CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On September 10, 2023, in the final game of their 2023 season, the Captains defeated the Lansing Lugnuts by a final score of 3-2 at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This victory clinched Lake County's fourth consecutive winning season, and 13th winning season in franchise history.

The Captains did not record a baserunner through the game's first four innings. However, Lake County took their first lead of the afternoon in the bottom of the fifth inning. Jorge Burgos hit a leadoff single to give the Captains their first baserunner of the day. This was the first of three straight singles for Burgos, who recorded his second three-hit game of the season. In the ensuing at-bat, Joe Lampe hit a two-run home run to put Lake County ahead 2-1. This was Lampe's fifth home run of the season, and first in a home game as a Captain. In the bottom of the eighth inning, Junior Sanquintin hit a two-out RBI double to make it a 3-1 game. Lampe tried to score from first base on the play, but was thrown out at the plate to end the inning.

After allowing a leadoff home run to begin the ninth inning, Matt Turner retired the next three Lugnuts hitters to end the game, earning his first High-A save of the season. Captains starting pitcher Ryan Webb (3-4) earned his third win of the season, pitching 6 innings, allowing 4 hits, one earned run, and 2 walks, and throwing 4 strikeouts in 82 pitches (49 strikes). Reid Johnston and Sergio Morillo then pitched a scoreless inning of relief each, throwing 2 strikeouts apiece.

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Lake County Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. Entering 2024, Lake County has an all-time regular season record of 1,373-1,361 (502).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made seven playoff appearances in franchise history (five Midwest League, two South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

AN EVEN SPLIT: Of Lake County's 30 active players to begin the 2024 season, 15 played for the team last season, while 15 did not. Of the 15 players who did not suit up for the Captains in 2023, 13 were promoted from Single-A Lynchburg, and two were promoted from the Arizona Complex League (OF Jonah Advincula and RHP Carter Spivey).

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Seven players on the Captains' initial 2024 roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in the third round, and was followed by C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, C Johnny Tincher in Round 11, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

FOX'S FRUITFUL SEASON: OF Jake Fox. Cleveland's No. 19 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, was one of Lake County's premier hitters a season ago. The 21-year-old led the Captains in hits (103), runs (61), doubles (23), triples (five), RBI (53), total bases (160), and at-bats (402) in 2023, while hitting .256 with eight home runs in 101 games.

Kayfus MESSICK'S PRODUCTIVE ROOKIE YEAR: LHP Parker Messick, Cleveland's No. 22 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, fared well in his first professional season last year. The 23-year-old ranked second in the Guardians' player development system with 136 strikeouts in 26 games (24 starts), including a trio of double-digit strikeout performances with Lake County.

INGLE'S INTRIGUING INITIATION: C Cooper Ingle, a fourth-round pick in the 2023 MLB Draft, had a strong beginning to his professional baseball last season.

In his first 17 professional games, all with Lake County, the 21-year-old hit .288 with 15 hits, 5 doubles, 10 RBI, 17 walks, and 2 stolen bases, while compiling a .464 on-base percentage.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: INF Jose Devers, Cleveland's No. 20 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, had a remarkable 2023 season with Single-A Lynchburg. The 20-year-old ranked top-five in the Carolina League in RBI (66, second), runs (65, tied for fourth), stolen bases (34, fifth), and total bases (158, fifth). Devers also hit 11 home runs, and was one of seven players in the league to record at least 100 hits.

KAYFUS'S EXCELLENT START: INF C.J. Kayfus, Cleveland's No. 19 prospect according to The Athletic's Keith Law, quickly made a substantial impact in his first 17 career professional games with Single-A Lynchburg. His 4 home runs (tied), 19 RBI (tied), and .542 slugging percentage led the team from his debut through the end of the season, as he also hit .271 with a .971 OPS.

JACOBS LEADING THE WAY: RHP Zach Jacobs led Cleveland's player development system with 10 wins last year. The 22-year-old made 29 appearances (3 starts) with Single-A Lynchburg, tallying a 4.43 ERA, 94 strikeouts, and a 1.29 WHIP, while converting three of his four save opportunities.

LAST TIME OUT: In his final outing of 2023, Parker Messick, recorded his second career High-A win, and first in a month. The left-hander pitched a season-high 6 innings (tied), allowing a career-high 8 hits (tied), one earned run, and one walk, while throwing 7 strikeouts in 85 pitches (62 strikes). The 22-year-old's lone earned run allowed was courtesy of a two-out solo home run from Lansing's Euribel Ángeles in the top of the 6th inning.

2023 IN REVIEW: Messick started his first career 13 games at Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games at High-A Lake County from June 29 to Sept. 9. Messick finished second in the Cleveland PD system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final seven starts for the Captains, posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings. Posted six quality starts with a career-high seven innings May 10 while at Lynchburg.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick is currently Cleveland's No. 22 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against righthanded hitters."

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Earlier this season, Messick was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 5/8-5/14. On May 10th, the left-hander had the one of the best performances of his Minor League career in a road start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (CHC). Messick earned his second career Minor League win, pitching a career-high 7 innings and allowing career-lows of one hit (since tied), zero runs (tied), and zero walks (tied), while throwing a then-career-high 7 strikeouts.

FLORIDA STATE PHENOM: Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, **Messick** became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI for the season as a hitter. **Messick's** 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. Messick was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. Messick is the FSU all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

SUMMER WONDER: Following his true freshman college season in 2020, Messick pitched for the Winter Garden Squeeze in the Florida Collegiate Summer League. The left-hander earned Cy Young honors as the best pitcher in the league for the season, finishing 3-0 with a 0.49 ERA and 27 strikeouts in 18.2 innings pitched.

HIGH SCHOOL HERO: Messick threw 11 complete games and 8 shutouts during his time at Plant City High School (FL), and was a 2019 MaxPreps 1st Team All-American pitcher. As a hitter, he hit .294 with 12 doubles, one triple, 7 home runs, and 40 RBI, scoring 30 runs and drawing 45 walks. In 2019, as a senior, Messick led all Florida high school pitchers with 125 strikeouts, helping quide Plant City to winning its first District, Region, and State Championship.

LAST TIME OUT: In his final outing of 2023, **Austin Peterson** suffered a loss on September 6 against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (CHW). He allowed 10 hits and seven earned runs, while striking out five in six innings of work in the 12-3 defeat. The right-hander went six innings for the fifth and final time in his first season of professional baseball.

2023 IN REVIEW: Peterson made 24 starts, tied for the most in the Carolina League with Hillcats teammate RHP **Alonzo Richardson** and Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP **Marcus Johnson**. Peterson recorded four quality starts, tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

POUNDING THE ZONE: Peterson finished fourth in the Carolina League with 102 strikeouts. He also ranked second in the Cleveland organization with a 3.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and posted the second-lowest walk rate among qualified arms in the Carolina League (5.4%). The right-hander threw 1,219 strikes, the second-most in the Carolina League.

THE GREAT EIGHT: Peterson posted two starts of eight shutout innings on June 30 versus Delmarva (BAL) and July 21 versus Fayetteville (HOU). He threw just 83 and 84 pitches, respectively in those two starts, and retired 48 of 55 batters faced during that span.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Peterson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on August 6, 2023. On August 2 versus Delmarva (BAL), he pitched six shutout innings, allowing one hit and throwing six strikeouts in the 8-2 win. **Peterson's** one hit allowed was the fewest in any of his starts last year, regardless of the number of innings he pitched.

A STAR IN STORRS: After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and five at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, **Peterson** was a two-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just two seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the sixth-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a First Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and First Team All-Big East. In his final year for the Huskies, **Peterson** struck out a program-record 147 batters, the third-most in the country. He also went eight-plus innings in three starts. In 2021, **Peterson** was named Second Team All-Big East, ranking fourth in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the league with 33 strikeouts looking.

BOILERMAKER BEGINNINGS: Peterson began his college career at Purdue, where he led its freshman class with 49 strikeouts, 25 appearances, and 48.0 innings pitched. He earned his first college victory on March 9, 2019, pitching a season-high 5.1 innings of relief and fanning a then-career-best nine batters in the 9-8 win. His final two appearances as a Boilermaker came on May 17 and 18 against today's West Michigan starter **Garrett Burhenn's** Ohio State Buckeyes. However, **Peterson** and **Burhenn** did not pitch in the same game at any point, as Burhenn made his only start on May 16.
