**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds continue their home opening series with game five tonight vs. St. Paul. The Saints evened the series with a close 6-5 win last night. Right-hander Tobias Myers will make his second start as a Sound. He'll face southpaw Brent Headrick, with first pitch at 6:35 p.m. in Hit City.

**Tobias Myers:** The 25-year-old gets the start for the Sounds tonight. He's 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA after pitching 4.0 scoreless innings on March 31 at Toledo. Myers struck out four and walked four in the outing and totaled 74 pitches, 43 of which were strikes. He spent almost all of 2023 with Double-A Biloxi, going 10-5 with a 5.03 ERA in 27 outings (26 starts) with the Shuckers. In his career, Myers is 4-19 with a 6.06 ERA in 38 appearances (35 starts) at the Triple-A level. He racked up the second-most losses by any Triple-A pitcher during the 2022 season with Columbus, Sacramento and Charlotte. Myers has spent time in the Orioles, Rays, Guardians, Giants, White Sox and now Brewers organizations. He was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven High School.

**Brent Headrick:** The 26-year-old makes his second start with St. Paul after getting the nod last Sunday vs. Columbus. He worked 3.2 innings and allowed a pair of runs (both earned) on five hits with eight strikeouts. Headrick threw 76 pitches, 49 strikes in the outing. He split last season between St. Paul (19) and Minnesota (14), appearing exclusively as a reliever with the Twins. He made his big-league debut on April 19 at Boston and worked 3.0 one-run innings for the save. Headrick was taken in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by Minnesota out of Illinois State University.

**It's Definitely a Nashville Party:** Veteran lefty Wade Miley made his first start on MLB rehab assignment with the Sounds last night. The southpaw went 3.0 innings, allowing a run (ER) on two hits and two walks with three strikeouts. He totaled 55 pitches (30 strikes) in his first action since last season. Miley was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 28, retroactive March 25, with left shoulder impingement. It was his first-ever outing with the Sounds - Nashville became the 17th different professional team the lefty has pitched for in his career.

**Something Brewing:** Brewer Hicklen has reached base in all seven games this season after a 1-for-4 night. He also swiped two bases, becoming the first Sound to steal multiple bags in a game this season. Hicklen is tied for the league lead in both doubles (4, with Jacksonville's Garrett Conine, Norfolk's Jackson Holliday and former Sound now with Durham Alex Jackson) and stolen bases (5, with Gwinnett's Eli White and Worcester's Mark Contreras).

**Raging Bullpen:** Despite giving up a couple of earned runs last night, the Sounds bullpen still holds the lowest Triple-A in ERA at 1.38 (32.2 IP/5 ER). The relievers also boast the lowest opponent batting average at .149. They are one of three teams yet to give up a home run in relief, along with Gwinnett (30.1 IP) and Memphis (24.0 IP). Nashville had the lowest bullpen ERA (4.10) at the Triple-A level last season.

**Just Guys Being Dudes:** Eric Haase and Francisco Mejia made their debut with Nashville last night, and the pair of catchers did not disappoint. The pair combined to go 4-for-9 with a double and two late RBI to make it a one-run game in the eighth. Haase joined the Sounds after being outrighted by Milwaukee on April 1. Mejia signed a minor league contract with the Brewers after being released by Tampa Bay on March 27. Both backstops have over three seasons of MLB service time (Mejia with five years and 42 days, Haase with three years and 58 days).

**Quality over Quantity:** Evan McKendry had the first quality start by a Sounds pitcher in 2024 on Thursday night. His line of 6.0 innings, four hits, two earned runs and three strikeouts marked the first quality start by a Sounds pitcher in the first six games of the season since Paul Blackburn on April 9, 2017 at Round Rock. McKendry has a quality start in three of his last five starts and pitched at least 6.0 innings in nine of his 23 starts in 2023.

**Lights Out:** Enoli Paredes continued his dominance with 2.0 scoreless and three strikeouts on Thursday. He has yet to allow an earned run this season in three appearances (4.0 IP/7 K). He has a 10-appearance streak (11.0 innings) dating back to last season with Sugarland without giving up a run. He has given up just two hits in the span while striking out 17 batters.

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 686-587 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,278-2,106 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).
