**RIDERS WIN SERIES OPENER IN COME-FROM-BEHIND FASHION:**

Behind a five-run sixth, the Frisco RoughRiders came from behind to drop the San Antonio Missions on Tuesday night, 10-4, from Nelson Wolff Stadium. Frisco (31-25) fell behind early when the Missions (26-33) scored three in the third and one in the fourth, tallying three of their runs on wild pitches, to lead 4-0. In the top of the sixth, the Riders stormed back against Victor Lizarraga (2-6) with five runs to take the lead. **Corey Joyce** and **Orlando Martinez** collected RBI singles before a **Julian Brock** RBI double and **Max Wagner** two-run double put Frisco in front 5-4. **Marcus Lee Sang** roped an RBI double in the 8th and Martinez added an RBI single in the ninth prior to a Brock RBI groundout and Wagner two-run single, pushing the lead to 10-4. **Aidan Curry** (1-1) worked through 5.0 innings to earn his first career Double-A victory.

**RAFE AT HOME:**

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had an incredibly clutch introduction to his new team, homering 4 times in his first 9 games with the RoughRiders. On Sunday in Arkansas, he crushed a solo shot and added an RBI single in a 2-1 win before he blasted a walk-off home run on Wednesday at home. In the doubleheader Sunday, he hit go-ahead home runs in the fifth and sixth innings of the games, respectively. His 15 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization and tied for T-10th among non-Triple-A players. Between High-A Hub City and Frisco, he won May Texas Rangers Player of the Month, hitting .327/.427/.714/1.141 with 11 home runs and 32 RBIs.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:**

The RoughRiders have won 4 games in a row, entering the second game of this series at San Antonio. During the streak, the Riders have outscored their opponents 33-15 with the best ERA in the Texas League (3.94 ERA). Frisco's bullpen during the streak owns a 2.30 ERA (4ER/15.2IP), including the three solo home runs the Riders allowed in the final inning of Sunday's doubleheader finale.

**HUNGRY LIKE THE WOLFF:**

Frisco has owned the Missions at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium since 2021, going 40-16 (.714) in San Antonio. During this stretch, Frisco has a 2.54 ERA as a team in the ballpark and has outscored the Missions by an average score of 4.9-2.8 (273-156). In 2024, the Riders went 12-1 at The Wolff.

**ONE-RUN MADNESS LATE:**

The RoughRiders are just 8-11 in one-run games this year. Out of the 11 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 5 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 2 of the 11 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen. The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (123 runs) and the 2nd-best team in Double-A in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.41).

**THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:**

**Arturo Disla**, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders. He he is hitting .296 (24-for-81)/.400/.469/.869 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 15 RBIs. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs. Between both levels, he has dominated lefties, hitting .400 (18-for-45)/.509/.711/1.220 against southpaws. Among those with at least 35 AB vs. LHP, he is 8th in the minors in batting average and 5th in OPS against lefties.

**GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:**

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been amazing recently. The No. 10 prospect is 5th in the Texas League in batting average (.306). On a 27-game on-base streak (longest active streak in TL), he is hitting .324 (33-for-102)/.432/.549/.981 with 5 doubles, 6 home runs, 23 RBIs, 21 walks and 21 strikeouts. He now has the T-9th-longest streak in franchise history at 27 games. In the last 7 games, Dreiling is hitting .400 (10-for-25)/.432/.549/.981.

**GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:**

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 38 games, going 23-15. During the stretch, they have scored 249 runs, third in the league (6.6 R/G), slashing .265/.372/.439/.811 with 48 home runs. Frisco's 52 runs in the first inning this year are 4th in the minors, hitting .302 (67-for-222) in the first with 12 home runs. **Dylan Dreiling** is tied for the league lead with 14 hits in the 1st inning (.368 avg) and has now hit 3 home runs in the 1st. They have scored in the first inning in 24 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 13 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 12-24 (including a combined 5-10 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 19-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 13-15 in 1 or 2-run games. The Riders have been shut out just twice this year, both in 7-inning doubleheader games.

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through 56 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in the Texas League with 505 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.269) and 2nd in runs (356, 6.4 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 45 percent of their games (25-of-56). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (73) while they are 2nd in SLG (.444) and 2nd in OPS (.811). For perspective, the Wind Surfer led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

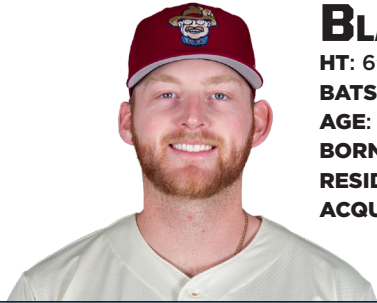

### ABOUT BLAKE

-Australian native pitched for Team Australia in both the 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classics. In 2023, he threw 1.0 scoreless inning before tossing two scoreless outings (2.1 innings) in 2026, including inducing a lineup to right field from Shohei Ohtani.

-Before the WBC, he was a member of the Australian National Team at the U-15 baseball World Cup in Iwaki, Japan in 2016.

-Pitched for the U-18 Australian Team against extended Spring Training Major League teams in 2018, leading to his signing by the Mariners on June 19th, 2018.

-After seven years with the Mariners, he was released in August of 2024 and signed by the Pirates, where he pitched for 2025 as well after resigning in the offseason.

-He elected free agency following 2025 and signed with the Rangers on January 23rd, 2026.

### 2026 SEASON

-Enters the season in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-On May 13th at Midland, threw 7.1 shutout innings, his longest outing of his career. He became the second RoughRiders starter to have recorded an out in the 8th since 2018 (Nick Krauth on 9/10/23: 7.1 IP).

-Between May 13th and 20th, threw first two quality starts of his career, 0.68 ERA (1ER/13.1IP).

### 2025 SEASON

-Among MiLB pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, he was 4th in the minors with a 1.76 ERA.

-Had just a 0.97 ERA through his first 25 games (six starts), allowing earned runs in just six of those outings.

-In his last 9G/6GS, went 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA.

### 2024 SEASON

-Pitched between Seattle and Pittsburgh organizations.

-2.35 ERA on the season over 38.1 IP was 84th in all of MiLB among relievers (0 starts) with at least 30.0 IP.

### 2023 SEASON

-All 35 games were in relief in 2023 for Low-A Modesto, finishing fifth on the team in appearances.

-Held opponents to a .221/.324/.293/.617 slashline

### 2022 SEASON

-Split time between four levels, including two games in Triple-A Tacoma, striking out 37 batters in 29.1 innings.

### 2019 SEASON

-Missed a majority of the season, undergoing "Tommy John" surgery, performed in August.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

## JORGE HERNANDEZ

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

## JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.
