JUMBO SHRIMP BATS STYMIED IN 10-1 LOSS

After falling behind early, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp couldn't overcome a nine-run deficit in their 10-1 loss to the Memphis Redbirds Saturday. Memphis (12-13) got out to a great start in the bottom of the second inning. After consecutive singles from **Alfonso Rivas** and **Moises Gómez**, **Jared Young** (3) blasted a three-run homer off Jacksonville (15-11) hurler **Max Meyer** (L, 0-1). The Jumbo Shrimp evened the game in the top of the fourth after **Will Banfield** drove in **Dane Myers** from second on a base hit. The Redbirds exploded for seven unanswered runs between the fourth and sixth innings, including a five-run sixth inning.

DANE TIME

Heading into play on Sunday, Jacksonville outfielder **Dane Myers** is riding a 22-game on-base streak, the second-longest such run in the International League this season. Myers got off to a slow start on this streak; over the first eight games of the streak, he went just 6-for-29 (.207/.343/.207/.550) with one RBI and four walks. In the 14 games since, though, the Katy, Texas native is 16-for-52 (.308/.400/.462/.862) with five doubles, one home run, six RBIs, eight walks and 14 runs scored. On the season, Myers' 57.6 percent ground ball rate is the 5th-highest among the 141 qualifiers in the International League. His ground ball rate was 46.6 percent in 2023 with Jacksonville.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

After homering Thursday night, **Jonah Bride** has now homered four times in his last 11 games. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 24-for-71 (.338/.478/.690/1.168) with seven doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, 14 walks and 11 runs scored. Bride ranks fourth in the International League in on-base percentage, second in OPS, second in slugging percentage and tenth in batting average.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 15 of Jacksonville's 26 games (57.6 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 11-4 (.733) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 58 of their 223 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 58 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in half of those, a total of 29 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a seven-run fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, five four-run innings, seven frames of three runs and 16 two-run innings.

TEN COMMANDMENTS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 14 of their last 23 games. 10 of those 14 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville actually being outscored by their opponents by a 88-86 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing sixth in ERA (4.47) in Triple-A during this stretch.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 26 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 120 runs (4.8 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 53-for-234 (.226/.331/.359/.690), ranking 28th, 26th, 28th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just seven stolen base attempts and six stolen bases in the 20 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A, over that same stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp are T-2nd-most home runs with 28. Since being moved to the bullpen in 2024, **Devyn Smeltzer** has thrived, not allowing a run in his last eight appearances (10.0 IP). In addition to this scoreless inning streak, Smeltzer leads the pitching staff in appearances (9) and ERA (0.77).

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings.

In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON

-

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
