TEEING OFF

- TODAY'S GAME: The GreenJackets saw their 4 game winning streak snapped with a 5-0 loss as the offense went dormant last night. Kadon Morton will take the ball with Davis Polo on his heels, trying to tame the strong offense of the Hillcats.
- BACKSTOP SHUFFLE: The GreenJackets made a series of moves involving their catchers, including activating Opening Day catcher Jacob Godman off of the 7-Day IL. Dawson Dimon returns to Rome after splitting starting duties in Godman's absence, while Jose Marcano comes down from Rome to serve as the 3rd catcher and utilityman.
- SHORT AND SWEET: The GreenJackets are now 3-0 in games shortened by rain, all of which have come at SRP Park. Augusta has seen a high level of rainfall in the early parts of the year, and it has benefited the home side more often than not.
- COMEBACK KIDS: Augusta earned their third walkoff win of the year Saturday night with Jeremy Celedonio's sac fly completing a 5-run comeback. The GreenJackets have shown a propensity for comeback wins, and do their best offensive work down the stretch in games.
- **ERROR, PAGE NOT FOUND:** The 'Jackets currently lead the Carolina League in errors with 87 in 58 games, but have been error-free in 2 of their last 3 contests.
- LOW POWER MODE: The GreenJackets are 12th out of 12 teams in home runs in the Carolina League, with just 22 in 58 games. Augusta hit four home runs in last week's homestand, with Isaiah Drake and Jeremy Celedonio each blasting a pair.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Kadon Morton makes his second start of the year after a rain-shortened outing last week saw him allow a run in 1.1 innings before an hour-long delay. He faces Rorik Maltrud, who has been inserted into the rotation over the last few weeks and has not allowed a run in his last two starts (10 innings).

CAREER: Drafted in the 19th Rd in 2019 out of Seguin HS in Arlington, TX, where he pitched and hit... scouts were split on future but was a hitter and outfielder in minors... plus defense with rocket arm and great speed, bat never quite caught up... best offensive season was 2022, which he spent most of in Augusta, hitting .226 with 13 HRs but 145 Ks in 112 games... was in Rome for all of 2023, hit .173 on the year, began transition to the mound for first time since high school in winter of 2023 and begining of 2024.
