**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped the homestand finale to the Harrisburg Senators, 3-2, in 10 innings. Aldrem Corredor opened the scoring in the first inning with an RBI groundout and brought in another run in the third with an RBI single to put the Senators ahead 2-0. In the bottom of the fifth, Richmond broke onto the scoreboard with a sac fly by **Bryan Torres**. In the bottom of the eighth, **Frankie Tostado** tied the game with an RBI single. Corredor picked up his third RBI of the day in the top of the tenth with a two-out RBI single. Richmond failed to score in the bottom of the tenth against Harrisburg reliever Gabe Klobosits, who closed out his second save of the year. Richmond starter **Trenton Toplikar** worked a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed two runs with five strikeouts. Harrisburg starter Mario Sanchez, making his fourth start of the year against Richmond, allowed one run over 6.0 innings with six strikeouts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees at TD Bank Ballpark. The game is the first for the Flying Squirrels against the Patriots, who are in their first season as an affiliated team. This is Richmond's only trip to Somerset this season. The Flying Squirrels will host the Patriots for a six-game series at The Diamond from July 13-18. This series features the top-two teams in the league in ERA on the season so far.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won six of their last nine games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is tied for seventh in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked second in the league with a 3.29 ERA for the season.

**THE PATRIOTS** have lost five of their last seven games and sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Northeast Division, 2.5 games ahead of Portland. The Somerset offense is tied for seventh in the Double-A Northeast with a .237 batting average. The Patriots' pitching staff is leading the league with a 3.09 ERA. The Patriots are in their first season as an affiliated team after picking up the Yankees affiliation during Major League Baseball's restructuring of the minor leagues this past offseason. The Yankees' Double-A affiliation was previously with the Trenton Thunder from 2003-2020. The Patriots were a founding member of the independent Atlantic League in 1998 and went on to win five league titles (2001, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2015). Somerset's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswald Peraza (4), RHP Luis Medina (7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (27), RHP Glenn Otto (28) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes his Flying Squirrels debut. He was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on Saturday in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. Plassmeyer began the season with Double-A Montgomery in the Double-A South. In his first four outings of the year, he went 0-1 with a 7.36 ERA (12 ER/14.2 IP). In his last three outings, all in relief, he combined for a 2-0 record over 15.0 scoreless innings with 18 strikeouts and two walks. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season along with catcher Mike Zunino and outfielder Guillermo Heredia for outfielders Mallex Smith and Jake Fraley. In his first season with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page two.**

**FOR SOMERSET:** Right-hander Glenn Otto makes his sixth start and seventh overall appearance of the season. He last pitched last Tuesday, allowing six earned runs with 10 strikeouts over 6.2 innings in a loss at Erie. Over his previous three starts from May 20-June 2, Otto went 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (4 ER/16.0 IP) with 31 strikeouts. On May 20 at Hartford, Otto worked 5.1 scoreless innings and picked up 14 strikeouts, the most by a pitcher in Double-A this season. He is currently ranked second in the Double-A Northeast with 55 strikeouts, third with 14.6 K/9 IP and ninth with 34.0 IP. He was named the first Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week this season on May 9. Otto was drafted by the Yankees in the fifth round in 2017 out of Rice.

**FABULOUS FABIAN:** Over his last 11 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .438 (14-for-32) with one homer, five doubles and nine RBIs while scoring four runs. On Saturday night, Fabian drove a two-run double to put Richmond ahead in the seventh inning. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .284.

**TORRES ON A TEAR:** In his last seven games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .438 (7-for-18) with one double and two RBIs. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher, second base and third base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

**MO' TIME:** Over his last six games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .333 (7-for-21) with a double and three RBIs. On the season, he is batting .353 (12-for-34) against left-handed pitchers compared to .218 (12-for-55) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 44.2 percent of his balls put in play, which is the third-highest rate in the Double-A Northeast, trailing Erie's John Valente (48.8 percent) and Harrisburg's Aldrem Corredor (44.6 percent).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in the Double-A Northeast at 3.04 on the season, trailing only Harrisburg (2.44). The bullpen is second in the league with 13 saves. **Norwith Gudino** is third in the Double-A Northeast this season with five saves and **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fourth with four saves.

**AMAYA REBOUNDS:** After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever **Luis Amaya** has worked nine straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 10.2 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 2.77. He has not allowed a run in his last seven outings, covering 9.0 straight scoreless innings.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 21-15 record is the second-best start in team history through 36 games, trailing only the team's 22-14 mark in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the Flying Squirrels went 22-15 through 37 games, a mark the team can tie with a win today.

**GETTING ON THE BOARD:** Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 45 consecutive games. That streak includes all 36 games of the 2021 season. The next closest streak in the league is Bowie, which has not been shut out in 44 consecutive games dating back to August 23, 2019.

**LAW OF AVERAGES:** The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .240 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

**PITCHERS WHO RAKE:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with seven hits, six RBIs and four runs scored by pitchers at the plate. Richmond is also tied with Hartford for first in the league with three walks worked by pitchers while batting. On the year, Richmond has gone 19-11 (.633) against National League affiliates, but have gone 2-4 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. After using the designated hitter for this week's series against Somerset, pitchers will return to the batter's box for the next two sets against Hartford and Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
