LAST OUTING: Rodriguez tied a career-high with 7.0 innings and went over 100 pitches for just the third time this season at Charlotte on August 28.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's third career appearance against Gwinnett. He went 4.0 scoreless in a rain-shortened start on July 30 and picked up the win with two earned runs across 5.0 innings on August 4.
