7 over 4.2 innings of 1-run ball...RHP Jace Beck tossed 1.1 innings of scoreless and hitless relief for his 3rd win...RHP Ben Simon went 2.0 scoreless out of the bullpen for the hold...RHP Saúl García registered the final 3 outs for his 4th save...The game was delayed 2 hours and 28 minutes at the start due to rain... Contest went from being a doubleheader to a single 9-inning game.

RAIN, RAIN GO AWAY: The Cyclones and BlueClaws had Game 2 of Thursday evening's scheduled doubleheader rained out...They will make up the postponed contest with a doubleheader on Friday...The two teams will play another twinbill on Sunday to make up for the washed-out affair on Saturday, April 26...Saturday's scheduled twinbill will now be a single 9-inning game...Thursday marked the 4th time the Cyclones had been rained out in 2025... Brooklyn was washed out 6 times in 2024...Brooklyn split its only doubleheader in 2025, losing Game 1 vs. Hudson Valley on April 12, 2-0, and winning Game 2, 2-1...In 2024, the Cyclones were 2-1-3 in doubleheaders, holding a 7-5 record overall...Friday will mark Brooklyn's first doubleheader against Jersey Shore since being swept on June 3, 2023, in Lakewood...The 'Clones dropped the opener, 3-2, in 8 innings and the finale, 3-2, in 7 frames.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City... Brooklyn continued to wreak havoc on the bases in a May 17 win over Winston-Salem, during which the Cyclones stole 6 bases courtesy of 3 players...Brooklyn enters play on Friday with 93 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (111)... The 93 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 40 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital ERA (2005-present) by 26 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 67 steals through 40 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: With Sunday's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021... Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021. ws. Wilmington... The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...It was the first time the team had won 6-straight games since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Additionally, the Cyclones' 27-13 record through 40 games is tied with the 2009 squad for the franchise's 2nd-best through 40 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...The 2007 team holds the best mark at 28-12.

CAN EW BELIEVE IT?: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He is the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Friday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (6), tied for 3rd in stolen bases (29), 4th in batting average (.366), and 9th in on-base percentage (.463)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (15) and is tied for 4th in triples (2), 6th in hitting (.333), 8th in on-base percentage (.418), and tied for 9th in hits (23)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Friday riding a 24-game on-base streak isnce April 18...During the on-base streak, Ewing has hit .344/.450/.516/.966 with 19 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 13 RBI, 18 walks, and 12 to the place of the control of the con

**REIM TIME:** INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer launched his 7th home run of the season in May 15's win vs. Winston-Salem...Entering play on Friday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (26), 4th in slugging percentage (.636), Lied for 5th in doubles (16), tied for 6th in total bases (91), and 8th in OPS (1.058)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (34), slugging percentage (.636), OPS (1.058), extra-base hits (26), hits (48), and doubles (16)...Reimer is also 2nd in batting average (.336) and total bases (91), 3rd in RBI (32), tied for 4th in triples (3), tied for 6th in home runs (7), and 8th in on-base percentage (.422)...Reimer had his 20-game on-base streak since April 24 snapped on Thursday...In that time, he hit .364/.473/.688/1.161 with 21 runs scored, 10 doubles, 5 home runs, 18 RBI, 13 walks, 4 steals, and 3 hit-by-pitches...Reimer also had a 9-game hitting streak since May 8 halted on Friday, in which he was 13-for-34 (.382) at the dish with a 1.235 OPS.

ALL ABOUT THE BENGE-AMINS: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Friday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also tied for 4th in slugging percentage (.543) and extra-base hits (17), 5th in runs scored (28), total bases (70), and OPS (972), 6th in batting average (.318), hits (41), and on-base percentage (.429), tied for 7th in walks (26), and tied for 9th in RBI (25)...The 22-year-old is riding an 11-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville, in which he is hitting 400/.519/.800/1.319 at the plate with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 triples, 2 home runs, 14 RBI, 11 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Benge has also reached base safely in 14-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .360/.492/.740/1.232 with 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 16 RBI, 14 walks, and 6 stolen bases.

BYE, BYE, BÁEZ: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly started to return to form...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 13-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .295/.436/.409/.845 with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 8 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 10 walks to 7 strikeouts..Báez also enters Friday with a 4-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem, going 5-for-13 (.385) at the plate with 2 RBI and 5 walks... On Tuesday, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore.

**KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING:** The Cyclones have yet to drop a series through the first 40 games of the 2025 season...Through Brooklyn's first 7 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 5-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6

vs. JERSEY SHORE: After sweeping a 6-game homestand vs. Winston-Salem, Brooklyn hits the road for a 7-game series with the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 at Wilmington...The BlueClaws are 8-10 at home this season and dropped 3-of-5 to Brooklyn in Lakewood from April 22-27...Jersey Shore boasts 8 of the Phillies' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Devin Saltiban (9), INF Bryan Rincon (14), INF Carson DeMartini (15), OF John Spikerman (16), LHP Mavis Graves (17), RHP Alex McFarlane (18), RHP Micah Ottenbreit (28), and OF Dylan Campbell (30)...Saltiban and Spikerman are currently on the injured list...In 117 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 60-57 (.513)... Brooklyn is 32-31 (.508) in 63 games at ShoreTown Ballpark.

at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 7-0-2 in a series of any length.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Friday, Cyclones relievers have a 16-6 record with a 3.39 ERA (70 ER in 185.2 IP), 9 saves, 93 walks, and an eye-popping 245 strikeouts...Brooklyn's relief staff holds the 4th-best strikeoutsper-9-innings ratio in Minor League Baseball (11.88), Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa is first (12.61)... The Cyclones relievers have also held opponents to a 185 batting average, which is the lowest in the South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest in MiLB...Detroit's Double-A Erie (.164) leads the Minors...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 31.98% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the goahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-yearold recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley... Entering play on Friday, Suero is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (11) and tied for 6th in home runs (7) and tied for 7th in stolen bases (15).

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 17 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 30 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 30-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .302/.420/.377/.797 with 24 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 16 RBI, 22 walks, and 10 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville...RF Eli Serano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...lt marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B Luke Ritter, 18 Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knox-ville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul... Brooklyn enters Friday tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (37)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (45) has hit home runs through the team's first 40 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 8 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3-2 with a 1.82 ERA (8 ER in 39.2 IP), 42 strikeouts and only 26 hits allowed...Entering Friday, Hall is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.82), 5th in batting average against (183), 8th in innings pitched (39.2), and tied for 8th in double plays induced (3)...Hall's 44.8% infield fly ball rate are tops in the league... The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SIR SERRANO: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game. His only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF Alex Ramirez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley....Entering Friday, Serrano is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (10) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16).

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On May 23, 2021, the C Hayden Senger hammered a walk-off 3-run home run in the bottom of the 12th in a 6-5 win vs. Hudson Valley...The home run comes in Senger's final at-bat as a Cyclone...He was assigned to Double-A Binghamton the next day... In 2023, LF Jaylen Palmer tallied 2 hits, a home run, and 2 RBI in a 7-3 win vs. Winston-Salem... In 2024, Brooklyn played its first game on SNY as a full-season affiliate, falling at Maimonides Park to Hudson Valley, 16-3.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the 1st victory of his professional career last Friday night vs. Winston-Salem...Tossed a career-high 5.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...Walked 2 and struck out 5...Retired the final 10 batters he faced in order after escaping a bases-loaded jam in the 2nd...Threw a career-high 81 pitches and 53 strikes (65.43%)...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to start the top of the 6th inning with the Cyclones leading 1-0...Hawkins (2.0 IP) and RHP **Chandler Marsh** (2.0) combined to throw 4.0 innings of scoreless relief to close out Brooklyn's 6-0 victory...The Cyclones scored 2 in the 6th, 1 in the 7th, and 2 more in the 8th to pull away.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Suffered the loss in his professional debut on 4/9 vs. HV (4.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 5 K)...Struck out a career-high 6 in a no-decision on 4/15 @ABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 6 K)...Suffered the loss, but tossed a career-long 4.1 innings on 5/3 vs. WIL (4.1 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 3 K)...Tossed a career-long 4.2 innings and career-high 78 pitches in a no-decision on 5/9 @ASH (4.2 IP, 10 H, 5 R, 5 ER, BB, 4 K)...Posted a career-high 5.0 innings and earned the 1st win of his professional career on 5/16 vWS (5.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 5 K).

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America...* He is also ranked the Mets' No. 15 farmhand by SNY's **Joe DeMayo...**Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

**SPRING BREAKOUT:** Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** during the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

**DEVILISHLY GOOD:** Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

**DUAL THREAT:** During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

**FAMILY TIES:** Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...He was a 19th-round pick of the St. Louis Cardinals out of Assumption in 1993...Played 4 seasons of Minor League Baseball as an outfielder...Reached Double-A Arkansas in 1996...Spent parts of 2 seasons in the New York-Penn League with the Glens Falls (N.Y.) Redbirds in 1993 and the New Jersey Cardinals in 1994...Hit .241/.311/.324/.635 in 403 career games with 16 home runs and 121 RBI...Was teammates of former Mets INF **Joe McEwing**, Cardinals RHP **Matt Morris**, and Detroit Tigers **I**NF **Placido Polanco**...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball as an outfielder at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.) from 2017-22.
