#### LAST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (June 2, 2021)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders toppled the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 10-2 on Wednesday at PNC Field. Socrates Brito, Hoy Park and Trey Amburgey all homered and Thomas Milone was a home run shy of the cycle as the RailRiders beat their rivals for the fifth time in eight games this season.

Lehigh Valley opened the scoring in the second inning. After leaving the bases loaded in the first, the IronPigs took a 1-0 lead in the second against Adam Warren. Scott Kingery's sac fly plated Edgar Cabral for Lehigh Valley's only lead of the game. Warren was lifted after an inning and a third as the IronPigs loaded the bases for the second time in two innings, but Albert Abreu came out of the bullpen to strike out CJ Chatham and Ryan Cordell to end the threat.

In the bottom of the second, Milone tripled home Rob Brantly from first base to even the game at one. The RailRiders took the lead against Phillies prospect Adonis Medina in the third when Brito elevated an 0-1 pitch to center, landing it just in top of the wall with a runner on as Scranton/Wilkes-Barre took a 3-1 advantage. In the fourth, Chris Gittens singled home Milone, who led off the inning with a double. A Brito sacrifice fly drove in Park and extended the lead to 5-1. Facing former RailRider Brady Lail in the fifth, Park hit a three-run home run over the lawn in right field and Amburgey followed with a two-run blast to left four batters later for a 10-1 lead. It was his team-best fifth of the year despite having only play in nine games so far in 2021.

After a single in the sixth, Milone was a home run short of the cycle when he came to the plate in the seventh and drove a ball to the warning track in left, falling just a few just shy of the cycle. The IronPigs plated a run in their half of the ninth to close the scoring.

Abreu (1-0) earned the win, working 3.2 innings of scoreless relief with six strikeouts. Medina (3-2) took the loss after surrendering the first five runs over five innings. Park, Brito, Amburgey and Milone each had multi-hit games to help lead the 10-run, 12-hit attack on Wednesday.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**FAST OUT OF THE GATE:** With 17 wins in 24 games, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have kept themselves in elite company across minor league baseball. Entering play on Thursday there are only 15 teams across minor league baseball with at least 17 wins, with only Nashville, Durham and Omaha at that mark among Triple-A East teams. Nashville (AAA, MIL) has the best record in minor league baseball at 20-5 on the season, and is the only team with 20 wins. Overall, the Yankees have the best organizational record in baseball (67-32, .677), a full 2.5 games better than Baltimore (64-34, .653), who has the second-best record.

**A WALK IN THE PARK:** Since his promotion from Double-A Somerset, infielder **Hoy Park** has been a hitting machine for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After a 2-for-4 performance on Wednesday, Park is hitting .349/.462/.651 with 4 doubles, 3 home runs and 9 RBIs in just 12 games played. In 113 games with Trenton in 2019, Park totaled three home runs, and is already almost halfway to his career-high of 7 HR (2017 with Charleston and Tampa). Signed as an international free agent in 2014, Park already has four multi-hit games with the RailRiders, including a pair of three-hit contests. He has reached base safely in 11 games and recorded a hit in nine of his dozen contests.

**BIG TEN:** The RailRiders' 10-2 win over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Wednesday was the fourth time this season that the Baby Bombers have scored at least 10 runs in a ballgame this year in 24 games. Before Wednesday night, the last time the RailRiders had accomplished the feat was on May 18 at Rochester in an 11-6 win. It also marked the first time that SWB scored double-digits at PNC Field this season, having also done so twice in the opening series of the season at Syracuse.

**BULLISH ON THE 'PEN:** The RailRiders bullpen has been the backbone of the pitching staff in the early part of the season and the last five games have been. SWB relievers have combined to allow just two runs in 25.2 innings (0.70 ERA) against the Bisons and IronPigs since the beginning of play last Wednesday. What's more, they've combined to allow just 18 baserunners -- two on hit batsmen (both by **Adam Warren**), six walks and 10 hits (nine singles, two of which were infield hits). The SWB bullpen ERA is down to 3.19 on the season, while the unit is averaging 11.76 K/9. That ranks as the third-best bullpen ERA in Triple-A East, and second-best in the Northeast Div. (Buffalo, 2.32).

**DINGER ALERT:** After shattering the SWB franchise record with 212 home runs in 2019 (previously 164 in 1998), the RailRiders are at it again, hitting 34 home runs in their first 24 games this season. The 34 round-trippers hit by SWB puts the club in a tie for fifth place in Triple-A East with Nashville setting the pace with 46 dingers. The RailRiders are tied for 14<sup>th</sup> in minor league baseball in home runs, with Salt Lake (AAA, LAA) leading the minors with 47. The long ball surge has been a true team effort, as only **Trey Amburgey** (t-18<sup>th</sup>, 5) ranks in the top 30 in home runs in Triple-A East.

**WALK-A-THON:** Through 24 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn 129 walks, the second-most in all of Triple-A baseball, trailing only Gwinnett (148). No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 124 bases on balls (Lehigh Valley). Overall, the RailRiders are 15<sup>th</sup> in all of minor league baseball in walks, with St. Lucie (Low-A, NYM) leading the way with 168 walks. The top four teams in walks all play in the Low-A Southeast, which is using an automated balls and strikes (ABS) system this season. SWB's team .362 OBP is third in Triple-A East, and ranks t-11<sup>th</sup> across all levels of the minors. There are currently four teams in Triple-A East with team OBPs of .350 or higher. Lehigh Valley (.343) has the sixth-best OBP of the 20-team league. Among qualified hitters, the RailRiders boast **Chris Gittens** (3<sup>rd</sup>, .477) and **Socrates Brito** (39<sup>th</sup>, .352) in the top 50 in OBP in Triple-A East.

**THREE DOZEN SIDES OF BACON:** The COVID-19 pandemic has created one of the most unusual season schedules in the history of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre franchise. With the season beginning a full month later than traditional, all teams in Triple-A East will play 120-game schedules. The RailRiders, along with the rest of the Northeast Division teams, will exclusively play teams within the division. This leads to a schedule where SWB plays the rival Lehigh Valley IronPigs an unprecedented 36 times. For perspective, the RailRiders play the Rochester Red Wings and the Buffalo Bisons a combined 36 times. The RailRiders currently lead the 2021 IronRail Series 5-3.

# RAILRIDERS STARTING PITCHER

**25 BRIAN KELLER • RHP • 6'3" • 210 LBS • 26**

**LAST TIME OUT:** After a rough start against Lehigh Valley in which he walked five batters, Keller rebounded with a much better outing last Thursday at Rochester. The right-hander threw a season-high 4.0 innings and allowed just one run on three hits while striking out six and walking four. The lone run scored on a Brandon Snyder solo home run. The RailRiders lost the game on a walk-off two-run home run for Luis García in the bottom of the ninth.

**JOINING THE NO-NO PARADE IN 2019:** Keller began the 2019 season on the I.L. due to an elbow injury, and made his season-debut on 6/17 with Staten Island. After one rehab appearance, he was transferred to Double-A Trenton. The highlight of his season came on August 1, when he threw a 7-inning no-hitter against the Altoona Curve, allowing only one walk and needing only 70 pitches. It was the second no-hitter for the Thunder in the season and the 8th in the Eastern League.

**LATE ROUND GEM?:** The Yankees drafted Keller in the 39th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, a round which no longer exists (MLB shortened draft to 20 rounds for 2021). While it is uncommon for a 39th-round pick to even make it as far as Triple-A, there is precedent for success from the late rounds. Four-time AL All-Star Kenny Rogers was taken in the 39th round of the 1982 draft and accumulated 50.7 bWAR. Mark Buehrle (59.3 bWAR) was a 38th round pick, and current RailRiders LHP Nestor Cortes was chosen in the 36th round of the 2013 draft by the Yankees.

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season on the RailRiders Opening Day Roster.

**PERSONAL/CAREER:**

- Played all four collegiate seasons at Wisconsin – Milwaukee and as a senior, set school records with 10 wins, 103 K and 107.1 IP.
- 2016 Horizon League Pitcher of the Year Award winner.
- As a SR in high school, went 11-0 with a 0.42 ERA and was named Wisconsin Baseball Coaches Association State Player of the Year.
- In 2017, led all Yankees farmhands with 157 strikeouts, the most for a Yankees minor leaguer since 2007.
