YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 4-3. **Brady Whalen** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the top of the fifth inning with a solo homer. Erie tied the game with an RBI triple by Jake Holton in the fifth. In the top of the sixth, **Victor Bericoto** gave Richmond the lead with a solo homer and **Will Wilson** added a two-run homer to open a 4-1 lead. In the seventh, Daniel Cabrera brought in a run with a groundout. Jace Jung hit a solo homer in the eighth inning to close the score to 4-3. In the ninth, Daniel Cabrera reached on a single with two outs, but Gage Workman was thrown out trying to reach third to end the game.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series is the last set of the 2023 regular season. The two teams first met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond taking four-of-six. In their last trip to UPMC Park, the Flying Squirrels lost the first five games before winning the Sunday finale from May 9-14. The SeaWolves returned to Richmond and won five-of-six from May 30-June 4.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 44-27 in their last 71 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 10-2 in their last 12 games. Heading into Sunday, Richmond had won a season-high seven consecutive games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.95 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 492.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 652.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.81 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 36 times over the last 19 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE SEAWOLVES won the Southwest Division's first half and are locked into the postseason for the second straight year. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.247) and hits (1,092) while ranking second in runs (687), total bases (1,840), homers (168), RBIs (646), OBP (.338), SLG (.417) and OPS (.755). Erie's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including 2B Jace Jung (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), SS Danny Serretti (No. 16) and LHP Brant Hurter (No. 18). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes five Erie players, including Jung (No. 4), Madden (No. 6), Hurter (No. 12), Serretti (No. 25) and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack takes the mound for his 24th appearance of the year and his fifth against the Sea-Wolves. Last time out, Zwack started with four scoreless innings against the RubberDucks last Thursday before leaving the game following a rain delay of nearly two hours with no outs in the fifth and two runners on base. Those baserunners came in to score against the bullpen when play resumed. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

FÜR ERIE: Right-hander Trevin Michael makes his first professional start and his Double-A debut. He began the season with Low-A Lakeland and posted a 1.04 ERA in six outings before a promotion to High-A West Michigan on April 27. With the Whitecaps, he went 5-4 with a 3.43 ERA in 34 relief outings, adding five saves. He was promoted to Double-A Erie on Tuesday. Michael was selected in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of Oklahoma University, where he was the Sooners' closer for one season. He began his collegiate career at North Oklahoma College-Tonkawa for one season before spending the next two years at Lamar University.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (428,541) and average attendance (6,396) this year. They are also 14th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels drew their highest attendance since 2013.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With five games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, two games ahead of the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and four games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 36 times in their last 18 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. On August 31 in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006. In last week's series against the RubberDucks at The Diamond, they homered nine times. They began this week's series with three homers on Tuesday.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 16 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in 10 of them. On August 17, Victor Bericoto hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, Sean Roby won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, Jimmy Glowenke hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before Brady Whalen and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and Logan Wyatt hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On August 30 at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On September 2, Will Wilson hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on September 3, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score. On September 6 against Akron, the Flying Squirrels picked up a walk-off win in the 10th on an error. On September 7, Wyatt hit a go-ahead single in the eighth in a 6-5 win over the RubberDucks. On Saturday night, Andy Thomas broke a tie with an RBI single in the eighth for a 5-4 win.

WHALEN'S WARMING UP: In his last 13 games since August 27, Brady Whalen is batting .392 (20-for-51) with three homers, three doubles and eight RBIs, raising his season batting average from .203 to .276. He has hit safely in each of his last nine games dating back to September 1, during which he is batting .389 (14-for-36).

LONGBALL LOGAN* Logan Wyatt is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak dating back to August 27 (G1), which is tied for the longest active streak in the Eastern League. During the streak, he is batting .387 (12-for-31). Over his last 15 games since August 20, Wyatt is hitting .360 (18-for-50) with five homers, four doubles, six walks and 14 RBIs. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On August 30 at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 7 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization. Wyatt also hit a go-ahead single on Thursday in the eighth inning to beat Akron.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is batting .370 (20-for-54) with three homers, three doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs in his last 19 games since August 23. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .345 (39-for-113) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .171 (20-for-117) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .302 (48-for-159) with seven homers and 28 RBIs in 50 games. Last Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford from August 29-Sept. 3.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
