FRES-NOTES

COMEBACK CLAWS ARE BACK: The Fresno Grizzlies (16-13) outlasted the Modesto Nuts (21-7) 3-2 Thursday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno enjoyed their first comeback claws win of the season, snapping a six-game losing streak at home. The Grizzlies improved to 3-11 overall (2-7 at home) when their opponents score first and relished their first victory in one or two-run contests (1-7 overall). Fresno also won their first game when trailing after six innings (1-9 overall, 1-7 at home) and when plating three runs or less (1-9 overall, 1-6 at home). The clubs combined for 30 strikeouts (15 each) and 14 walks (7 apiece). Both teams left 10 runners on base (20 overall) in the 3-2 duel. Fresno cut the deficit to 2-1 in the bottom of the fifth when Jason Hinchman roped a single to left. In the seventh, Hinchman once again came up with the clutch hit, lining a double to the left-center gap. Two runs roared home, putting the Grizzlies ahead 3-2. The one-run cushion was just enough for the Fresno pitching staff to wrap up the contest. Grizzlies' southpaw Austin Emener did not factor in the decision despite an excellent four and two-thirds innings of work. Emener tied a career-high with seven strikeouts, his third time reaching that feat this year. Welinton Herrera (2-1, win) entered for Emener with runners in scoring position, punching out Lazaro Montes to end the threat. Herrera completed his evening with a season-high two and one-third scoreless frames of relief. The lefty gave up two walks and no hits while whiffing six, the most by a Grizzlies reliever in 2024. Bryson Hammer (Hold, 2) hurled a clean eighth, mustering one strikeout. Collin Baumgartner secured his first professional save after fanning Arroyo with two runners on in the ninth.

MODESTO MINI FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Modesto Nuts (Seattle Mariners Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the first of five regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the first meeting in Fresno. The Nuts are 42-9 over their last 51 games dating back to August 20, 2023 (including playoffs). Last season, Modesto claimed the California League crown after a dominating 4-0 run through the playoffs. They won the second half by one game over Fresno to earn their way into the postseason. In four years, the Grizzlies are 42-40 against the Nuts (2-1 Modesto in the season series) since the squads became a part of the same league for the first time since 1988. At that time, Modesto was affiliated with the Athletics and were named the A's, while the Grizzlies were known as the Fresno Suns, playing independently. Now, the Nuts are associated with the Seattle Mariners organization (affiliated with the Colorado Rockies prior to Mariners), while the Grizzlies are partnered with the Rockies. The two cities are 96 miles away from one another if you drive by car, following the CA 99 route. Fresno and Modesto are one hour and 32 minutes apart, if you drive non-stop. The halfway point between both cities is Planada, California.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Fresno Grizzlies hold a 3-6 record with 24 total runs scored. A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' ability with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the nine games in the month, Fresno is 14-for-72 (194) with three different instances where the team did not score a run with runners in scoring position. Last night, Fresno went 3-for-13 with runners in scoring position, which included leaving the bases-loaded in the first (three strikeouts) and second innings (one strikeout and a double play).

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE": Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an unbelievable start to the season (25 games), going 21-for-72 (.292 AVG/.518 OBP/.486 SLG/1.004 OPS) with one homer, two triples, seven doubles, 14 RBI, 18 runs, 29 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and six stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked first in all of professional baseball with a .518 OBP. Snider's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has also had an outstanding start to the season (28 games), going 32-for-115 (.278 AVG/.320 OBP/.478 SLG/.798 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, five doubles, 20 RBI, 14 runs, seven walks and two stolen bases. The Cuban native is ranked among the Top 10 in seven different California League categories. He is ranked second in total bases (55), tied for third in hits (32), tied for third in triples (3), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (12), tied for fourth in homers (4), tied for fifth in RBI (20), and tied for 10th in slugging percentage (.478). Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Like Snider, Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

JACK OF ALL TRADES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #19 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney is from Illinois and grew up with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

HERRERA THROWS A TON OF STRIKES: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has eight consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 9. Herrera has tossed 11 innings, allowing six hits, two walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 22.

MADDEN IS MASTERFUL: Grizzlies' RHP Jake Madden has five straight scoreless appearances from April 19-May 8. Madden has tossed nine innings, allowing three hits and three walks while fanning six.

JACE THE ACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska leads the California League with a 1.90 ERA and 0.93 WHIP. Over five starts, Kaminska is 2-1 in 23.2 innings. The Nebraska alum has struck out 29 batters and has only walked four.
